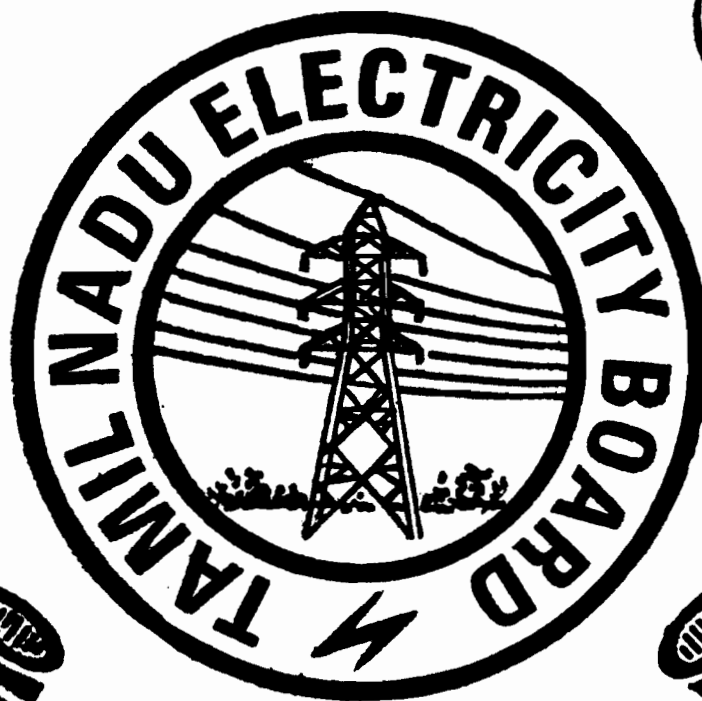

ESTABLISHMENT - Tamil Nadu Electricity Board - Creation of one post of Officer on Special Duty in the grade of Chief Engineer - Provision of High Precision/Static Meters for the existing high paying consumers by replacing the mechanical meters - Appointment of Thiru P.S. Shankar, Chief Engineer (Retired) as Officer on Special Duty - Orders - Issued.

Proceedings :

During the Chief Engineers/Distribution conference held on 12.10.2000 at Chennai, it was suggested that Precision/Static Meters may be provided to high paying consumers who are in large numbers in Chennai City. Besides, new equipments have been allotted for replacement of old equipments to improve reliability of power in Chennai City. 70 more sub-stations are to be linked to SCADA system for remote operation.

2. To advise and supervise speedy implementation of these proposals, the Chairman/ Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, hereby directs that one post of Officer on Special Duty in the grade of Chief Engineer/ Electrical be created for a period of 3 (three) months.

3. Consequent on the creation of the post of Officer on Special Duty in para 2 above, the Chairman/ Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, hereby directs that Thiru P.S.Shankar, Chief Engineer (Retired) be appointed as Officer on Special Duty for a period of 3 (three) months from the date of his taking over of this assignment. He shall be paid a monthly fixed payment of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) per month, and vehicle allowance of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only) per month. He is also permitted to retain the residential telephone for a period of three months.

4. His pay, vehicle allowance and telephone bills will be claimed and paid by the Secretary/ Tamil Nadu Electricity Board.

5. The expenditure is debitible to "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Funds - Revenue Expenses - 75 - Exmploees cost - 75-1 - Salaries - 75-110 - Salaries - Provincial. "

Proceedings :

Consequent on the revision of the pay scale and allowances to the employees of the TNEB with effect from 1.12.1996 instructions were issued in the Memo. 3rd cited to impound 50% of the arrears and to credit the amount to the GPF Account of the employees in a separate account which shall be paid to the Pensioner/Family Pensioners on or after 1.7.2003 with interest as admissible to the G.P.F.

2. The Govt. of Tamil Nadu in their G.O. Ms.No.332 Finance (Allowances) Dept. dt.20.7.1999 issued orders amending the GPF (Tamil Nadu) Rules to keep open the GPF Account in respect of the employees of the Govt. retiring before 1.4.2003 from whom the arrears of revision of pay and allowances have been credited to the G.P.F. Account.

