

Proceedings:

In the Memo. cited, orders were issued depriving all Class II Officers of the Board from supplying the table articles etc., which are eligible for Class I Officers only.

2. Some of the Chief Engineers (Distribution) Regions have represented for supply of the items to Class II Officers also (viz., Assistant Executive Engineers and Assistant Engineers). The matter has been examined. After careful consideration, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby passes the following orders regarding supply of the Table articles etc., to both Class I and Class II Officers of the Board.

3. In respect of all Class II Officers of the Board, the following items with their periodicity as detailed below shall be supplied for their use with effect from the date of issue of this order:-

	Name of the Articles		Quantity	Periodicity
i)	A pen stand with 2 desk pens (Not pocket pens)	---	1 No.	Once in 2 years
ii)	Table Cloth	---	1 No.	Once in 2 years
iii)	Paper Weight	---	2 Nos.	Once in 3 years

The prescribed periodicity should strictly be followed in respect of the post and not to the individual officers who takes-over charge every time. The articles need not be replaced so long as those articles are in use without any specific period; but not before the prescribed periodicity of 2 and 3 years.

4. In respect of all Class I Officers of the Board, the items as indicated in the Memo. cited shall be supplied for their use. The periodicity prescribed should strictly be followed in respect of the post and not in respect of the individual Officers' taking charge of the post every time. So long as these articles are in use they need not be replaced.

5. Any deviation in supplying these articles to Class I and II Officers will be viewed seriously.

Sub : Establishment - Class II Service - R.W.E. employees promoted from Junior Engineer II Grade to Junior Engineer I Grade - Fixation of Pay under Service Regulations 33(b) - Clarification - Issued.

The Chief Engineer/Distribution/Coimbatore Region has requested to clarify whether 33(b) fixation under Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service/Regulations can be allowed to a Junior Engineer II Grade (who

was previously promoted from the post of Selection Grade Foreman I Grade) drawing pay in the scale of Rs.2150-3680(pre-revised) as per orders in Board's Proceedings second cited on his further promotion as Junior Engineer I Grade in the same scale of pay of Rs.2150-3680 (pre-revised) before movement to Selection Grade in the post of Junior Engineer II Grade.

2. The Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers and other officers of the Board are informed that in the above case, 33(b) fixation ensuring 5% benefit may be allowed, as was allowed in the case of promotion from Foreman I Grade to Junior Engineer II Grade, in view of the assumption of higher duties and responsibilities irrespective of the fact that both the lower post scale and the higher post scale are identical.

மின்வாரிய கையேட்டு ஆணையின்படி ஒவ்வொரு அலுவலரும் சரியாக காலை 10.30 மணிக்கு அலுவலகம் வந்து மாலை 5.00 மணிக்கு அலுவலகத்தை விட்டு செல்ல வேண்டும். இந்த சுற்றறிக்கை பலமுறை வழங்கியும், சென்னை அண்ணா சாலை மின்வளாகத்திலுள்ள பணியாளர்கள்/அலுவலர்கள் பலர் மேற்கண்ட சுற்றறிக்கையினை கடைப்பிடிப்பதில்லை. எனவே, மேற்கண்ட அலுவலக நேர ஆணையை அனைத்து அலுவலர்களும் கண்டிப்பாக கடைபிடிக்க வேண்டுமென்று அறிவுறுத்தப்படுகிறார்கள். இவ்வாணையை தவறுவோர் மீது கண்டிப்பாக நடவடிக்கை எடுக்கப்படும் என்றும் அறிவுறுத்தப்படுகிறார்கள்.

2. அலுவலக நேரத்தில் அனைத்து அலுவலர்/பணியாளர்களும் அமைதியாகவும், கண்ணியமான முறையிலும், உயர் அதிகாரிகளுக்கு உரிய முறையில் மதிப்பளித்தும், மற்றவர் பணிக்கு ஊறு நேரா வண்ணம் விளக்கம் ஏதும் தேவை எனில், மெல்லிய குரலில் கலந்துரையாடி கோப்புகளை விரைந்து பணிநிறுப்புமாறு கேட்டுக் கொள்ளப்படுகிறார்கள். மற்றும், அலுவலக நேரத்தில் மின்வளாகத்தில் சுற்றுவதோ, வெளியில் உள்ள கடைகளில் சென்று பொருள்கள் வாங்குவதோ, வராந்தாவில் நின்று பேசுவதோ, இருக்கையை விட்டு அடுத்தவர் இருக்கைக்கு சென்று பேசுவதோ உடனடியாக தவிர்க்கப்படவேண்டுமென்று அறிவுறுத்தப்படுகிறார்கள்.

