

Sub: Medical Aid - Special Surgery/Treatment - Health Fund Scheme -

Assistance to the Pensioners of the Board - Recovery of Annual

Subscription - Modified Procedure.

Ref: i) (Per) B.P. (FB) No.23 (SB) dated 2.4.1997.

ii) (Per) B.P. (FB) No.72 (SB) dated 1.11.1999

In (Permanent) B.P. (FB) No.23 (SB) dated 2.4.1997, the Board has constituted 'Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund Scheme' for giving financial assistance to the Pensioners of the Board for Special Surgery/Treatment. It has also been ordered that annual subscription towards Pensioners Health Fund Scheme should be recovered from the Pensioners for the first year from their first month's pension by the concerned Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineer who is the pension sanctioning authority, and for the subsequent years to be collected by Chief Internal Audit Officer every year from their pension and the details of recovery along with Pension Payment Order number are to be furnished to Chief Financial Controller who will administer the fund.

- 2. When return on recovery was called for, a Superintending Engineer had reported that he had not recovered any amount from the retired employees in his circle and had suggested that subscription towards pensioners Health Fund for the first month also be recovered at the Audit Branch, while authorising the second and subsequent months' pensions, since pension payment order number will be assigned only by the Audit Branch and it may also directly maintain Accounts without waiting for the return from the Superintending Engineers every month.
- 3. The Chief Internal Audit Officer has reported that the Audit Branch has no-objection for effecting the recovery of the first instalment also while authorising the second and subsequent months penision from the pensioners.

4. Accordingly, in modification of the orders issued in (Permanent) B.P. (FB) No.23 (SB) dated 2.4.1997, it is hereby ordered that recovery towards monthly subscription of Health Fund Scheme from the pensioners of the Board be effected by the Chief Internal Audit Officer himself right from the first monthly subscription of all the retired employees including in cases omitted to be recovered in the past instead of the existing practice of the recovery of the first month subscription being effected by pension sanctioning authorities, viz. Chief Engineers/ Superintending Engineers.

In the Board's Proceedings cited, one post of Legal Officer in the grade of Section Officer with special allowance of Rs.150/-p.m. was sanctioned to assist the Legal Adviser/Board Office Secretariat Branch. The above post was sanctioned when there was no post of Assistant Legal Adviser in the Legal Cell. As there are two posts of Assistant Legal Adviser in the Legal Cell now, it is decided that the post of Legal Officer need not be continued in the Legal Cell.

Sub: Loans and Advances - Technical Education Loan - Rate of fees for the

M.C.A. course - Instructions - Issued.

Ref: Board's Memo. No.41442/E2/96-3, dated 21.1.1997.

The Board is sanctioning Technical Education Loan to the employees for their wards studying in M.C.A. course. As the Government have not fixed any fee structure, as done in the case of Engineering and Medical courses, orders were issued in the Board's Memo. cited that tuition fees, special fees and other fees as eligible under the rules and as claimed by the respective colleges may be sanctioned for M.C.A. course.

- 2. It has been noticed that the sanctioning Authorities are not following any uniform procedure in regard to sanction of Technical Education Advance for M.C.A. course. To ensure uniformity, it has been decided that only tuition fee and special fee claimed by respective college should be taken into account for sanction of Technical Education Advance for M.C.A. course.
- 3. All the sanctioning Authorities are therefore instructed that only tuition fee and special fee claimed by respective college should be taken into account for sanction of Technical Education Loan for M.C.A. course. The order will be applicable for future cases in which formal sanction was not accorded. They are also requested to follow the above instructions scrupulously.
 - 4. Receipt of the above Memorandum shall be acknowledged.

Sub: Establishment - Availing of leave by the employees and Officers of the Board without Prior sanction - Avoidance of - Instructions - Issued.

Of late, it has been brought to the notice that Officers and employees of the Board are availing leave without getting prior sanction of leave from the Competent authorities. They are expected to proceed on leave only after getting leave sanctioned by the Competent authority.

- 2. As per Regulation-7 of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Leave Regulations "Leave cannot be claimed as a matter of right and Discretion is reserved to the authority empowered to grant leave, to refuse or revoke leave at any time according to the exigencies of Service". Even Casual Leave is not recognised as leave due or earned under Regulation-26(a) of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Leave Regulations and prior sanction is to be obtained from the Competent authority except on an occasion beyond his control.
- 3. All Officers and employees of the Board are therefore informed that they should proceed on leave only after getting prior sanction of leave from the Competent authority.
- 4. All Chief Engineers, Chief Financial Controllers/General & Revenue, Superintending Engineers, Chief Internal Audit Officer and all other Officers are therefore requested to ensure that the above instructions are followed scrupulously in future.

Establishmnt - Tamil Nadu Electrictiy Board - Technical and Administrative Control of Superintending Engineer/Operations under the control of Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineer (Distribution) - Orders - Issued.

(Permanent) B.P.(Ch) No.169

(Secretariat Branch)

(Per) B.P. (FB) No.112, (S.B.) dated 10.11.93.

