

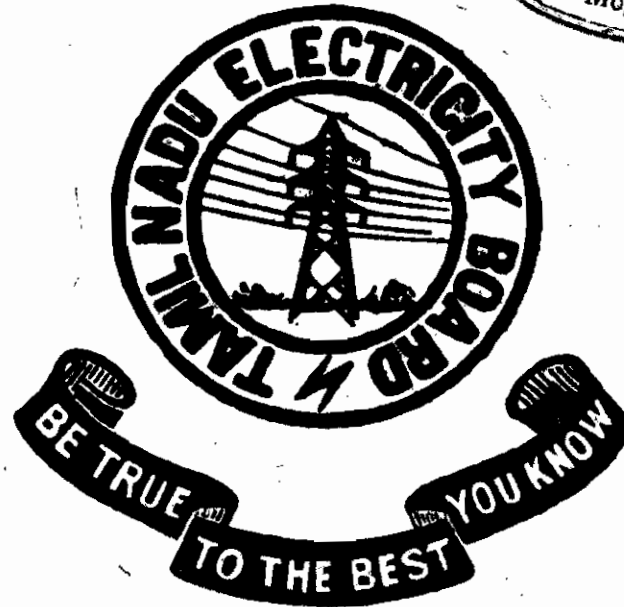

VIII. Training :

The following special programmes were conducted during December '90. —

2. Two Executive Engineers deputed for short term course on 'Run of River Small Hydro Power Development' at University of Roorkee from 18-12-90 to 5-1-91.
3. Two Superintending Engineers deputed to Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited/New Delhi for the 'Fourth Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited User's Committee for Thermal Sets' from 4-12-90 to 5-12-90.
4. One Assistant Engineer deputed to Power Engineers Training Society/Neyveli for Training Programme on 'Mill Plant Maintenance' from 10-12-90 to 14-12-90.
5. Chief Engineer/Officer on Special Duty participated in the "Training Programme on Human Resource Management for Administrators" from 5-12-90 to 14-12-90 conducted by Institute of Applied Manpower Research, New Delhi.
6. One Under Secretary & Senior Personnel Officer deputed to "Training Programme on Managerial Effectiveness" conducted by Anna Institute of Management, Madras from 3-12-90 to 4-12-90.

IX. Free supply to Agricultural consumers :

In G.O. Ms. No. 2341 (PWD) dt. 17-11-90 (Memo. No. 162/SE/IEMC/PO(T)/Tariff I(2)/90-9 dt. 4-12-90) the Government of Tamil Nadu has ordered free supply to all agricultural consumers with effect from 1-8-90.

X. Extension of time beyond 90 days for agricultural applicants :

In circular Memo. No. SE/IEMC/EE3/AEE2/D537/90 dt. 3-12-90, the Superintending Engineers of Distribution Circles have been delegated with full powers to grant extension of time beyond the initial 90 days' notice period issued by the Executive Engineers to the agricultural pumpset applicants to report their readiness. The above extension to be granted without any time limit and for any reason put forth by the applicants and irrespective of whether the application requesting extension of time is received before or after the expiry notice period.

XI. House Building Advance—Deduction of grace period for interest

In Memo. No. 511707/E2/90—2 dt. 11—12—90, the Board has specified the grace period to calculate the interest for the periods as below :-

XII. Increase in advance for education of children

In (Per) B.P. (FB) No. 51 (Sectt. Branch) dt. 7—12—90, the Board has enhanced the educational advance from Rs. 300/- to Rs. 400/- from 1991—92 for Class III & IV employees of the Board drawing a pay not exceeding Rs. 1700/- per month.

XIII. Temporary overlooking of priority in respect of LT industrial applicants

In Memo. No. SE/IEMC/EE3/AEE1/10558/90 dt. 5—12—90, the Board has clarified that the temporary overlooking of priority for want of distribution transformer may be followed in the revised procedure for disposal of LT industrial applications.

XIV. Changing/shifting of meter board

In Per. B.P. (FB) No. 233 (Tech. Branch) dt. 24—11—90, the Board has prescribed the following charges for changing/shifting of meter Board :-

XV. Inspection charges

In Per. B.P. (FB) No. 226 (Tech. Branch) dt. 20—11—90, the Board has prescribed the following charges in respect of second and subsequent test and inspection charges necessitated due to faults in the installations or due to non compliance with the Terms and Conditions of Supply:-

For over 75 KW of connected load, the above charges will be doubled.

For replacement of white meter card, the fee is Rs. 2/-.

XVI. Vigilance Cell

In Memo. No. 82022/O&M Cell (2)/90—1 dt. 15—12—90, the Board has instructed that to detect cases of misappropriation, misuse or misapplication of stores and execution of substandard works, Officers of Vigilance Cell as far as possible should take with them the next superior officer of the organisation or his nominee and carry out surprise checks of offices, stores, workshops etc. Routine items like Attendance Registers, Casual Leave Register etc. shall not be checked.