3. As the provisions of rules 13, 28 and 29 of the GPF(Tamil Nadu) Rules are similar to Regl.15, 31 and 32 and other related regulation namely, Regulation 33 and 34 of TNEB GPF Regulation, the T.N.E.B., after careful consideration directs that the orders of the Govt. Fourth cited be made applicable to T.N.E.B., also and necessary amendments be issued to T.N.E.B., G.P.F. Regulations.

4. Accordingly, the following amendments are issued to the TNEB GPF Regulations viz.,

i. In the said regulations, in Regulation 15 after sub-Regulation (6), the following Regulation shall be added as sub-Regulation (7) viz:-

7. The authority maintaining the GPF account shall work out the interest applicable from time to time on the amount at credit in the fund account retained beyond the date of retirement of the subscriber and release the same along with the principal amount on the date specified by the Board".

ii. In the said Regulation, in Regulation 31, after the second proviso to sub-regulation(b), the following proviso shall be added namely:-

Provided also that the Authority maintaining the GPF account of the subscriber shall retain such amount credited to the Fund account of the subscriber as arrears of pay and allowances by an order of the Board upto the date as specified by the Board, even if such date is beyond the date of retirement of the subscriber".

iii. In the said Regulations, in Regulation 32, after sub-regulation(c), the following sub-regulation shall be added viz:-/

(d) "Has attained the age of Superannuation or retired voluntarily/compulsorily etc., the authority maintaining the GPF Account of the subscriber shall retain such amount credited to the fund account of the subscriber as arrears of pay and allowances by an order of the Board upto the date as specified by the Board even if such date is beyond the date of retirement of subscriber.

iv) In the said Regulations, in Regulation 33, after the proviso to clause (b) under Note (3), the following portion shall be added, namely:-

" Even after the death of subscriber the authority maintaining the GPF A/c of the subscriber shall retain such amount credited to the fund account of the subscriber as arrears of pay and allowances by an order of the Board upto the date as specified by the Board even if such date is beyond the date of the death of subscriber. It shall become payable to the nominee/nominees as per rule after the date specified by the Board.

v) In the said Regulations, in Regulation 34, after sub-regulation (4) the following sub-regulation shall be added as sub-regulation (5) namely :-

5. "The officer who is maintaining the GPF Account of the subscriber shall retain such impounded amount credited to the fund account of the subscriber by an order of the Board up to the date as specified by the Board even if such date is beyond the date of retirement/death of the subscriber".

- d. There shall be no change in the other existing rules and conditions.

Order:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have introduced the Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund-cum-Gratuity Scheme with effect from 1.4.1984. According to this scheme, all regular Government employees under Tamil Nadu Government including persons on foreign service and on deputation and the All India Service Officers belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre are required to pay a uniform rate of Rs.20/- per month till one month prior to the date of superannuation or till the subscription together with interest thereon adds upto Rs.5000/- whichever is earlier. In the case of an employee retiring on superannuation, he will be paid the actual amount of subscription recovered from him together with interest thereon and in addition, the Government will be contributing a fixed amount of Rs.5000/- In all other cases of retirement, i.e., compulsory retirement, retirement on medical invalidation etc., including death while in service, the actual subscription made by him together with interest thereon alone will be paid.

2. In the Government Order third read above, orders have been issued allowing the Government contribution of Rs. 5000/- in the case of voluntary retirement. In the Government Order Fourth read above, the Government have issued orders allowing the Government contribution of Rs.5000/- in the case of retirement on medical invalidation.

3. The Government have now decided to enhance the contribution payable by the Government, under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund-Cum-Gratuity Scheme from Rs.5000/- to Rs.10,000/-. Accordingly the Government direct that the contribution payable by the Government under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund -Cum Gratuity Scheme shall be enhanced from Rs.5,000/- to Rs.10,000/- in the case of retirement on superannuation, Voluntary retirement and medical invalidation of the Government servants.

4. This order shall take effect from the date of this order.

Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund-cum-Gratuity Scheme - Recovery of subscription on the completion of 148th instalment - Payment of interest on the employees' subscription beyond 148th instalment - Orders issued - Further orders - Issued.

