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Sub : Loans & Advances—Conveyance Advance—Enhancement of monetary limit for Motor Car Advance—Certain Clarification— Issued.

Ref : (i) (Per.) B.P. (FB) No. 96, (SB) dt. 28-12-96.

(ii) From the Superintending Engineer/Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle/  
Central Lr. No. Adm. IV/A2/D. 159/97, dt. 3-3-97.

In the B.P. first cited orders have been issued enhancing the quantum of advance for purchase of Bi-cycle, Motor Cycle and Motor Car and it has also been stated that the eligibility criteria and period of recovery of advance shall remain unchanged.

2. The Superintending Engineer/Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle/Central has raised a point for clarification as to whether the condition, limiting the Car Advance to 40 months basic pay is to be adhered to while working out the eligible amount of advance.

3. It is clarified that in the B.P. first cited, the existing monetary limits alone have been enhanced without modifying the other conditions of limitation. Therefore, the other limits viz. anticipated price of the car as well as the number of months pay will continue to be in force.

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Letter No. 22831/L.C. 1/97-2, (Sectt. Br.) dated 2-4-97.

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Sub : Theft of Board's Materials—Criminal trial order of the Court for custody and disposal of property—Pending trial in criminal cases—Compliance of the orders of the Court—Instructions issued.

In the case of theft of materials of the Board, complaints are lodged by the field officers to the Police. If the materials are seized by the Police; they are deposited in the Court for custody pending trial of the case. It is seen that during the pendency of the criminal trial, the Board's officials take the materials from the Court with the permission of the Court on bond to return the same as and when Courts direct. It has now been reported that the officials fail to return the materials to the Court inspite of notice sent by the Court.

2. In one case the Judicial Magistrate No. II, Ramanathapuram made a complaint to the Chairman that the Assistant Engineer concerned who had taken the materials from the Court had not returned the same inspite of direction of the Court. This has caused embarrassment to the Board.

3. It may be stated that Sections 451 to 459 (Chapter XXXIV) of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (2 of 1974) authorise the Court to make such orders as it thinks fit for the proper custody of the property pending the conclusion of trial and for disposal of the same on conclusion of trial.

4. In view of above and also as and when directions are given by the Courts in this regard, the directions of the Courts shall be complied with by the concerned officials of the Board.

5. However in individual cases if it is felt that the orders passed by the Court is against rule/law or against the interest of the Board in such cases an appeal may be resorted to after getting opinion of Legal Cell and also with approval of the Chairman.

Memorandum No. 10178/O&M-1(3)/97—9, (Secretariat Branch) Dated the 4th April, 1997.

Sub : Establishment—Board Office—Punctuality in attendance, movement control etc. of employees—Curbing of indiscipline—Instructions—Issued.

Ref : 1. Circular Memo. No. 10178/O&M-1(3)/97—1 dt. 10—2—97.

In the reference first cited, instructions were issued to curb absenteeism from the seats by the staff for long intervals during office hours without valid reason. The duty officers were directed to make visits and conduct checks of absentees purposefully to facilitate stern action against the delinquents missing from their seats. In the references second and third cited the staff of the Board in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Complex were instructed to utilise the Saturdays to clear the backlog accumulated over the week days as well as to attend to other urgent official works, by restricting their movement.

2. It is observed that the above instructions have not been followed scrupulously. In the last week the Chairman noticed that scores of employees were leaving the offices in the complex at 4-30 P.M. Quite a number of employees working in the complex are seen coming late to office. It shows lack of discipline on the part of some staff and also that strict control is not exercised by the Controlling Officers/Duty Officers on the staff, as instructed to curb these tendencies of staff. Chairman has expressed displeasure on this. Therefore the controlling officers should exercise greater control over their staff to maintain discipline and bring to book the erring members of the staff.

3. As we all aware, punctuality in attendance should be given utmost importance by all concerned. Yet, the tendency of coming late to office is still there. In order to make the rules in this regard more effective, it is proposed to close the two entrance gates of the High Rise Building and also the gates of other offices housed in the complex on any one day in a week exactly at 10.41 A.M. The late comers will have to produce their identity card and then sign in the register kept in the gate with their name (in capital letters) designation and office legibly and then go to their respective offices. The Register will be maintained by the Security Officer with the help of the Sergeants and Security Staff, and hand over the register to Secretary/O&M Cell by 12.00 Noon on the same day. The O&M Cell will communicate the names of employees who attended late and signed in the register, to the concerned Establishment Officers in the various offices in the complex for taking appropriate action as per rules. Similar exercise will be conducted in the evening on any two working days in a week. It is the responsibility of the Establishment Officers concerned to take prompt action on the habitual late comers so that a sense of discipline will be created in the minds of employees for being punctual.

4. All officers and staff of the Board are requested to note the above instructions and any violation of these instructions will be viewed very seriously.

Sub : Establishment—Tamil Nadu Electricity Board—Entry of candidates with Bogus education qualification certificates—Avoidance of—Instruction—Issued.

It has been brought to the notice that in certain cases appointment orders had been issued based on the bogus educational qualification certificates produced by the employees. Subsequent revelation of the fact will result in unnecessary initiation of Disciplinary Proceedings, litigation etc. In order to prevent such practice in future, all the appointing authorities of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board are hereby instructed that before issuing appointment orders, the veracity of the educational qualification certificate should be got verified at Educational Institution/School where the candidate studied. The above instruction should be followed scrupulously.

Sub : Vigilance cell—Co—operation by field officers for conducting enquiries Instructions—Issued.

Ref : B. P. Ms. (Ch.) No. 379, dated 3—12—88.

It has been brought to the notice that some of the senior officers are of the opinion that the Vigilance Officers are of lower rank than themselves cannot enquire about them and openly express their displeasure and are reluctant to co-operate with the enquiry.

2. Practically it is not possible to have Vigilance Officers of higher rank to enquire into the allegations against the senior officers like Superintending Engineer, Chief Engineer, etc.