Proceedings:-

The Superintending Engineers (Operation) at Salem, Madurai, Trichy, Thiruvalam, Chennai (Korattur) and Coimbatore are at present under the technical control of Chief Engineer (Operation), Chennai. The Superintending Engineers (Operation) are incharge of 400 KV/230 KV Grid Sub-Stations and EHT lines for their operation and maintenance.

- 2. The 110 KV, 66 KV and 33 KV Sub-Stations and HT lines are looked after by the Distribution Superintending Engineers under the Administrative and Technical Control of Chief Engineers/ Distribution.
- 3. All Administrative matters like Pay and Allowances, leave sanction, transfers, financial and accounting matters etc., of Superintending Engineers (Operation) are dealt by Chief Engineers/Distribution/Superintending Engineers/Distribution.
- 4. The Grid operation have become more complex due to low frequency operation, due to mismatch of load and generation. As availability based tariff is going to be introduced, each State is to plan for economic generation, relief at different durations of a day, the Chief Engineers (Operation) has to pay more attention to these aspects. Now, he has to co-ordinate with Independent Power Projects also besides Central generating Stations. It is proposed to modernise the Load Despatch Centre with on line control and data transfer.
- 5. These issues were discussed in detail in the Distribution Review Meeting on 22.7.2000. All Chief Engineers/Distribution. except Chief Engineer/Distribution/Chennai Region agreed to take over the 400 KV and 230 KV sub-stations, EHT lines under their control along with Superintending Engineer (Operation). Chief Engineer/Distribution, Chennai Region informed that the present arrangement of technical control over Superintending Engineer (Operation) in Chennai Region may be continued with Chief Engineer (Operation) and administrative control remaining with Chief Engineer/Distribution/Chennai. However, the control of lines in Chennai Region shall remain with Chief Engineer/Operation/Chennai.
- 6. Hence, the following re-allocation of work is ordered with effect from the date of this proceedings:-
 - 1. The Superintending Engineer (Operation)/Salem, Madurai, Trichy, Thiruvalam & Coimbatore will be placed under the full control of Chief Engineer/Distribution (Administrative, Technical and Financial). The maintenance and Operation of 400 KV, 230 KV Sub-stations and EHT lines under the control of these Superintending Engineers will be transferred to the respective Chief Engineers/Distribution. The existing arrangements of this maintenance shall continue. However, the jurisdiction for lines between regions could be decided by Member (Distribution) if necessary.
 - 2. The Superintending Engineer (Operation)/Chennai (Korattur) will continue to remain under the technical control of the Chief Engineer (Operation) without any change of the existing arrangement. The Administrative control of Superintending Engineer (Operation)/ Korattur will be with Chief Engineer (Distribution), Chennai.

It has been brought to the notice of Government that in one of the Statutory Boards of the State Government, Junior Audit Officer of a Central Government Department drawing pay in the scale of pay of Rs.2,200 – 4,000 has been appointed as Chief Audit Officer in the scale of pay of Rs.4,100 – 5,300 (pre revised) on deputation terms and condition without the specific approval of the State Government which has resulted in payment of salary and allowances against norms. Eventhough it is permissible under the terms and conditions of deputation of Central Government officials to State Autonomous Bodies to draw pay in the scale of pay of the post in which he is appointed, it is desirable that an officer holding a post in the equivalent cadre or atleast holding a post only one level below the post for which he is deputed is selected and appointed to that deputation post in the foreign body.

ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, interalia, orders were issued for extension of free supply upto 500 units to actual places of public worship with annual income less than Rs.1,000/- subject to certain conditions.

2. In the letter fifth read above the Chairman, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board has requested the Government to incorporate the following conditions in an amendment to eliminate ambiguity for availing free supply to the places of public worship to be implemented for implementation of the above Government Order.

- A certificate shall be produced every year that the annual income of the place of public worship
 is less than Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) from the District level Officers of the
 Departments concerned viz. Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Department/Tamil Nadu
 Wakf Board/Procuratore and Treasurer of the concerned Dioceses.
- ii. Service connection shall not be effected to the places of Public Worship constructed in Government Poromboke lands, Highway Roads & Porombokes and disputed lands. A certificate from the District level Officer of the respective religion certifying that the place of worship is a bonafide one is necessary for effecting service connection.
- iii. Burning of one light not exceeding 100 Watts between 6.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. only shall be allowed.
- iv. Regular bi-monthly readings will be taken and if the consumption is found to have exceeded the limit of annual consumption fixed i.e. 150 units, then the excess consumption over and above the permissible limit during the balance period of the year will be billed under L.T. Tariff-II (B) rates. In the event of non-payment within stipulated period, then the service will be disconnected.
- v. In case, the annual income of the place of public worship in any particular year exceeds Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) then free supply will not be allowed for the next year.
- vi. It is the responsibility of the consumer to safeguard the meter provided by the Board. In case of tampering of meter, the free supply will cease to be extended. In case of damages to the meter, the consumer shall bear the cost of the meter, otherwise the service is liable for disconnection.
- vii. The prospective consumers under free supply category of places of public worship are to obtain the service connection by payment of normal charges of Rs.1,200/- according to existing procedure, like any other consumer.
- viii. There shall not be any additions to the number of actual places of public worship every year getting benefit under the scheme.
- ix. In the first phase service connection to 1000 temples and proportionate number of mosques and churches shall be provided.
- x. A cut of date may be fixed for receiving applications from the places of public worship.
- xi. The Government should grant a subsidy to compensate the revenue loss to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board by implementation of this scheme.
- 3. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Chairman, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with a condition that the proposed revenue loss (after restricting the units from 500 to 150 units) to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board for implementing this scheme will not be compensated by the Government separately and it should be met out by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board from the present tariff compensation given by the Government every year.
- 4. The Religion Governing bodies are requested to send a final list of actual places of public worship with annual income of less than Rs.1,000/- as on the **cut of date** 15.8.2000 to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board for the purpose of extension of supply upto specified units of annual consumption free of charges.
- 5. The following notification wil be published in an **Extra Ordinary issue of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette** dated 6th July 2000.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Revision of Tariff Rates on supply of Electrical Energy Act, 1978 (Tamil Nadu Act, I of 1979), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Schedule to the said Act.