Proceedings:

As per the orders issued in Board's B.P.(Ch.) No.212,(SB)dt.30.9.97, the drawing authorities should make payment of conveyance advance for purchase of motor car/motor cycle/scooter/moped by "Account Payee" crossed cheque drawn in favour of the dealer/supplier of the vehicle from whom the employee had obtained invoice. In case where the employee requests the payment specifically by means of Demand Draft, then crossed Demand Draft, in favour of the dealer/supplier might be obtained and issued at the cost of the individual employee.

2. The Superintending Engineer/Udumalpet EDC has raised a clarification as to the mode of payment to be adopted in the case of advance sanctioned for purchase of a second hand vehicle.

3. The matter has been considered in consultation with the Govt. Following the orders of the Government of Tamil Nadu, in Lr.No.56236/Salaries/99-1, Finance, dt.24.11.99, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board directs that the drawing authorities shall make payment of advance for the purchase of "second hand" vehicles viz., motor car/motor cycle/scooter/moped by "Account Payee" crossed cheque drawn in favour of the proposed seller of the second hand vehicle. In case where the employee requests the payment specifically by means of demand draft, then crossed demand draft in favour of the seller may be obtained and issued at the cost of the individual.

4. This order shall take immediate effect.

Proceedings:

Thiru. M. Jayaprakash was originally appointed as Helper(Trainee) in the Board under the compassionate grounds during 1990. Subsequently, he was selected as Junior Assistant (Accounts) by internal selection and he had joined duty on 15.12.1994. The individual has passed the S.S.L.C. examination of Kerala State (without Tamil as one of the subject).

2. As per the condition laid down in the para 3(iv) of the appointment order and the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulation 91(3) para (1) and (b) the individual should pass the II language test in Tamil conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission within the period of probation. But, the incumbent has not passed the above test within the extended period of probation also.

3. As per the Service Regulation 91(3)(b) if the employee fails to pass the language test within the period of four years, he should be discharged from service. But, the Superintending Engineer/Generation Circle/Kadamparai instead of discharging Thiru. Sub : Loans and Advances - Signing of Deeds and Documents by Departmental Officers and the loanee employee - Certain instructions - Issued.

The O&M Cell Inspection Team (Chairman's Inspection Team) during their inspection of the Chief Engineers' Offices have observed certain defects in the mortgage deed, Surety Bond, Sale Deed etc.,

submitted by the loanee employees for availing House Building Advance, Conveyance Advance, Marriage Advance and other loans and Advances. To prevent any future manipulation and to overcome any possible legal objections the following instructions are issued in connection with the execution and submission of deeds for availing loans and advances:-

- i) The mortgage deed, sale deed, surety bond, agreement etc. should bear the signature of the parties concerned at the foot of all pages of the deed/ documents. The Authorised Officer should affix the signature in all pages wherever he is the party to the deed.
 - ii) The corrections, alterations, etc., in the deed/documents should be duly attested by all concerned viz., the corrections should be attested not only by the loanee employee but also by the surety/vendor, etc. as the case may be and also by the departmental officer viz., sanctioning authority.
 - iii) Xerox copies should not be added to or annexed to the deed. The annexures etc. should be typed in green bond paper.
 - iv) The deed/ document etc. should be executed in stamp paper of proper denomination as per the Stamp Duty Act.
 - v) It should be ensured that the parties concerned viz., mortgager, mortgagee, Vendor, surety, witness etc. affix their signatures at the appropriate space assigned for them.
2. The above instructions should be followed scrupulously.

Sub : Establishment - Fixation of Pay in the Revised Scales of Pay - Permitting correction in the date of option in certain cases of employees due to reduction of pay based on Audit objection - Instructions - issued.

It has been reported in the reference 5th cited that one Thiru. J. Natarajan, Executive Engineer/Electrical, opted for fixation of pay in the 1996 Wage Revision with effect from 19.1.97 F.N. Based on his option his pay was fixed at Rs.14,150/- including three service weightage increments for having completed 27 years of service as per Wage Revision order. Subsequently, the Audit Party while auditing the revised scale fixations during 12/99, has pointed out an error in the calculation of total service and stated that only two service weightage increments were admissible in his case as the total service worked out to 26 years, 11 months and 29 days only. (Fall short of one day to 27 years). Accordingly, his pay has been reduced from Rs.14,150/- to Rs.13,800/-. The individual has submitted a revised option to come over to Revised Scales of Pay with effect from 20.1.97 instead of 19.1.97 so that he would become eligible for three service weightage whereby reduction of pay could be avoided. Hence, the Superintending Engineer/Kadamparai Generation Circle has requested to confirm whether the request of the individual for revision of option made after the time limit might be accepted, as a special case.