3. The senior officers are expected to extend full co-operation to the Vigilance Officers irrespective of the rank or the Vigilance Officers by answering the questions and handing over official records.

4. Vigilance Officers are doing their duty by collecting facts and figures and documents so that the allegation can be found true or not.

5. The Officers concerned need not take the visit of the Vigilance Officer or Vigilance enquiry as a nuisance embarrassment or humiliation.

6. Attention is drawn to the instructions issued in para XII/20 of B. P. Ms. (Ch.) No. 379, dated 30—12—88. As per this instructions, all the officials of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board should extend their co-operation to all officers and staff of Vigilance Cell and all official records should be handed over to them.

Sub: Loans and Advances—House Building Advance—Eligible service for sanction of House building Advance—Instructions—Issued.

As per Rule 1 of the Rules to regulate the Grant of Advances to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees for Building etc., of Houses, House Building Advance may be sanctioned to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board employees whether permanent or non-permanent, if they have rendered on the date of application for the advance 6 (six) years continuous regular service. Complaints are received that employees who do not satisfy this condition are also sanctioned House Building Advance.

2. It is hereby ordered that the sanctioning authorities should follow the above rule scrupulously and if any such case of deviation is noticed, in regard to sanctions accorded earlier or in future disciplinary action will be taken against the officials responsible.

Establishment — Class I Service — Performance Assessment Reports—Representation against adverse remarks—Removal of Time Limit for disposal of representation — Revised guidelines for communication of adverse remarks—Orders—Issued.

**Proceedings :**

In para 6 of B.P. Ms (Ch.) No. 419 (SB) dt. 31—10—83, it has been ordered that the representation for expunging or modifying of adverse remarks in the Confidential Reports should be finally disposed of within SIX months of its receipt failing which the defects should not be held against the officer for promotion etc.

2. Any delay in the disposal of the representation for expunging or modifying of adverse remarks results in unintended advantage to the officer concerned. Therefore, after careful examination, it is hereby ordered that the time limit of six months laid down in the above said Board's Proceedings for disposal of representation for expunging or modifying adverse remarks shall be removed with immediate effect.

3. It is also stressed that the representations for expunging or modifying of adverse remarks should be disposed of by the authorities competent within a reasonable time required for the above purpose and if any instance of official affected adversely on account of delay in disposal of the representation is brought to the notice of the Board, the same will be viewed seriously.

4. The system of communicating all adverse remarks recorded in the Assessment Reports by the Reporting Officer, after review by the Scrutinising Officer, to the official concerned within one month from the date of review ordered in the Board's Proceedings second cited are cancelled. Instead, it is ordered that it is enough if the Performance Assessment Report is shown to the officer concerned and his acknowledgement obtained in the Performance Assessment Report. The representation for expunging adverse remarks shall be made by the official concerned not later than three months from the date on which they have perused the Performance Assessment Report and acknowledged on it.

Sub : Loans and Advances—House Building Advance—Advance for the purchase of Ready Built House/Flat from Private Parties—Inspection of the house—Instructions—Issued.

It is noticed in certain cases of sanction of advance for the purchase of Ready Built House/Flat from private parties that the sanctioning authorities sanction the House Building Advance after a very long time after issue of orders allotting the funds in those cases from this office. Such a delay is reported to be due to the conducting of the inspection of the house/flat, with reference to the proviso under Rule 3(a) of the Board's House Building Advance Rules after the receipt of the orders from this office for sanction of the loan. This procedure is not correct.

2. All the Sanctioning Authorities of House Building Advance are informed that inspection of house/flat with reference to the proviso under Rule 3(a) of the Board's House Building Advance Rules shall be conducted immediately on receipt of the application in complete shape. If in any case the norms stipulated in the Table under the said proviso, are not satisfied, the application should be rejected and returned to the applicant immediately without assigning priority in the register. The Sanctioning Authorities are also informed that the particulars such as date of receipt of the application, date of inspection of the house and date of receipt of the inspection report, should be indicated in the sanction order of the advance in each case.

Sub : Establishment—Tamil Nadu Electricity Board—Punctuality in attendance, movement control etc. of employees—Curbing of indiscipline—Further instructions—Issued.

Ref : (i) Circular Memo. No. 10178/O&M-1(3)/97—3 dt. 15—2—97.  
(ii) Memo. No. 10178/O&M-1(3)/97—9 dt. 4—4—97.

In the reference first cited, orders were issued declaring Saturdays as 'No Visitor Day' and the employees of the Board in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Complex were instructed to utilise Saturdays to clear the back-log of work accumulated over the week days, as well as to attend to other urgent official work.

2. It has come to notice that there are some difficulties in restricting the visitors on Saturdays. In this connection, it is hereby ordered that the following categories of visitors may be allowed to enter the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Complex on Saturdays :—

- (i) M.L.As., M.Ps and Councillors who come to meet the Chairman or other Top Officers of the Board ;
- (ii) Pensioners, Members of the families of employees/Pensioners who come to Headquarters Dispensary for treatment ;
- (iii) Employees coming from other offices of the Board, situated outside the complex on official work ;
- (iv) Employees of the Board who are coming to Dispensary, Co-operative Society, Co-operative Stores and Union Offices ;
- (v) Residents of the quarters inside the complex.
- (vi) Authorised people working in canteen/tea shop/pawn shop ;
- (vii) Postal and Tele-communication staff, couriers
- (viii) Persons coming for interview, training, appointment if trainings are fixed.
- (ix) Participants in Seminars, Meetings.
- (x) Accountant General Audit staff.



3. In the reference second cited instructions to curb the tendency of attending office late in the mornings and leaving the office before the closing time, were issued. As ordered therein, the entrance gates of the High Rise Building were closed a few times without notice for test-checking the number of late comers/or early goers without proper permission. It was observed that this tendency continued.

