

The Director of Vigilance & Anti-corruption has brought to the notice of the Government an instance in which the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal quashed the charge letter issued by the Government based on the investigation report of the Directorate against a State Service Officer. The matter was not brought to the notice of his Directorate by the Secretariat Department till the Investigating Officer ascertained the stage of the matter from the Head of Department. (When the Investigating Officer came to know of this, he has addressed the Government for taking up the matter in appeal to the Supreme Court).

- In another case, the orders of Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal directing the completion of investigation by Director of Vigilance and Anti-corruption within one year was communicated by another Secretariat department *nearly one year after* the date of the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal Order.
- 3. It is observed that often the departments of Secretariat/Heads of Departments do not bring to the notice of the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-corruption in time the important stages as well as the outcome of the cases filed before Court/Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal/Central Administrative Tribunal, arising out of Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption enquiry. Such belated information hampers follow up action by Director of Vigilance and Anti-corruption.
- 4. In view of the above, all the departments of Secretariat and Heads of departments/Collectors are requested to keep the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-corruption informed promptly and in time of the important stages as well as the outcome of cases filed before the courts or applications filed before the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal/Central Administrative Tribunal arising out of Director of Vigilance and Anti-corruption enquiries/investigations so that effective follow up action can be taken up by the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-corruption, wherever necessary. The Heads of Departments are requested to issue suitable instructions to their subordinates also in the matter.

Sub: Establishment - RWE - Extension of Service beyond the date of retirement on superannuation - Re-employment - Instructions - Issued.

While approving the proposal of re-employment to a workman who was allowed to continue in service beyond the date of superannuation in Chidambaranar Electricity Distribution Circle, the Full Board has observed that proposals of this kind are received in large numbers and this shows that officials concerned are not taking adequate care to maintain the service registers and watch the date of retirement of the employees under their control properly.

- In such cases, regularisation of service has to be done necessarily by way of re-employment as the individuals are allowed to continue beyond the actual date of retirement on superannuation. In a number of cases, the following grounds are noticed.
 - Not verifying the records for the date of birth and not indicating the nature of the record verified (S.S.L.C certificate or any other certificate of qualification, Transfer certificate etc.) in the Service Roll.
 - ii) Omission of the Signature of the individual and attestation by the Officer in the Service Rolf.
 - Belated verification of the date of birth certificates produced by the employees.
 - (iv) Omission to follow the instructions issued in Chief Engineer/Personnel's Memo. No.125259/1318/ S6(1)/86-1 dt.10.9.86 wherein it is ordered to launch a drive for updating the Service Roll and to permit the workmen to see their Service Rolls for verification once in a year.

- v) Record of the dates of retirement of the employees not maintained upto date and notice of retirement not issued to the staff as per instructions issued in B.P.Ms.(Ch)No.220 (Sectt.Br) dt.11.6.84, without giving room for extension of service beyond the date of superannuation.
- In view of the above observation, the attention of the Superintending Engineers are invited to the Service Regulation and Leave Regulation Manual under Chapter III, General Conditions of Service Regulation 17 and Chapter X Regulations 110(a) & (b) and the Superintending Engineers are requested to ensure that a Register is maintained exclusively for this purpose and checked periodically.
- 4. The Superintending Engineers are requested to follow the instructions strictly as laid down in the Service Regulation and Leave Regulation Manual in order to curb extension of Service beyond the actual date of retirement on superannuation.
- 5. All the Superintending Engineers should ensure that such irregular extension of services are avoided at all costs and failure to do so will entail in severe Discinlinary Proceeding action.
- 6. The receipt of this Memo, should be acknowledged.

Order:

In the G.O. third read above, orders have been issued revising the Self Financing Schemes for the energisation of agricultural pumpsets as follows:

- i) The initial costs of Rs.25,000/- or the actual cost of extension whichever is higher has been reduced to a flat rate of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) per service.
- ii) The agriculturists who pay the flat rate of Rs.10,000/- shall pay electricity consumption charges at the rate of Rs.250/- per Horse Power per annum or metered tariff at the rate of 50 paise per KWH at the option of the consumer and
- iii) The progress under the revised scheme should be included within the annual target of 40,000 pumpsets.
 - The Schedule to the Tamil Nadu Revision of Tariff Rates on Supply of Electrical Energy Act, 1978 has been amended accordingly.
- 2. The Chairman, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, Madras, in his letter fourth read above, has informed that the Board in its meeting held on 11.8.95 discussed the modalities of implementation of the Revised Self Financing Scheme and came up with suggestions for certain modification of the Scheme.
- 3. The Government, after careful consideration of the proposals of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, direct that the Revised Self Financing Scheme for energisation of agricultural pumpsets shall be modified as follows and the Schedule to the Tamil Nadu Revision of Tariff Rates on Supply of Electrical Energy Act, 1978 be amended accordingly:
 - i) If the cost of extension of power connection is within Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) per service, the agriculturists should pay the flat rate of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousands only) per services,
 - ii) If the cost of extension of power connection exceeds Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) per service, the agriculturists should pay the actual costs of extension of power connection;
 - iii) The agriculturists who pay the flat rate of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousands only) or the actual cost of extension of power connection, as the case may be, shall pay electricity consumption charges at the rate of Rs.250/- (Rupees Two hundred and fifty only) per Horse Power per annum or metered tariff at the rate of 50 paise per KWH at the option of the consumer; and
 - iv) The applicants who opt for this scheme will be given priority over the pending applicants; and
 - v) Power connection to 10,000 pumpsets under this Self Financing Scheme will be given within the annual target of 40,000 pumpsets. However, if the demand goes above 10,000, the extra cases under this Self Financing Scheme will also be covered even though the total 40,000 is exceeded.
- 4. The following notification will be published in an extra-ordinary issue of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 6th November, 1995.

Notification

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Revision of Tariff Rates on Supply of Electrical Energy 'Act, 1978 (Tamil Nadu Act 1 of 1979), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Schedule to the said Act.

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 6th November, 1995.

In the meeting convened by Honourable Minister for Industries on 6.9.95 it was decided that, all applications for Industrial services falling under 'Red Category' Industries (highly polluting), presently 22 industries as per G.O.Ms.No.17 dated 10.4.94 and Government letter dated 9.4.92 and also industries subsequently notified under 'Red Category' by Government/Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board from time to time, should be received by the Board only with the 'consent to establish' from the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board and further supply to such industries should be effected only on production of 'consent to operate' from Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board.

Accordingly, in exercise of the Powers conferred by Section 49 of the Electricity (Supply) Act 1948 (Central Act LIV of 1948), the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board issues the following amendment to Terms and Conditions of Supply Notified in B.P.Ms. (F.B) No.61 dated 24.12.88 and published in Part-VI Section 3(b) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette No.8, dated 1.3.89 and as amended subsequently.

This amendment shall come into force with immediate effect.

Amendment

The supply to such 'Red Category' industries as defined in Clause 6.01 (b) shall be effected only on production of the letter of "consent to operate" issued by Tamii Nadu Pollution Control Board by the prospective consumer.