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force with effect on and from the 06.07.2000.

AMENDMENT

In the said Act, in the Schedule, in Part-B, under the heading "Low Tension Supply" for the proviso to sub-heading "Low Tension Tariff-II B" the following proviso shall be substituted namely:-

Provided that the actual places of public worship having an annual income of less than Rs.1,000/-(Rupees one thousand only) shall not be charged for burning of one light not exceeding power of 100 watts (one hundred), from 6.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. with restriction of 150 units per annum, by installing only a single meter per a place of public worship on payment of Rs.1,200/- (Rupees one thousand and

two hundred only) as service connection charges and in the initial phase service connections to 1,000 temple and also to proportionate number of Mosques and Churches with annual income of less than Rs.1,000/- per annum will also be provided under the scheme subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The cut off date for receipt of application from eligible places of public worship shall be **fifteenth August 2000.**
- 2. If the annual income of the places of public worship in any particular year exceeds Rs.1,000/-(Rupees one thousand only), the said places are Public Worship shall not be eligible for availing the scheme of free supply for the subsequent years.
- 3. A certificate to the annual income of places of public worship shall be obtained every year for this purpose from.
 - (i) Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments in respect of temples;
 - (ii) Chief Administrative Officer of the Tamil Nadu Wakf Board in respect of Mosque and
 - (iii) Arch Bishops Church of South India, Arch Bishops Catholic Church and Chief Pastors, Pentecost in respect of the concerned dioceses.
- 4. This scheme shall not be made applicable for the places of public worship situated in Government Poromboke lands, Highways and its Poromboke lands and disputed lands eventhough they are otherwise eligible.
- 5. If the units of consumption exceeds 150 units per annum, the excess consumption shall be charged under L.T. Tariff II B.
- 6. No split of meter facility shall be allowed and that only one connection with a single meter be provided for each places of worship.
- 7. Additional number of connection to the places of public worship shall not be provided every year under this scheme.

Proceedings:

As per the existing rules, if the multi-storeyed buildings are utilised for only domestic purposes then the water pumping motor and the common lighting in the premises around the flats etc., will attract L.T. Tariff-IA (domestic) only. If the multi-storeyed buildings are utilised for domestic and non-domestic purposes, then the supply given to water pumping motor should be charged under L.T. Tariff-IX (presently L.T. Tariff-V).

Many flat owners have represented that in the case of multi-storeyed buildings/residential complexes, even if one single flat is utilised for commercial purposes, due to the adoption of commercial/general purpose tariff for the common utilities such as common lighting, lifts, water pumping motor etc., maintenance cost had increased considerably and hence requested for reconsideration.

To mitigate the hardship to the residents of such multi-storeyed buildings - Residential complexes, after careful consideration the Board directs to adhere the following procedure.

In respect of multi-storeyed buildings/residential complexes having both domestic/commercial
utility and in the event the number of Tenements/Flats utilised for commercial purposes does
not exceed 25% of total Tenements/Flats, in such cases the LT Services relating to common
utilities such as common lighting, water supply motor, lift etc., be categorised under
L.T.Tariff-I A.

- In respect of multi-storeyed buildings/residential complexes where the number of flats/ Tenements utilised for commercial purposes exceeds 25% of the total number of Tenements/ Flats the L.T. Services relating to common utilities such as common lighting, water supply motor, lift etc., be categorised under L.T. Commercial Tariff (L.T. Tariff-V).
- 3. The authority for considering change of Tariff from L.T. Tariff-V to L.T. Tariff-IA, in such cases shall be vested with the Executive Engineers/O&M concerned and the change of tariff shall be effected by taking RTR after ensuring that the revised norms are satisfied.

The revised norms as above shall take prospective effect from the date of issue of the B.P. and past bills rendered under commercial tariff shall not be revised.