4. The instructions are equally applicable to all employees of the Board in the offices housed in the High Rise Building as well as in the various other blocks within the complex. In order to make the rules more effective, the following instructions are issued;—

- (i) The entrance gates in each and every block inside the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Complex where Board's Offices are functioning should also be closed on any one day in a week exactly at 10.41 A.M. on instructions. The gates will remain closed till 11.00 A.M. Therefore the late comers/persons who had applied for late permission will have to produce their identity cards and then sign in the register kept in the gate with their name (in capital letters), designation and office legibly and then go to their offices.
- (ii) The Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers housed in the various blocks other than High Rise Building shall arrange to see that the above exercise is done on any one working day in a week in the morning to enforce discipline and send a report to O&M Cell/Board Office Secretariat Branch. The concerned Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineer may seek the assistance of the Security Officer.
- (iii) The Security Officer shall post a security guard at the entrance of each block to assist the staff concerned to get the names and designation of the late comers of that office. The register should be handed over to O&M Cell-1/Board Office Secretariat Branch before 12.00 Noon.
- (iv) The O & M Cell will communicate the names of employees who attended late and signed in the register, to the Establishment Officers concerned in the various offices in the complex for taking appropriate action as per rules.
- (v) As already instructed, the duty officers should conduct surprise checks on the allotted floors and note the names of employees who absent from their seats for long intervals without valid reason. From recent reports it is seen that the exercise is done in a routine manner and this is not what is expected of from the Duty Officers. They should send their reports without fail on the last working day of the week. Duty Officers who do not send reports will be liable for Disciplinary action.

5. The Inspector General of Police/Vigilance, Chief Engineer/Personnel and Legal Adviser shall conduct surprise checks at random before close of office hours to ensure that employees do not leave office without proper permission.

6. All officers and staff of the Board are requested to note the above instructions and follow them scrupulously.

7. The Controlling Officers shall give wide publicity to such circulars issued.

Certain points have been raised regarding sanction of Conveyance advance for purchase of two wheelers and four wheelers, and the points raised are clarified below :

A model form of order of suspension of an employee has been prescribed in Appendix—II of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees' Discipline and Appeal Regulations. It is considered that as far as possible, factual details and the reasons for suspension of an employee may be specified in the order of suspension itself, in future, except in the following cases where such requirements have to be dispensed with expressly or by necessary implication or it is not desirable to communicate the reasons for such suspension in the larger public interest :

- (i) When suspension is ordered due to enquiries by Director of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption or Vigilance Cell of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board on the reported allegations, those allegations cannot be furnished in the suspension order, as some of the allegations after enquiry may have to be treated as not substantiated.
- (ii) Similarly, in the criminal cases investigated by the Director of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption/Criminal Investigation Department etc., factual reasons cannot be furnished as there may be possibility of destroying records or intimidation of witnesses;
- (iii) In other cases where enquiry into grave allegations/complaints against criminal offence is contemplated, furnishing of factual reasons for suspension may have to be dispensed with as the reasons cannot be mentioned in the suspension orders.

2. Accordingly the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board carefully considered revising the form of suspension order in the case of employees of the Board, having regard to two sets of employees serving in the Board, namely, employees governed by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees' Discipline & Appeal Regulations and the workmen governed by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Standing Orders, and has decided to revise the form.

3. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board directs that the revised form of order of suspension prescribed in the Annexure to these proceedings shall be followed by all the Disciplinary Authorities/Competent Authority.

- (v) Financial Controller/Revenue will report to Chief Financial Controller/Revenue, Deputy Financial Controller/Revenue, Deputy Financial Controller/Cost and Deputy Financial Controller/Acquisition/Independent Power Project will work under the control of Financial Controller/Revenue.

#### Proceedings:

In the G.O. cited, the government of Tamil Nadu have introduced a pilot scheme to provide financial assistance to the pensioners for undergoing specialised Treatment/Surgery by constituting a fund called "Tamil Nadu Government Pensioner's Health fund". This fund will be utilised to extend grants to the pensioners who have to undergo specialised Treatment/Surgery in the accredited private hospitals irrespective of whether such facilities are available in Government Hospitals or not. Under this scheme, each pensioner shall contribute a sum of Rs.5/-p.a. to the fund with Government contributing Rs.5/- per annum per pensioner.

2. Following the orders of the Government, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board has decided to constitute a fund called "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund" to provide financial assistance to the pensioners of the Board for undergoing specialised Treatment/Surgery. Each pensioner of the Board will contribute Rs. 5/- p.a. and the Board will also contribute Rs. 5/- p.a. per pensioner to the above fund. The

annual subscription of Rs.5/- from each of the pensioners of the Board for the year 1996-97 will be recovered from their pension for the month of April 1997 and the subscription for the subsequent years will be recovered from the pensioners from the pension for the month of March, by the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Board Office Audit Branch. With regard to new pensioners, the first recovery towards the health fund will be effected by the pension sanctioning authority in the first month pension. The Chief Financial Controller will administer the fund. The annual subscription recovered will be sent to the Chief Financial Controller along with the details of name, P.P.O. number of pensioners. The transaction will be subjected to Audit by the Chief Internal Audit Officer and to test Audit by the Accountant General/Residential Audit Officer/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board/Chennai.