XVII. House Building Advance—Advance for construction of house involving ground and first floor—Stage of instalments to be released.

In Per. B.P. (Ch) No. 256 (Sectt. Branch) dt. 17—12—90, the Board has ordered that the House Building Advance sanctioned to the employees of the Board for constructing house with ground and first floor be disbursed in three instalments as below :

30% of the sanctioned amount	For bringing the construction upto ground floor roof level (excluding roof slab)
40% of the sanctioned amount	Completion of ground floor and first floor roof.
30% of the sanctioned amount	Completing the construction.

Time limit for utilisation of each instalment shall be three months and the time limit for completion of the house shall be 18 months.

XVIII. Norms for construction of quarters in substations:-

In Per B.P. (FB) No. 252 (Tech. Branch) dt. 10-12-90, the Board has fixed the revised norms for construction of quarters in substations.

XIX. Posting of Lady incumbant in substation

In Memo. No. 26002/E8-2/90-1 dt. 10-11-90, the Board has lifted the ban on posting of women officers/staff in substations.

XX. Appointment of Thiru K. U. Krishnan, CE (Distribution)/Madras as Member/TNEB:-

In G. O. (D) No. 15 (PWD) dt. 21-12-90, the Government has appointed Thiru K. U. Krishnan, Chief Engineer as Member of the TNEB. In per BP (Ch) No. 262 (Sectt. Branch) dt. 22-12-90, the Board has designated Thiru E. U. Krishnan as Member (Distribution) and Thiru E. K. Abdul Jabbar as Member (Generation).

XXI. Advancement and surrendering of energy quota by HT Industries:-

In G.O. Ms. No. 2626 (PWD) dt. 6-12-90, the Government of Tamil Nadu has extended the facility of "Advancement" and "Surrender" of energy quota by the HT Industries beyond 31-12-90 without any limit of time.

XXII. Reduction of power cut :-

In G.O. Ms. No. 2746 (PWD) dt. 24-12-90, the Government of Tamil Nadu has reduced the 30% power cut on demand and energy in respect of HT Industries with a permitted demand of 130 KVA and above to 20% on demand and 10% on energy effective from 26-12-90. Oxygen Plants, freezing plants and cold storage of sea food industries, Liquid nitrogen plants of Tamil Nadu Cooperative Milk Producers Federation Ltd., Salem, roller flour mills and Liquid nitrogen plants of M/s. Kamarajar District Cooperative Milk producers' Union Ltd., Sulakkarai will be subjected to 15% cut on demand and 10% cut on energy.

XXIII. Acquiring immovable property by the member of the Board Employees—Dispensing with the provisions of TNEB Employees' Conduct Regulations:-

In Per. B.P. (Ch) No. 264 (Sectt. Branch) dt. 26-12-90, the Board has ordered that the properties acquired by inheritance or from out of their own funds by the members of Board Employees will not attract the provisions of the TNEB Employees Conduct Regulations and the Board Employees need not include such properties in the property return.

XXIV. Meter Caution Deposit:-

In Memo. No. 1154 PO(T)/Tariff I (2)/89-12 dt. 15-12-90, it has been clarified that the meter caution deposit shall be collected wherever a fresh meter is installed in place of the existing one due to conversion of LT service connection to HT service connection, sanction of additional demand in the HT service connection etc. This will not apply to replacement of meter for testing purpose or defective meter.

XXV. Advance increment for MBA degree holders:-

In Per B.P.(FB) No. 53 (Sectt. Branch) dt. 29-12-90, the Board has ordered that the Board Engineers who commenced the MBA degree course prior to 7-11-83 and completed the course after the above date may also be granted the benefit of two advance increments from the date of eligibility.

XXVI. Extension of banking of energy scheme from July 90 to March 91:-

In B.P. (FB) No. 18 (Tech. Branch) dt. 28-12-90, the Board has permitted the HT consumers to withdraw the balance of banked energy in their credit as on 30-6-90 till 31-3-91. Energy not drawn on that date will lapse.

Sub: Establishment—Class II service—AE./EI.—Posting of Lady incumbent in the Sub-station—Orders—cancelled.

1. In Adm. Branch Memo. first cited, it has been inter alia ordered that as the nature of works in S.S. demands the presence of officers and staff at any time during day and night and most of the work is confined inside the S.S. yard, no woman officers/staff shall be posted for O & M works inside S.S. Yard.

2. In the B.P. second cited, certain guidelines for posting of Assistant Engineer/EI. selected through direct recruitment have been issued.

3. Citing the above instructions, the Chief Engineer/Distribution/Madurai Region, has stated that instructions issued could not be followed strictly in view of the recruitment of large number of woman candidates. The newly recruited woman Assistant Engineers allotted to Distribution Circle have to be posted in the S.S. not only for gaining field experience, but also due to necessity. The Chief Engineer/Distribution/Madurai has therefore requested for modification of instructions issued earlier.