2. This is due to an error in the calculation of the date of completion of service which will count for increments and qualify for service weightage. To rectify such an error and to correct the date of option, employees were permitted time limit upto 25.6.1999 in Board's Memo.No.5761/C1/99-1, dated 26.3.99. In the instant case, the Audit has found the error only in 12/99 i.e. after the expiry of the above time limit.

3. After careful consideration, it is hereby ordered that in such cases, as the reduction of pay is due to Audit objection made after expiry of the time limit fixed for revision of option, the request for revision of option may be accepted as a special case and the employees be permitted to make correction in their date of option without shifting their original choice. The Superintending Engineers and other heads of offices shall allow a time limit of two months to make correction in the option from the date of intimation of reduction of pay to individual employees.

4. The orders in para-3 above shall apply only in such cases where the Audit has pointed out the error after expiry of time limit permitted in the reference 3rd cited. Revision of option due to other reasons or to switch over to other choices shall not be permitted.

Sub : Loans and Advances - House Building Advance - Insurance of house constructed/enlarged/purchased out of Board's loan - Avoidance of delay - Instructions - Reiterated.

According to Rule 11 of the Board's House Building Advance Rules, the house constructed/purchased and/or the living accommodation enlarged out of the advance sanctioned by the Board should

be insured with the General Insurance Company of India or its few subsidiaries (National Insurance Company, New India Insurance Company, Oriental Fire and General Insurance Company, United India Fire and General Insurance Company) against fire, flood and cyclone within a period of 3 months after completion of construction/purchase/enlargement of the house and the Disbursing Officers concerned may condone delays upto six months beyond the permissible period of three months for insuring the houses after completion/purchase of house in insuring/renewing the insurance policies.

2. In the Board's Memo. first cited, it has been ordered that the instructions issued under Rule 11 of House Building Advance Rules should be followed strictly, that it should be ensured that all the houses constructed/ enlarged/ purchased out of the House Building Advance sanctioned by the Board are insured without fail at the required time by the loanee Board employees and also that the insurance policies are kept alive by renewing promptly by them. It has also been ordered therein that the powers to condone delays over and above the permitted period of 3 months shall vest with the authority next higher to the sanctioning authority and that the proposals for condonation of delay should not be approved as a matter of routine.

3. In the Memo. second cited the Rule position and the instructions already issued were reiterated and it was informed that the sanctioning authorities will be held responsible if there is any failure to insure/renew the insurance policies on the part of the Board loanee employees.

4. In spite of the above instructions, a case has been sent to the Board for condonation of delay in renewing insurance by an officer who has not at all renewed the insurance policy in respect of his house constructed out of House Building Advance for more than 15 years. Such slackness and indifferent attitude on the part of loanee employees and the sanctioning authorities of House Building Advance is liable to cause avoidable financial loss to the Board and this should be curbed forthwith.

5. All the sanctioning authorities of House Building Advance are directed to take effective steps to obtain the insurance policies at the required time. Condonation of delay should not be allowed as a matter of routine. The sanctioning authorities will be held responsible if instances of any failure to insure/renew the insurance policies on the part of the loanee employees. The above instructions should be followed scrupulously. Any violation in this regard is liable for taking disciplinary action.

6. Receipt of the Memo. shall be acknowledged.

Sub: Electricity - H.T. Service Connection - Payment of current consumption charges by cheque at Chennai instead of at Circle Headquarters - Reg.

According to Clause 19.05 of the Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity, the high tension consumers have to pay the current consumption bills by cash or demand draft on local bank or cheque drawn on a Bank at the same place as the Headquarters of the Superintending Engineer.

2. Now, several representation are being received from H.T. consumers who are having their registered office at Chennai, to permit them to make payment by cheque drawn at Chennai.