Read:

1. G.O. Ms.No.62, Finance (Pension) Department, dated 11.2.1997.
2. G.O. Ms. No.207, Finance (Allowances) Department, dated 18.5.2000.

Order:

According to rule 5 of the Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund-cum-Gratuity Scheme Rules, the rate of interest shall be treated on par with the rate of interest applicable to General Provident fund subscription. The recovery of subscription under the said scheme was commenced from the month of April, 1984 and the recovery of subscription accumulated to Rs.5021/- at the end of July, 1996. The rate of interest towards General Provident Fund subscription was raised from time to time since 1984 and the rate of interest for the year 1996-97 towards General Provident Fund for the subscription was 12 percent per annum.

2. In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued allowing 12 percent per annum instead of 9 percent per annum on the second stage of interest calculation by issuing the following orders:-

- i. Those employees' subscribing to the scheme and retire before 148th instalment shall receive gross amount as per the table of repayment.
- ii. Those who have already subscribed 148 instalments at the end of the month of July, 1996 shall be paid the principal amount of Rs.5021/- plus the interest thereon at 12 percent per annum compounded annually plus the Government contribution of Rs.5000/- (now enhanced to Rs.10000). The Heads of offices/Heads of Department shall work out the interest and sanction the payment under the scheme.

3. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued reducing the rate of interest from 12% per annum to 11% per annum towards General Provident Fund subscription made by the State Government employees with effect from 1.4.2000.

4. The Government have therefore decided to reduce the rate of interest from 12% per annum to 11% per annum compounded annually payable on the amount of Rs.5021/- standing at the credit of the State Government employees at the end of July, 1996 under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund-cum-Gratuity Scheme. Accordingly, the Government direct that the rates of interest payable on the principal amount of Rs.5021/- shall be reduced to 11% compounded annually with effect from 1.8.2000. Past cases already settled prior to the date of this order at 12% shall not be re-opened.

5. An Illustration for the calculation of interest is annexed to this order.

Memorandum No.S.E./EMC/EE1/AEE/D.773/2000 (Technical Branch), dated 17.11.2000.

Sub: Offences and violation under I.E. Act, 1910 and I.E. Rules 1956 -
Compounding of - Payment of compensation by Consumers -
Further instructions - Issued.

Ref: Memo.No.SE/Plg./EE/MP/AEEE3/F.IE.Act/D.114/2000, dated 17.6.2000.

In continuation of the Memo.cited, it is informed that the Offences committed against Electricity Act 1910 Consumers are punishable with imprisonment or with the fine or with the both under I.E. Act 1910. Conviction by the Criminal Courts is after a long process and take much time. So as to relieve the accused consumers from mental agony caused due to pendency of criminal proceedings the Government of Tamil Nadu by Act 33 of 1998 have brought a new Section 50 B to the said Act 1910 which came into force on and from 15.10.98. The provisions of the said Section is as follows:-

50-B Power to compound offences - (1)

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or in any other law for the time being in force, the State Government or the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board or any other person who is competent to institute prosecution under this Act may accept from any person who has committed or is reasonably suspected of having committed an offence punishable under this Act or the rules made thereunder, by way of composition of such offence,

- (a) if such offence is punishable under Section 39 or Section 39-A or Section 44, a sum of money not exceeding one thousand rupees or twice the rates of tariff payable in respect of the electrical energy involved in such offence, whichever is greater; and
- (b) if such offence is punishable under any other provisions of this Act, a sum of money not exceeding one thousand rupees.
- (2) On payment of the sum of money specified in Sub-section (1), the person concerned, if in custody, shall be discharged and no further proceedings in respect of the offence shall be taken against such person.

2. Under Sub-section 1 of Section 50 B, the named accused who has committed or reasonably suspected to have committed theft of energy and against whom FIR is registered may if he so pleases, pay the amount towards composition fee as assessed by the Officers of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with reference to the said provision, by way of composition of offence committed by him. Thereby conviction by a criminal court can be avoided at the option of the accused consumer. When the offence committed by the Consumer falls under Sections 39, 39A and 44 of the said Act and if the amount of composition fee payable is less than Rs.1,000/- the Consumer has to pay Rs.1,000/- and if the composition amount payable exceeds Rs.1000/- twice the rate of tariff payable in respect of the electrical energy involved in such offence shall be paid by such Consumer and shall be accepted by the Officer of the Board who has lodged the complaint.