4. Taking all these aspects into account, the suggestion of Chief Engineer/Distribution/Madurai has been examined. It is hereby ordered that the instructions issued in para 1 of the Adm. Branch M. I am directed to state that the Government of India in its reference second cited, has issued a notification specifying certain special allowances specifically granted to meet expenses wholly, necessarily and exclusively incurred in the performance of the duties of an office or employment of profit for the purpose of section 10 (14) of the income tax Act. In that, among others it is stated that any allowance (by whatever name called) granted to meet the expenditure incurred on a helper where such helper is engaged for the performance of the duties of an office or employment of the profit, as one of the items.

The purpose of sanctioning a post of residential Office Assistant is only to carry out the duties of an Officer during out of office hours by the Officer concerned and the cash allowance given is only to compensate wholly, exclusively and necessarily the expenses incurred by the Officer by engaging any helper, consequent on surrendering the Office Assistant. I am, therefore, directed to state that cash allowance in lieu of surrendering residential Office Assistant will now qualify for exemption under section 10 (14) of the Income Tax Act. Hence this allowance need not be included in the total income of the Officer concerned for the purpose of deduction of Income Tax at source.

4. I therefore request you to issue suitable instruction to your subordinate officers that all the columns in the Performance Assessment Reports are properly filled up and see that they have taken special care to indicate Branch, Grade and Date of Birth without any omissions. They may also be instructed to use separate covering letter for each category as different sections are maintaining the Personal Files for different categories.

5. Of late, it is seen that the different form of the Performance Assessment Reports are being used by different officers for writing the Performance Assessment Reports for Class II & III Officers. The Performance Assessment Reports in respect of Class III employees whose next line of promotion is Class II Service only are to be written annually. The following categories of employees are in Class III Service :

- (1) Junior Engineers/Electrical/Mechanical/Civil II Grade.
- (2) Head Draughtsman
- (3) Junior Chemist

6. Their next line of promotion is in Class II Service. Therefore the Performance Assessment Reports of the above Class III personnel have to be written in the format as applicable to Class II Officers.

Regulation 13(1) of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employee's Conduct Regulations lays down that no employee shall except after notice to the prescribed authority acquire or dispose of any immovable property by lease, mortgage, purchase, sale, gift, exchange or otherwise whether in his own name or in the name of any member of his family. Such a notice will be necessary even where any immovable property is acquired by any member of the family of the employee out of the resources of the employee. If any such transaction is conducted with a person having official dealings with the Board employee, it shall require the prior sanction of the prescribed authority. According to Regulation 13(3), every Board employee shall periodically submit a return of assets and liabilities in the prescribed form.

2. A question has been raised whether notice to the prescribed authority is required if the members of the family of a Board employee acquire any immovable property either by inheritance or from out of their own funds.

3. Taking into account the orders issued by the Government on the above question, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board directs that Regulation 13(1) of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees' Conduct Regulations will apply only to the properties acquired, etc. by the Board employees either in their own name or in the name of any other member of their family. The properties acquired by the members of the family of the Board employees either by inheritance or from out of their own funds, will not attract the provisions of the above Regulations. The Board employees are also not required to include such properties in the property return submitted by them under Regulation 13(3) of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees' Conduct Regulations.

Instances of misplaced sympathy and uncalled for lenience in cases where grave charges involving moral turpitude like demand and receipt of bribe etc. have been proved have repeatedly come to notice. Appellate authorities have to study the disposal of Disciplinary Proceeding cases and see that the principles of natural justice have been followed and punishment awarded by Disciplinary Authorities are commensurate with the gravity of the proven charges. Vigilance Cell would also bring to the notice of such appellate authorities for suo-motu review of such cases wherever it is possible as and when it come to their notice. Vigilance Cell would be in a position to study how the facts connected with the Disciplinary Proceedings have been appreciated by Enquiry Officers. Sometimes Vigilance Officers understanding of matters may also call for corrections. Meaningful instructions are possible and quality of disposal of Vigilance Cell cases could be improved only if Enquiry Officers reports are thoroughly studied in Vigilance Cell. At the same time gross injustice or lack of appreciation of fact/evidence by Enquiry Officers could also be pointed out only if enquiry report is studied by Vigilance Cell

Hence it has been decided that in all Disciplinary Proceeding cases started on a report from the Vigilance Cell of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board apart from a copy of the served charge memo. and the final speaking orders which are required to be sent to Inspector General of Police/Vigilance, a copy of enquiry officer's report would also be sent to the Inspector General of Police/Vigilance without fail. As regards sending a copy of charge memo. final speaking orders etc. instructions have already been issued in the reference cited above.

Hence, certain points for clarifications have been raised regarding calculation of grace period interest.

2. The matter has been examined in detail. Since the grace period interest is collected only to cover the period during which the House Building Advance amount remains unrecovered it has been decided that the interest for grace period may be calculated with reference to the period stipulated for commencement of recovery and not with reference to period actually deducted for arriving at the balance service of the employee. Accordingly the Sanctioning Authorities are requested to calculate "grace period interest" for the periods given below:—