3. (a) The annual subscription of Rs.5/- recovered from the pensioner every year shall be credited to the new head of account, "viz. 57.167 - T.N.E.B. Pensioners' health fund (Receipt)".
  - (b) The Board's contribution to the fund shall be debited to a new head of account "viz. 75.714 - Board's contribution to T.N.E.B. pensioners health fund".
  - (c) Sanction of financial assistance to the Board's pensioners shall be debited under the new head of account. "viz 57.167 - T.N.E.B. pensioners Health Fund (out go)".
4. The scheme will be implemented with effect from 1.3.97 so that the financial assistance is feasible to the specialised Surgery/Treatment undergone on or after 1st March 1997.
  5. The Chief Internal Audit Officer shall be the sanctioning authority for the grant of assistance under Tamil Nadu Electricity Board pensioners Health Fund Scheme.
  6. The Chief Financial Controller shall be the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the head of account.
  7. This scheme will cover pensioners only and it will not cover family pensioners and dependants.
  8. An entry shall be made in the P.P.O. of the pensioner regarding the financial assistance sanctioned.
  9. The pension sanctioning authority will be responsible for the prompt recovery of the subscription. The details of collection indicating the number of pensioners from whom the recovery is made and the total amount collected with a certificate that annual subscriptions have been collected from all pensioners under his control shall be sent to the Chief Financial Controller by the respective heads of officers.
  10. The Regulations framed for administering the scheme are in the Annexure-I to these proceedings. The list of Surgeries/Treatments for which assistance is eligible is indicated in the Annexure-II hereto. The list of accredited Institutions where specialised Surgeries/Treatments can be undergone is in the Annexure-III hereto.
  11. The regulations governing the fund shall be reviewed by the Board with reference to the facilities available in the Government medical institutions from time to time.

**Annexure - I**

**Regulations governing the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund :-**

**1. Scope :**

The scope of these Regulations shall be to constitute a separate fund for the purpose of granting financial assistance to the Board pensioners who have to undergo certain specialised Surgery/Advance Treatment, for which facilities are not ordinarily available at the Government Hospitals.



## 2. Extent of the Scheme :

The annual subscription for the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioner's Health Fund shall be recovered from the pensioners by the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Audit Branch. The scheme shall apply to all pensioners of the Board and this scheme will not apply to the dependant of the pensioners and family pensioners. Each pensioner shall contribute a sum of Rs.5/-p.a. to the fund and the Board will match this with a contribution of Rs.5/-p.a. per pensioner. The annual subscription will be recovered from the pension for the month of March payable in April every year. When a new pensioner is authorised, the contribution shall be recovered from the first pension payable to him. The scheme shall come into force with effect from March 1997 onwards and the subscription for the year 1997 shall be deducted from the pension for the month of April'97 payable in May'97. An amount of Rs.5/-p.a. towards the subscription shall be recovered by the Chief Internal Audit Officer and the amount recovered shall be sent to the Chief Financial Controller, Accounts Branch along with the details of name/designation. In respect of new pensioners, the recovery towards subscription shall be made from the first month pension by the pension sanctioning authorities and the recovered amount shall be credited to the "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund". The pension sanctioning authorities shall send a monthly report in this effect to the Chief Financial Controller. The Chief Financial Controller shall credit the subscription into the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioner's Health Fund.

## 3. Corpus of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund :-

The subscriptions recovered from the pensioners shall be credited to "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioner's Health Fund".

## 4. Assistance:

The assistance from the fund will be sanctioned to the pensioners for undergoing the specialised Treatments/Surgeries listed in Annexure-II in the accredited Institutions indicated in Annexure-III.

## 5. Specialised Advance Surgery /Treatment:

For the purpose of the pensioners health fund rules, specialised advance Surgery or Treatment mean:-

(a) Surgery or Treatment specified in the Annexure-II.

## 6. Procedure for Release of Assistance :

Financial Assistance to the Board Pensioners shall be granted from the fund subject to the following condition:-

- a) Pensioners seeking assistance under Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund shall submit the application to the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with such evidence as may be necessary or relevant to establish the need for the special treatment for which the assistance is sought.
- b) The Chief Internal Audit Officer shall scrutinise all the applications received upto 28th February of each year and place before the committee constituted with the following officers:-
 

Accounts Member	-	Chairman of the Committee
Chief Internal Audit Officer	-	Member of the Committee (Convenor).
Chief Medical Officer	-	Member of the Committee.

As per decision of the committee, the Chief Internal Audit Officer will sanction the assistance by the middle of March every year. Other applications for which funds are not available will lapse. They cannot renew their application afresh from 1st March onwards. This payment will be given only after the Treatment/Surgery is over and no advance payment will be granted under this scheme.

- c) The Chief Financial Controller/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board shall operate the personal deposit account for the fund and issue of cheque to the respective Bank where the pensioner draws his pension.

d) The Chief Internal Audit Officer/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board shall be the sanctioning authority for the grant of assistance under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board/Pensioners Health Fund. The committee shall decide the quantum of assistance to be sanctioned subject to the ceilings fixed by the Board from time to time. The Chief Internal audit Officer/Audit Branch shall arrange to credit the amount sanctioned in the S.B. Account of the pensioner after getting cheque from Chief Financial Controller from Tamil Nadu Electricity Board pensioners Health Fund and entries to this effect shall also be made in both halves of P.P.O. The sanctioned amount shall be credited in the pension account by including the amount while getting fund allotment for the subsequent month.

#### **7. Governance of the Fund:**

- a) The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund constituted under these rules shall be a separate fund under the governance of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board.
- b) Financial assistance from the fund shall be sanctioned in the form of outright grant, based on the quantum of assistance required.
- c) Assistance sanctioned under Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund shall be in the form of grant to the maximum extent of Rs.25,000/- of 75% of the actual cost of the treatment whichever is less.

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Sub: Payment of Technical Fees to Foreign Companies.

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Payment in foreign currency towards Technical Fees such as Service charges, Erection charges etc. can be made by the following two methods.

#### 1. Payment Through L.C.

Under this method, first a Letter of Credit is established with the Foreign Bank specified by the Foreign Company. After completion of the works, the work bills are passed and handed over to the Foreign Company, who will submit the same to their Bankers in their country and get the payment against the L.C. there itself.

#### 2. Direct Payment Procedure:

Under this method, no LC is opened. After completion of the works, the work bills are passed and sent to our Bankers for releasing the same to the Foreign Company by Telegraphic Transfer.

While most of the Bankers agree for Direct Payment procedure they are reluctant to open LC for payment other than materials which are in the nature of service. In this connection, copy of letter received from the Canara Bank, Madras-2 declining to open LC is sent herewith for information. Further, Direct Payment procedure is also cheaper compared to payment through L.C. and it has the advantage of time leverage in releasing payment for the same.