3. For the offences committed under any other provisions aof the I.E. Act, 1910, the amount payable shall be Rs.1,000/- for the composition of the offence.

4. On receipt of the money, the Officer who has lodged the complaint shall certify that the offence mentioned in the FIR has been compounded on payment of fees to the Board as prescribed under Section 50 B of the I.E. Act, 1910, which shall be produced by the Consumer to the Station Officer of the Police Station where FIR in respect of the offence has been registered. Further course of action which is only formal shall lie with the Consumer and the Police Officer.

5. If the Consumer chooses to get the offence compounded by paying the fees, the Assistant Executive Engineer/O&M concerned shall inform the Consumer to pay the amount as calculated under Section 50B of the I.E. Act, 1910. On payment of such money by the accused Consumer, the Assistant Executive Engineer shall issue certificate to the Consumer.

6. The above instructions shall be followed by the Officers when the accused Consumers come forward to compound the offence committed by him, instead of facing criminal prosecution.

Proceedings:-

The post of Chief Financial Controller is a very important post like the post of Chief Engineer in the Headquarters and hence the powers of approving the panel of Financial Controller fit for promotion to the post of Chief Financial Controller are vested with the Board. The Chief Financial Controllers in the Headquarters who are responsible for carrying out various financial matters of the Board have to assist the Accounts Member of the Board in various financial affairs of the Board. Hence, to become competent to hold the post of Chief Financial Controller, the Financial Controller before getting promotion should be well-versed in the various financial affairs of the Board which can be acquired by experience only. So also, the post of Financial Controller is the senior level important post in the Accounts Branch. The Financial Controller has to assist the Chief Financial Controller. Hence, for considering promotion to the post of Financial Controller, the Deputy Financial Controller should be well-versed in the financial matters of the Board and this can be gained by experience only. There is no specific stipulation of experience for appointment to the posts of Chief Financial Controller and Financial Controller in the Service Regulations.

2. In the absence of specific provision in the Service Regulation stipulating a period of experience for an officer to become eligible for being considered for appointment by promotion to the post of Chief Financial Controller, there is a possibility of including an officer in the panel of officers suitable for promotion to the post of Chief Financial Controller who does not possess adequate experience to discharge the important functional requirements. Such a promotion may result in the inefficient functioning of the Head of Accounts Branch with corisequential loss to the Board. In order to plug this loophole, the need for stipulating a minimum period of experience in Class I Service for a Deputy Financial Controller and Financial Controller to become eligible for promotion to the post of Financial Controller and Chief Financial Controller in line with stipulation of minimum experience for not less than eight years of service as in the case of Engineers was examined by the Board.

3. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, after careful consideration, directs that (i) a Financial Controller of the Board shall be eligible for consideration for promotion to the post of Chief Financial Controller provided he has put in an actual service of not less than eight years in Class I service and that (ii) a Deputy Financial Controller of the Board shall be eligible for consideration for promotion to the post of Financial Controller provided he has put in an actual service of not less than five years in Class-I service.

4. The above orders shall come into force with effect from the date of issue of this Proceedings.

5. Necessary amendments to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations will be issued separately.

Sub: Establishment - RWE workmen - Promotion - Fitness and
knowledge - Instructions issued.

The Superintending Engineers are informed that in some circles, while considering the circle level promotions of R.W.E. workmen, the Departmental Promotion Committee has failed to check the merit and ability of each person. In this connection, attention is invited to Regulation 98(1) (b) (i) of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations, it has been clearly prescribed

that promotion in all cases shall be made on grounds of merit and ability, seniority being considered where merit and ability approximately equal.