3. After careful examination of the above request of the H.T. consumers, the following instructions are issued:

i) The H.T. consumers other than Chennai Metropolitan Circles (i.e. Chennai EDC/South, North, Central and West) whose current consumption charges are Rupees One lakh and above per month may be permitted to pay the current consumption charges within the due date indicated in the bill at the Headquarter's Office at Chennai. For such payment, the cheque should be drawn in favour of Chief Financial Controller, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, Chennai on any Nationalised/Scheduled Bank at Chennai. The payment should be made to Accounts Officer (Cash), Office of the Chief Financial Controller (General), Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, 800, Anna Salai, N.P.K.R.R. Maaligai, 7th Floor, Chennai - 2 before 2.00 P.M. with a covering letter containing the following details along with a copy of bill.

- a) H.T. Service Connection No.
- b) Name of the Consumer
- c) Name of the Circle
- d) Due date of the bill
- e) Amount of the bill
- f) Amount of the cheque
- g) Cheque No./Date

However, payment of current consumption charges will not be accepted in the Headquarters Office of the Chief Financial Controller (General), T.N.E.B., Chennai after the due date indicated in the bill. The payment after the due date is to be made only at the concerned Superintending Engineer's Office and in that case the Cheque/Demand Draft should be drawn in favour of the Superintending Engineer concerned on local Bank at the same place as the Headquarters of the Superintending Engineer concerned.

ii) The existing procedure of paying at Headquarter's Office of the concerned Superintending Engineer by Cash/Demand Draft or local cheque may also be continued.

iii) On receipt of cheque, the cash section at Chief Financial Controller's Office at Chennai will issue necessary stamped receipt to the consumer containing the following details:

- a) H.T. Service Connection No.
- b) Name of the Consumer
- c) Name of the Circle
- d) Month for which the C.C. charges paid
- e) Amount of bill
- f) Amount paid
- g) Cheque No./Date

The consumer has to forward a copy of receipt to the concerned Superintending Engineer.

iv) The cheques so collected in Chief Financial Controller's Office will be deposited into Board's collection account immediately. A fax message is to be sent from Chief Financial Controller's Office (A.O./Cash) to the concerned Circle daily before 4.00 P.M. about the fact of having collected the current consumption charges duly furnishing the details like H.T. S.C. No., Name of the Consumer, Due date of bill, amount of payment, date of payment, Cheque No. with date, Board's Receipt No. and date etc. Further, necessary T.C.A. (Transfer of Credit) should also be sent to the concerned Superintending Engineer with full details to regularise the transactions and to credit the consumer's account maintained at Circle Office.

4. The high tension consumers may be informed of the above facility and the procedure for their beneficial use.

Sub : Fire fighting in Substations - Instruction reissue of.

On 6.3.2000 a fire accident took place at Basin Bridge Gas Turbine Power Plant and the same was put off due to the timely action of the officers and staff.

Detailed instructions regarding fire protection in Substations have been issued and incorporated as Chapter-10 of the Code of Technical Instruction 1990.

All Chief Engineers and Superintending Engineers including S.Es./EDC., Operation are once again requested to check the fire protection scheme available in the Substation for proper usage and adequacy as per instructions already issued.

Close liaison with the local Fire Departments of Govt. and other industrial organisations is to be maintained so that their assistance could be drawn to fight a fire. For this purpose the address and telephone number of the Fire Department should be exhibited in the S.S.

The most frequent cause of the fire protection system performing unsatisfactorily is mechanical malfunction of one or more system components - a valve in a bank of cylinder fails to open, a fire detector failing to act, a sprinkler getting choked up, a pump failing to start and inadequate water in sprinkler system.

Necessary mock drills shall be conducted periodically for training the Substation staff in the usage of the fire fighting equipments. The fire fighting equipments shall be kept charged with chemicals or gas periodically.

In order to avoid delay in effecting supply to residential/commercial Flats, orders were issued vide reference second and third cited to collect flat rates as erection charges towards the cost of service connection chargeable to the consumer from the applicant for giving single phase or three phase connections to the residential/commercial Flats, promoted by flat promoters in the city of Chennai, apart from the other miscellaneous charges such as service connection charges, current consumption deposit, meter caution deposit, development charges etc.

Hence, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 49 of Electricity (Supply) Act 1948, Central Act (LIV of 1948), read with section 79 (J), the following amendments are issued to the clause 38 Schedule Part II of Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity notified in B.P. Ms. (FB) No.61 (Adm. Br.) dt.24.12.88 and amended up to 31.8.95 and published in Part-VI Section 3(b) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette No.7, dt.21.2.96 and further amended subsequently.

The amendment shall come into force with effect from 21.02.2000.

AMENDMENT

The following new sub-clause shall be added to the clause 38 schedule part II of Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity as sub clause 12.00.