Therefore it is better to follow Direct Payment procedure instead of payment through L.C. However, under unavoidable circumstances L.C. can also be opened. The procedural formalities which are already in vogue are reiterated hereunder as they are not followed in a no. of cases causing delay in making payment of the same.

(1) The P.O. ordering authorities shall first apply to "The General Manager (P.R. Section), Reserve Bank of India, Madras-1 for issue of permit Approval for making payment of the Technical Fees to the Foreign Company. This can be obtained from RBI in a weeks time.

(2) Then, he has to apply to the Deputy Commissioner of Income Tax/Special Range VIII, Nungambakkam, Madras - 34, for issue of No Objection Certificate duly furnishing the particulars as per the proforma enclosed for making payment of the Technical Fees to the Foreign Company. This can also be obtained in a weeks time.

(3) If the period of engagement of the Foreign Technicians exceeds 3 months, Approval from the Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi shall also be obtained.

(4) EFT Forms (copy enclosed) shall be filled in triplicate and copy of relevant pages of passport and visa of the Foreign Technicians giving Name, Address and date of their arrival in India shall be sent.

(5) 5% towards R&D Cess is payable to Govt. of India. But in view of Order No.2261 of 1989 in the High Court of Calcutta, payment of R&D Cess is not to be insisted now. However an undertaking to the effect that "R&D Cess will be paid by TNEB if it becomes eventually payable at a later date" shall be given.

(6) A certificate to the effect that "the Service of the Foreign Technicians are not covered by any Foreign collaboration agreement entered into with any Foreign Company or under any Warranty/Guarantee obtained providing for deputation of the Technicians by the Foreign Company without any payment" shall be given.

(7) A certificate that " the total duration of engagement of Foreign Technicians does not exceed 12 man-months in a Calender Year" shall be given.

(8) A Certificate to the effect that " This transaction does not involve any transfer of Technology" shall also be given.

The above 8 documents along with Two copies of the purchase order and P.C. acceptance by the company shall be sent to Financial Controller/Purchase (LC Section). Further the Foreign Bank through which LC to be established shall also be furnished.

These documents will be sent to our Bankers and LC will be established on the Foreign Bank specified by the Company. Subsequently on completion of works, the invoices submitted by the company are to be processed and passed for payment as per rules & regulations therefor.

If Income Tax is payable by the Company, it shall be recovered at the % specified in the NOC issued by the I.T.Department and remitted to the Govt. of India Account at the prevailing Exchange Rate for the same. If Income Tax is payable by the Board, then it shall be paid by the Board itself.

The Income Tax is to be remitted by the Territorial Superintending Engineers who have certified/ passed the work bills in the respective region from out of available funds or by obtaining funds from the DFC/ Funds for the same.

The passed invoices and a copy of Income Tax Remittance Challan shall be handed over to the Foreign Company for getting payment against the LC from their Banks where LC is established in their country.

However in the case of Direct Payment procedure, the passed Invoices & Copy of I.T.Remittance Challan are to be sent to F.C/Purchase (LC Section) along with all the other documents mentioned above. Further the Bank A/c No. through which payment to be released to the Foreign Company shall also be furnished. These documents will be sent to our Bankers for releasing payment to the Foreign Company by Telegraphic Transfer.

This is applicable to supply and erection contracts also in respect of the erection portion only.

Due to recent developments, Bankers are insisting submission of all the above documents before making payment under LC/Direct Payment. It is therefore requested to follow all these procedural aspects for avoiding delay in making payment.

The details of admissibility of revised Dearness Allowance for employees drawing pay at various stages are given in the Annexure to this order.

4. For the purpose of calculation of revised Dearness Allowance, the basic pay including personal pay, if any shall be taken into account. In cases where the pay plus personal pay of employees fall between the two pay ranges indicated in column (1) in the Annexure to this order, the revised rates shall be worked out at the specified percentage rates. The revised Dearness Allowance shall be rounded to the nearest rupee.

3. Following the orders issued by Government of India, in their Office Memorandum second read above, the Government now sanction the revised rates of Dearness Allowance to the State Government Employees as follows:-

4. The Government has decided that the increase in Dearness Allowance shall be paid in cash to all the employees irrespective of pay drawn by them with effect from 1st January 1997. The details of admissibility of revised Dearness Allowance for employees drawing pay at various stages are given in the Annexure to this Order.

5. For the purpose of calculation of revised Dearness Allowance, the basic pay including personal pay, if any, shall be taken into account. In cases, where the pay plus personal pay of Government servants fall between two pay ranges indicated in column (i) in the Annexure to this order, the revised rates shall be worked out at the percentage rates. While working out the revised rate, fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise.

6. The Government also directs that the revised dearness Allowance sanctioned above, shall be admissible to full time employees who are at present getting Dearness Allowance and paid from contingencies at fixed monthly rates and to full time non-provincialised work - charged establishments. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order shall not be admissible to part time employees.

7. The revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order will also apply to the teaching and non-teaching staff working under the local bodies and in aided educational institutions, employees governed by the University Grants Commission and the all India Council of Technical Education scales of pay and the Teachers / Physical Directors/Librarians in Government and Aided Polytechnics, Special Diploma Institutions and Village Assistants in Revenue Department.

8. The expenditure shall be debited to the detailed head of account '03. Dearness Allowance' under the relevant sub-minor, sub-major and major heads of account.

9. The Treasury Officers/Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to make payment of the revised Dearness Allowance when bills are presented without waiting for the authorisation from the Principal Accountant-General (A&E), Chennai - 18.

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In the Board Proceedings under reference orders have been issued to computerise L.T. Bill Accounting in the Nine Revenue Units of Madras City as indicated in the Annexure-I therein and to instal computer system in these Revenue Units under the control of Chief Engineer/Distribution/Madras Region at an estimated cost of 73.24 lakhs.