2. Therefore, it has been clarified the following points to follow, while considering promotion to the RWE workmen.

- i. Promotion to RWE workmen in all categories shall be considered on the basis of seniority with required educational qualification and prescribed experience for the post in the type of work concerned.
 - ii. At the time of preparing panel for promotion, the Officer under whom the RWE workmen working shall have to give a report regarding their capacity, fitness for the post of promotion with details of their technical knowledge.
 - iii. The Departmental Promotion Committee while selecting the persons for promotion to the higher posts, they shall check the merit and ability in each case like the capacity, fitness for the post of promotion and the details of technical knowledge in each person since these persons are mainly responsible for building up of public image. The incapable RWE workmen should not be considered further promotions.
3. The above points should be followed scrupulously by all the field officers .
4. The receipt of the Memo may be acknowledged.

Pension - Family Pension - Immediate sanction of Provisional Family Pension to family of Board employee who die in harness and sanction of advance from employees Family Security Fund Scheme for meeting immediate requirement of the family in case of death in harness - Orders Issued.

Proceedings:-

The Board is sanctioning ex-gratia grant of Rs.300/- on request by the legal heirs of the Board employees to meet the funeral expenses in case of death occurred while in service. This grant is admissible to the employees whose pay does not exceed Rs.5,600/- per month. Apart from above, following the orders issued by Government, it has been decided by the Board to sanction a sum of Rs.5000/- as advance from the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Family Security Fund Scheme to the legal heirs of Board employees in cases of death in harness. This amount will be adjusted in the final amount payable under the said scheme. Further, the Board has also decided to sanction Provisional Family Pension to the eligible member of the family based on the evidence produced about the death of the employee while in service and also based on the claim of the advance amount of Rs.5000/- payable under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Family Security Fund Scheme without insisting on the legal heirship certificate.

2. Accordingly the following orders are issued:-

i) In the case of death of an employee while in service, an advance of Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) from the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Family Security Fund Scheme shall be sanctioned by the pension sanctioning authority for meeting the immediate requirement of the family of the deceased employee based on the written request duly certified to by any Board Officer. This advance is adjustable against the lumpsum amount payable later under the said scheme and the adjustment should be made promptly. The nominee to the Family Security Fund or the person eligible for family pension shall be the claimant of the advance. It will be the responsibility of the claimant to satisfy the sanctioning authority that she/he is the widow/widower or child of the deceased employee. The sanctioning authority shall verify the claim with reference to the records and disburse the amount immediately.

ii) Based on the evidence produced for sanction of the above said advance, the pension sanctioning authority shall address the eligible family pensioner for making the claim for provisional family pension. The provisional family pension shall be sanctioned immediately without insisting on legal heirship certificate for a period not exceeding 12 months from the day following the date of death of the employee.

iii) After sanction of the advance and provisional family pension, the pension sanctioning authority shall obtain necessary application form, the death and legal heirship certificates along with regular sanction of family pension by him and send them to the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Board Office Audit Branch to admit/regularise the transaction and issue of authorisation for disbursement of family pension through Indian Overseas Bank.

3. These orders shall take effect from the date of issue of orders. The Heads of Offices are requested to communicate these orders to all offices under their control. Receipt of the orders shall be acknowledged.

The Government of Tamil Nadu, in their G.O. Ms.No.58, Energy (A) Department, dated 17.3.99, have constituted the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission to provide for rationalisation of Electricity Tariff, transparent policies regarding subsidies, promotion of efficient and environmentally friendly policies and for all matters connected therewith. The Commission is functioning from 6.9.99 onwards. The Member, Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission, has requested to create a Regulatory Assistance Cell in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Headquarters consisting of few Senior Officers.

2. After careful consideration, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby directs, that the Cell dealing with matters relating to the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC) under the control of Superintending Engineer/Planning shall attend to the work relating to the State Electricity Regulatory Commission also. The Officers in other wings shall extend necessary co-operation and furnish the information required by the Cell. The Chief Financial Controller/Revenue shall be Co-ordinator of the Cell.

3. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board also directs that one post of Accounts Officer be created exclusively for attending the works of State Electricity Regulatory Commission in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board for a period of 1 year from the date of utilisation by duly abolishing one post of Accounts Officer in the Board Office Accounts Branch and the post of Accounts Officer be placed under the control of Superintending Engineer/Planning.