12.00 Erection Charges

The Flat promoters applying for the new service connection for their newly constructed flats have to pay the Erection charges towards the cost of service connection work chargeable to consumer as noted against each.

Sub : Circuit breakers - Provision of Adequate rupturing capacity -
Instructions issue of - Reg.

While reviewing a OMCB failure, it was noticed that the rupturing capacity of the breaker was less than the fault level of the 110 KV bus to which the breaker was connected in the Sub-station.

2. It is essential that the breaking capacity (MVA) of the circuit breaking devices should be more than the fault MVA of the bus in order to make the available protection effective. Further, the associated apparatus such as bus bars, switches, connections, CTs, cable and boxes etc should also be of adequate thermal rating.

3. It may be noted that the breaker should be capable to withstand the effects of carrying through-fault current.

4. To avoid accidents due to breaker bursts consequent to inadequate rupturing capacity resulting in loss of life & materials, fire and shutdown of plant the following instructions are issued for strict adherence:

i. It has to be ensured that the increased fault MVA of a bus in Sub-stations as a result of plant extensions, erection of additional feeders etc would be within the breaking capacity of the existing circuit breaker and ratings of other associated accessories.

ii. If necessary, the existing breaker has to be replaced with higher rupturing capacity and the released breaker used in a bus commensurate with its rating/in a less demanding location. Similar action has to be taken for beneficial use of other components also.

1. Board, in B.P. first cited, directed that any organisation which has conducted energy audit by its in-house team for the first time shall necessarily conduct energy audit by an external agency, approved by TNEB and send energy audit report to TNEB, for the second time and so on.

2. Subsequently, in B.P. second read above, H.T. Services belonging to Government of India under the following categories were permitted to conduct energy audit by their own in-house energy audit team, approved by TNEB and send energy audit report to TNEB every three years.

- i) H.T. Services of Southern Railway including Electric traction.
- ii) Research Organisations of Government of India similar to Liquid Propulsion System Centre, Panagudy.
- iii) Indian Naval Service, Government of India.
- iv) Airport Authority, Government of India.

3. Further to the instructions in para 2 above, it is hereby directed that any Government of India Organisation linked to defence and nuclear establishments may be waived from external energy auditing; and such organisations may be added to the above list and may be permitted to conduct energy audit by their in-house team, approved by TNEB, if a request is made by them and furnish the energy audit report every three years.

Proceedings:

Government of Tamil Nadu have directed under G.O. in reference (i) that energy audit for the industrial sector and commercial establishments with High Tension Power Consumption shall be made mandatory. Based on the said G.O.Board has issued orders in reference (ii) to implement the same. Energy audit in H.T.Industries with maximum demand exceeding 2000 KVA was made mandatory as first phase of its programme. Further to the above, the extension of mandatory energy audit programme under Phase II to cover HT Industrial services with sanctioned demand exceeding 1000 KVA and upto 2000 KVA and HT Commercial services exceeding 1000 KVA, has been communicated in the reference(iii). As per reference (iii), energy audit is to be conducted for all the existing services coming under the above mentioned category, for all the services effected during the course of implementation and for new services to be effected there after also. Phase II activities will commence after formation of energy conservation cell.

2. The expert monitoring committee, formed for implementing the Energy Conservation measures, consisting of representatives from Tamil Nadu Energy Development Agency, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and the Chief Electrical Inspector to Government studied the problems in implementing energy audit programmes in new H.T.Services and concluded in its meeting held on 1.3.2000 that the new HT Consumers may be insisted to conduct energy audit after 3 years from the date of service connection and awareness among these consumers may be created at the time of submitting the application for availing new H.T.Services and while communicating the load sanction to the consumers. The committee recommended to implement the above suggestion.

3. After careful examination of the above proposal. Chairman has approved the following:

3.1 The new H.T.Services covered under the mandatory energy audit programmes shall be exempted from conducting energy audit for a period of 3 years from the date of service connection. For the sake of systematic and uniform approach and convenient follow up, a review may be made once every year on 1st January and notice to conduct energy audit may be issued to new H.T.Services which have completed 3 years from the date of service connection as on 1st January of every year and which are covered under the mandatory energy audit programme.

3.2 The message of awareness of energy conservation and mandatory energy audit as per Annexure I may be incorporated in the application to be issued to the firm/Industry /organisation requesting for new HT Service connection.

3.3 The points indicated in Annexure II may be incorporated in the communication of the load sanction to the new firm/Industry/ organisation.

4.0 This order will come into effect from the date of this B.P.