It has been decided to instal the computer in Erode South Division of Erode Electricity Distribution Circle deleting the Guindy Division Madras Electricity Distribution Circle/South as a trial measure. Accordingly the following amendment is issued to the Per.B.P.(FB) No.57 (Tech.Br.) dated 24.02.96.

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Circular Memorandum No.18402/L.C.3./97-1 (Secretariat Branch), dated 3.4.97.

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Sub: Contract - Open tender system - Interim orders by High Court - Certain instructions Issued.

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A copy of the news item under the caption, "High Court asks Tamil Nadu Government to follow Open Tender System" published in the Hindu, Chennai Edition dated 28.2.97 is enclosed. It may be seen there from that the High Court by an interim order has directed the Tamil Nadu Government to follow the

notification given by it in June 1996 that only open tender system should be adopted for awarding contracts by Government Departments.

2. This direction was issued by the High Court on a petition filed by a registered contractor in the Public Works Department and Highways Rural Works Departments alleging that the authorities had discarded the notification given by the Government and had invented a new practice called "The Quotation System" which was an easy way of making money without the knowledge of higher ups. As per this system, the petitioner alleged that, "there was no sale of tender schedules, no earnest money deposit and as a result, the government, in the last two months alone, had lost about Rs.2 Crores". During this period, the respondents 1 to 3 had given contracts for nearly Rs.25 crores in the quotation system. The petitioner alleged that he had not been awarded the contract as he refused to pay anything illegally.

3. In this context all the Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers and other authorities who are competent to award contracts in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board are requested to follow scrupulously without deviation whatsoever the latest instructions of the Board in regard to award of contracts. However single tenders for proprietary items and limited tenders for the procurement of materials of value up to Rs.2 lakhs per material per annum and works contracts of value up to Rs.2 lakhs per item of work by issuing enquiries to all the registered Suppliers/Contractors may be adopted in exceptional cases. They are further informed that they should not give any room for the Courts to criticise the Board in this regard.

**High Court Asks Tamil Nadu Government to Follow open Tender System.**

**From Our Legal Correspondent,**

Chennai Feb.27.

The Madras High court, by an interim order, has directed the Tamil Nadu Government to follow the notification given by it in June 1996 that only "open tender" system should be adopted for awarding contracts by Government departments.

Mr. Justice E.Padmanabhan, in his order, directed the State Highways Department, which was alleged to have resorted to "quotation system" and awarded contracts for Rs.25 crores, to follow the notification.

The Judge ordered notice to the respondents - Divisional Engineers of Saidapet and Chengalpattu Divisions of Highways and Rural Works Department; Superintending Engineer, HRW, Chennai and Secretary, Highways Department.

According to the petitioner, Mr.S.Jayabalan of Chennai, he is registered contractor in the PWD and HRW Departments for the last 25 years. He alleged that during the AIADMK Government, tender schedules were given only to select contractors or one or two benamis, who were favoured by the Minister concerned. Only the Minister would choose the contractors and then the tender schedules would be sold. As a result, there was a large-scale corruption in awarding contracts.

The petitioner said after the DMK Government came to power, a notification was issued on June 8, 1996 and published in newspapers which stated that hereafter "single tender" system would be stopped and "open tender" system should be resorted to. This notification, according to the petitioner, was implemented only for a couple of months. Now the authorities had discarded the notification given under the directions of the Chief Minister and had invented a new practice called the "quotation system", which was an easy way of making money without the knowledge of the higher-ups.

The modus operandi adopted in this system was that no tender notification would be published either in newspaper or in the notice boards. The respondents - 1 to 3 - would call the contractor of their choice, tell the nature of the work and ask him to submit a quotation to do the work or for the supply of the materials, strike a deal with him and award the work.

After the introduction of this new system, many contractors were rendered workless and their right to participate in the contract had been infringed upon.

In the present system, there was no sale of tender schedules, no earnest money deposit and as a result, the Government, in the last two months alone, had lost about Rs. 2 crores. During this period, the respondents - 1 to 3 - had given contracts for nearly Rs.25 crores in the quotation system. The petitioner alleged that he had not been awarded the contract as he refused to pay anything illegally.

Aggrieved over this procedure, he had filed the present petition for a direction to the respondents to implement the notification issued on June 8, 1996; to follow the "open tender" system and not to resort the "quotation system".

He sought an interim injunction to restrain respondents - 1 to 3 - from awarding any contract to any person under the quotation system pending disposal of the petition.

The attention of the all Superintending Engineers/Electricity Distribution Circles is invited to the circular memo dated 23.8.95 cited wherein the procedure for disposal of H.T. application was issued along with the flow chart of various events.

In the flow chart it was informed to accord extension estimate sanction within 45 days of load sanction with a subjective clause to take up work only on payment of Development Charges, Meter Caution Deposit and Service Connection Charges and on verification of readiness reported by the party.

In this connection many representations have been received from field Officers that the sanctioning of extension estimate within 45 days of load sanction does not serve any purpose in case a party avails the entire 20 months extension period on expiry of 180 days notice allowed by the Board as the estimate has to be revised suitably as per the latest cost data.

After careful examination and to avoid duplication of work the following revised instruction is issued.

The estimate for the extension work shall be sanctioned only after the party has reported readiness. The readiness reported by the applicant should be verified within 15 days from then. On satisfying the readiness, the estimate for extension of H.T. supply may be sanctioned within 30 days of reporting readiness.

Ref: Permanent B.P. (FB) No.63, (Technical Branch), dt. 26.3.97.

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As per the B.P. cited, the power source required to test the manufactured/repared products is also considered as connected load defined in Clause 2.0 of terms and conditions of supply of Electricity.

In view of the above, the following follow-up action may be taken to avoid criticism by the consumers on detection of violation by APTS:

1. Wide publicity may be made among industrial consumers that manufactured products/repared equipments would be considered as connected loads if they are electrically connected. Necessary compensation charges would be levied if the total connected load inclusive of the capacity of equipments manufactured/repared exceeds the permitted load. The matter may be published both in Tamil and English dailies.
2. The consumers may be advised to avail additional load if they want to test their products/repared ones by submitting necessary application indicating the capacity of test bench.
3. Additional loads could be effected for this following Board's normal procededures.
4. In the test report (OTR/RTR) the capacity of the power source alone need be indicated as the equipments tested vary from time to time.