Proceedings:-

The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board is a large organisation requiring personnel with competence and technical skills to man the various installation and equipments. Unless the employees possess necessary skills and technical knowledge, it would be difficult for the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board to run the system efficiently and supply electricity to consumers without interruption. Further, a lot of new developments are taking place in the field of power generation, transmission and distribution and the personnel should keep themselves abreast of these developments. However, the present system of promotion purely based on seniority has led to deterioration in quality at various levels. It is, therefore, desirable to introduce a proper system based on merit for promotion, so that the employees are motivated to obtain higher skills and knowledge continuously. With the above objective in view, it is proposed to have a system of examination for promotions at the following levels:-

- 1) For promotion from Assistant Engineer to Assistant Executive Engineer.
- 2) For promotion from Assistant Executive Engineer to Executive Engineer.

2. The questions in the examination will be objective type. A large number of questions have been obtained from the senior officials of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and a question bank has already been prepared. The question bank will be updated from time to time reflecting the needs of the organisation.

3. Proceedings :

The Chief Engineer/Distribution/Chennai had reported that 305 mtrs. of 185 sq.mm. earth bonding cables to the value of Rs.1,84,220/- were lost in theft occurred on 19.4.98 (Sunday) night at Chennai Development Circle Central Stores at Ambattur.

A complaint with Ambattur Police Station was lodged and F.I.R. registered. After investigation, the Police Authorities had reported that the stolen materials were undetectable.

2. The Chief Engineer/Distribution/Chennai proposed to write off the cost of the materials lost in theft on the following grounds :

i) The stores is situated just in front of the Ambattur Police Station and the area is theft prone area. The theft had occurred inspite of best efforts and alertness displayed by the watchman.

ii) The cable drums numbering 500 to 600 had been stored in open yard in an area of 20000_m² and because, of the size and height of the drums, which is about 8' to 10' the watch and ward could not have a clear view of the yard and cannot detect the movement of men.

iii) There is no trace of negligence of duty on the part of the watch and ward staff on duty warranting action against them.

In the circumstances, the proposal of the Chief Engineer/Distribution to write off Rs.1,84,220/- (Rupees One lakh eighty four thousand two hundred and twenty only) being the cost of 305 mtrs. of 185 sq.mm. earth bonding cables lost in theft on 19.4.98/20.4.98 is approved.

The write-off loss may be debited to A/c.79.882 - Loss to stock on account of Flood, Cyclone, Fire, etc.

Sub: TENDERS - Ensuring of the reasonableness of the rates quoted by the tenderers - Instructions - Issued - Reg.

The Vigilance Wing of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board has observed that some of the tenderers have formed a cartel among themselves and quoted inflated rates for various materials against open/limited tenders floated by Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and that the rates quoted did not have relevance to the basic cost of raw materials involved in manufacture of materials causing financial loss to the Board.

In order to safeguard the interest of the Board against such unethical act of tenderers the following instructions are issued.

i) All the tendering authorities shall take effective steps to ensure reasonableness of the rates quoted by L1 tenderer while processing the tenders for procurement of various materials/works contract against open/limited/single tenders floated by the Board, as the case may be.

ii) The criteria for accepting tenders shall be, not only the evaluated price or percentage variations, but also the reasonableness of the rates of the individual sub-items in respect of works contract.

iii) The reasonableness of the rates quoted by L1 tenderer may be judged by comparing with the price accepted for the same materials in earlier purchase orders/price accepted by other Thermal Stations/price accepted by other State Electricity Boards/Price accepted in other Region/Circle, updated price of earlier P.Os. in the case of variable priced items. The estimated cost of the product as per the cost data and the percentage of variation of quoted prices from the estimated cost may also be considered to arrive at the reasonableness.

iv) The reasonableness of the rate for each individual items may be ascertained by comparing with the estimated rate, PWD Schedule of rates, DGS&D rates in respect of works contracts.

v) Further, all the tendering authorities are hereby instructed to avoid/minimise exercise of discretionary powers vested in clause 23.0 and 26.0 of the Tender Regulations 1991 to avoid loss to the Board in future.

vi) The Tendering Authorities are instructed to bear this in mind while processing, evaluating and approving the tenders/works contract.