Sub: Electricity - Target for extension of supply to hut services under One light per one hut scheme for the year 1997-98 Regarding.

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A total target of 40,000 huts electrification is fixed for the year 1997-98. The Districtwise/Circlewise target for extension of supply to hut services under one light per one hut scheme in respect of Normal programme are given in Annexure-I&II.

In this connection, it may be noted that not less than 75% of the target fixed shall be reserved for the hut/group houses belonging to Adi-Dravidar/Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes. Priority may be extended to group houses constructed under Indra Awas Yojana (Sub scheme of JVVT) in Village panchayats.

In case, the no. of application from Adi-Dravidar/Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes is less than 75% of the circle target, the Chief Engineer/Distribution may reallocate the circle target within the region without affecting the overall district target so as to ensure that 75% of the services are effected to Adi-Dravidar/Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe beneficiaries.

The other terms and conditions for effecting hut services now in vogue remain unaltered.

The no. of hut services for Adi-Dravidars under General category, NREP/RLEGP/JVVT/IAY/Kamarajar/Thadco/Other category may be arranged to be furnished separately in the monthly return on 20 point programme. Any modification in the circle target by Chief Engineer/Distribution, shall be duly intimated to Superintending Engineer/RE&I(D).

Sub: Accident - Compensation - Certain instruction to Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers-Reg.

Ref: Routine B.P. (Ch.) No.231 (Sectt, Branch) dated 16-8-1996.

- - -

In the Board's Proceedings quoted above, powers have been delegated to the Chief Engineer/Personnel to accord sanction of compensations in all cases where the amount of compensation is payable to the Legal heirs of fatal and non-fatal accident cases of both non-departmental persons/Animals due to electrocution and as per Court orders which are not fit for appeal as per Legal opinion, without monetary limit.

2. On this score, Courts while disposing of cases pass awards directing Tamil Nadu Electricity Board to make payment of compensation to the dependants/Legal heirs of the deceased persons stipulating time limit for implementation of award with interest.

3. Of late, it is observed that the Superintending Engineers are submitting proposals to Chief Engineer/Personnel/Chennai (Administrative Branch) seeking sanction after a delay of 4 to 5 months from the date of the Judgement. At times, some of the Superintending Engineers are submitting such proposals seeking sanction through Special Messengers at the 11th hour only without taking timely action well before the prescribed time given by the Court in the Judgement, even without getting the opinion of the Legal Adviser/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board. This amounts to payment of interest also in addition to the compensation awarded. The Superintending Engineers are thus responsible for the above payment of interest due to the delay in sending proposal etc. and till the date of payment.

4. The proposals sent by the Superintending Engineers to Chief Engineer/Personnel involve considerable time to scrutinise/process etc. works and to finally accord sanctions obeying Court's verdicts, much difficulties are being experienced due to paucity of adequate time gap. To overcome the paucity of time due to belated receipt of such proposals in Chief Engineer/Personnel office and also to guard against making larger quantum of payment towards interest, the following guidelines are issued:-

1. The proposal from Superintending Engineers seeking sanction of compensation in accident cases both cases of non-departmental human beings and animals, should be sent in such a manner as to reach Chief Engineer/Personnel office within 3 weeks from the date of Judgement by Courts along with the opinion of the Legal Adviser/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board without fail., thus enabling payment before the time limit prescribed therein.
  2. Proposals received beyond the 3 weeks time in Chief Engineer / Personnel Office, the concerned Superintending Engineer would be made to personally responsible and deterrent action will be taken against such defaulters.

We refer to your request for opening a Letter of Credit for US \$. 1786967 in favour of Skoda Export Company Ltd., Praha, Czech Republic, on CIF basis.

2. As per the RBI Circular AD(MA series) Circular No.7 dated 3.6.1996, all Central and State Govt. Departments, Public Sector undertakings and autonomous bodies are required to finalise their import contract on FOB/FAS basis only . In case where terms contracted are not in conformity with this policy, and in respect of earlier contracts entered into with the foreign suppliers prior to the date of RBI circular, a 'No Objection Certificate' is to be obtained from Ministry of Surface Transport, (Chartering Wing) Government of India, New Delhi. In this connection, we refer to the permission obtained by TNEB from Ministry of Surface Transport, Chartering Wing, Government of India, New Delhi, vide their reference No.SC-11018/1/97/ACO V dated 26.2.1997, for import of steaming coal on CIF basis. In the circumstances mentioned above, we express our inability to open the L.C. on CIF basis which is in violation of RBI guidelines as well as the instruction of Ministry of Surface Transport, New Delhi. Please, therefore, 'obtain No Objection Certificate' from Ministry of Surface Transport and forward to us a copy of the same to enable us to open the L.C.

Sub: Central Stores in Distribution & Project Circles - Tidying up and maintenance as Model one - Guidelines issued - Regarding.

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The Chairman after inspecting Coimbatore/South stores has remarked that the maintenance of stores was in a very bad shape and has instructed to tide up the same within 2 months and make it a model one for others to follow:-

Accordingly, Chief Engineer/Distribution/Coimbatore has initiated action to provide the required infrastructural facilities with a minimum cost so as to make the stores as a model one.

The Chairman during a review of the above subject on 19.4.97 has also instructed to make the Central Stores in each Circle a model one by taking action on the lines suggested belows:-

1. All the scrap items should be disposed off periodically so as to avoid huge accumulation and speedy realisation of the funds. Scrap disposal should be done twice a year or as and when the value of the scrap crossed Rs.2 Lakhs as already instructed vide Per B.P. (FB) No.273 (Technical Branch) dated 22.11.96.

2. The roads inside the stores premises should be black topped to the minimum level wherever required.

3. Cement platform should be provided for stacking transformers and yard materials wherever required if not already done.

4. Temporary sheds, if any, should be dismantled.

5. The existing sheds should be utilised to the optimum level by making improvement wherever required by providing racks and the materials stored in an orderly maner (Both indoor/outdoor.)

6. Worn out wiring should be replaced.

7. The compound wall should be reinforced with security fencing wherever required as per CE/Civil Design's letter No. 1) CE/CD/E3/A2/D.229/87 dt. 20/22.4.87. 2) CE/CD/E3/A2/D.279/87 dated 8/13.5.87, 3)SE/CD/E3/A2/F.Security Fencing/D.293/91 dated 17.5.91.

8. Tell-Tale Clock should be erected at 2 vulnerable locations.

9. The fire fighting equipments should be provided as per norms specified under Memo.No.SET/EE/400V/A2/Fire Extinguishers/D.39/90 (Tech.Branch) dated 19.3.90 and maintained with periodical fire drills to the staff.

10. One ramp has to be provided at a convenient location so as to enable safe loading and unloading of heavy items.

11. One extension to the nearest P & T Phone may be provided if not already available.

12. Wherever over head lines are crossing over the iron and steel yard and where heavy equipments are handled, the lines may be either deviated as per the field requirement or taken through under ground cable to the extent required to avoid accidents.

13. Drinking water and toilet facilities for men and women should be improved.

14. Utmost importance should be given to keep the entire stores premises and surroundings neat and tidy.

Immediate action should be taken on the lines suggested above to make the central stores in each Circle as a model one for emulation by other stores in the field.

The above work should be completed within two months and a confirmation report sent to Chief Engineer/Technical Audit/Chennai promptly.

2. Accordingly the Districtwise and Circlewise Targets have been worked out and furnished in the Annexures. The target for the divisions may be fixed in such a way that the division having the oldest applications gets a substantial higher target.

3. Special priority in extending supply to pumpsets may be given as per Govt. orders in force within the overall target of Electricity Distribution Circles.

4. Priority may be given to the parties who have already reported their readiness under normal priority and issue of notices may be regulated to 50% of the target including the number of parties who have already reported their readiness.

5. In the case of Revised Self Financing Scheme, the Superintending Engineer/Electricity Distribution Circles are requested to make wide publicity among the public and accept the agriculture application under this scheme so that the target can be achieved in full. Target of 5000 Nos. for those who pay Rs.10,000/- only under this category is alone shown in the Annexure-I. For those 5000 Nos. who are willing to pay entire estimate cost can be energised without any limit to the circles subject to overall State target does not exceed 5,000 Nos. Instructions in this regards being issued separately. The achievement of both Rs.10,000/- cases and cases who pay actual estimate amount may be shown separately in the 20 point return both circlewise and districtwise.

2500 Nos. in Nagapattinam Q.M. and 2290 in Thanjavur have to be done under normal priority as per registration seniority without any discrimination to mere service/one pole category as it is funded by Govt.

**B.B. - 11 (Apr.'97).**

6. The Chief Engineers (Distribution) and Superintending Engineers/Electricity Distribution Circles are requested to adhere to the targets and send monthly progress reports to the Superintending Engineer/Rural Electrification & Improvements (Distribution). Monthly progress reports shall cover the no. of agricultural service connections effected under the following categories.

- i. Pumpsets for handicapped, widows, tribals and Ex-Servicemen as per Government orders.
- ii. Jeevandhara scheme for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes under National Rural Employment Programme (NREP) and Rural Landless Employment Guarantee Programme (RLEGP).
- iii. Restoration of supply to the Agriculturists whose services were disconnected.
- iv. Spillover cases of mere service connections/one pole for Special reasons.
- v. Normal registration priority.
- vi. Drought Prone Areas Programme (DPAP) well and community wells.
- vii. Mere service/One pole category
- viii. Revised Self Financing Scheme Group (A) and Group (B) separately.

7. In case of any shortfall in achieving the target in any of the circles, the Chief Engineers (Distribution) of the region may reallocate the target to the other circles within the region without affecting the Districtwise targets. Any such modification may be intimated to Superintending Engineer/Rural Electrification & Improvements (Distribution) for information.

8. If any new circle/district is formed, the Chief Engineer (Distribution) of the Region may suitably reallocate and fix the target for the bifurcated circle/district under intimation to the Superintending Engineer/Rural Electrification & Improvements (Distribution)

Sub: Electricity—Extension of supply to Domestic Services—Instructions—Regarding.

The Honourable Minister for Health & Electricity has announced in the Assembly that in Chennai supply to the Domestic services will be effected within one month time and in other areas supply to domestic services will be extended within two months.

Hence all the Chief Engineers/Distribution of all Regions are informed that supply to all the domestic services involving mere service connections in Chennai area and also in all major towns should be effected within one month time and in rural areas it has to be given within two months. The Chief Engineers/Distribution are requested to send a time bound programme for extending supply to the domestic services involving extensions.

The Board Office Audit Branch had remarked that the instruction issued vide 13-5-96 does not appear to be correct as the revised estimate has to be prepared based on revised cost data only and not based on the issue rate as per the priced requisition. Only for the purpose of closing the Work Order the Standard issue cost has to be adopted.

Therefore the following revised instructions are issued:

1. The instruction issued vide Memo. dt. 13-5-96 (Ref. 2) may be treated as cancelled.
2. The instruction issued for preparation of revised Estimate based on revised cost data for execution as per Memo dated 23-11-94 only need be considered. The revised Estimate need not be prepared based on the Standard issue rate.
3. However, while closing the DCW work orders the Superintending Engineers/Electricity Distribution Circles are requested to adopt the latest standard rates of materials applicable for the work from the date of actual issue by proposing adjustment requisitions and devolutions. If necessary so as to avoid any revenue loss to the Board (ie. the difference in cost may be collected from the consumer in case of amount originally collected is indifitit or and to the party in case of any excess amount is collected.