Receipt of this Circular Memo. shall be acknowledged to the Deputy Financial Controller/Tender.

Proceedings :-

The Chief Engineer/Distribution/Chennai had reported that 535 Mtrs. of U.G. Copper cables to the value of Rs.7.5 lakhs were lost due to fire accident that took place on 14.3.98 at Ambathur Central Stores of Chennai Development Circle.

A complaint with Ambattur Industrial Estate Police Station was lodged and FIR registered. After detailed investigation the police authorities had closed the case as "Accidental Fire".

2. The Chief Engineer/Distribution/Chennai proposed to write-off the cost of materials lost due to fire accident on the following grounds :

i. There were about 600 drums with the cable of 33 KV, 110 KV and 230 KV class big drums and they had been stacked side by side in the open yard, in view of their numbers and within the limited space available observing all norms of storage.

ii. As the drum was with oil filled cable, there could have been small leakage from the oil reservoir provided in the drum which could have facilitated ignition. However, the definite cause of fire could not be established beyond doubt.

iii. There is no trace of negligence of duty on the part of the watch and ward staff since the occurrence of fire was beyond the Control of Staff.

Under these circumstances, after examination by the Board the proposal of Chief Engineer/Distribution to write off Rs.7.5 lakhs (Rupees Seven Lakhs & Fifty Thousand only) being the cost of 535 mtrs. of 110 KV Single core 400 Sq.mm. oil bound under ground cables destroyed in Fire accident on 14.3.98 is approved.

The above write-off loss may be debited to A/c.No.79.882 Loss to stock on account of Flood, Cyclone, Fire etc.

The annual maintenance format followed in Erode EDC is found to be appropriate without slippage of any parameters during maintenance works. Filling up the forms does not require any writing work but ticking the appropriate boxes. On completion of the maintenance works, this format can be immediately handed over to the concerned O & M division for attending to the defects noticed during maintenance works. The approved format set is enclosed herewith.

This format may be scrupulously followed in all the MRT divisions in future.

All the Chief Engineers and Superintending Engineers of EDC are requested to review this during their inspection and ensure that the maintenance works on power transformers are carried out without any slippage. If the entries in ticking is not done, the concerned AE/AEE/EE may be held responsible and pulled up if necessary, so that proper maintenance could avert failures.

Sub: Insulation resistance measurement - Guidelines - Issued.

The insulation resistance measurement is taken with a megohm-meter/"megger".

1. MEGGER:

The megger has three terminals 'L' (Standing for line), 'S' or 'G' (Screen or Guard) and 'E' (for earth).

In taking measurement of the insulation resistance with respect of earth, the lead coming from the earth connection must be connected to the megger terminal marked 'E'. and the lead coming from the circuit element to the megger terminal marked 'L'. Any arbitrary order of connection of the leads can be used when measuring the insulation resistance between circuits say between H.V. and L.V. windings of a transformer.

If test results are disturbed by insulation surface currents (mostly the case with cables), screen electrodes are applied to the insulation and connected to terminal 'S'.

2. HAND OR MOTOR OPERATED MEGGER:

The megger may be hand driven through gearing and a centrifugally controlled clutch which slips at a predetermined speed so that a constant voltage can be obtained (500 V, 1000V).

The megger may also be motor driven, or static (1000V or 2.5 K.V.).

3. LEADS USED FOR INSULATION RESISTANCE MEASUREMENT :

The leads which are connected to the terminals of the megger must have an insulation resistance of at least 100 megohms. Also the megger and leads must be absolutely dry and clean.

4. PLACEMENT OF MEGGER AND LEADS:

The megger should be on a flat surface. When working on an outdoor sub-station in damp premises and during moist weather conditions, the megger must be placed on a rubbermat, dry board etc, while the leads must not lie on the damp ground or touch the earthed steel work or the metal frames of the apparatus.

5. CHECK ON THE MEGGER BEFORE MEASUREMENT :

Before an insulation resistance measurement is taken, the megger must be checked as follows:

With the leads shorted to each other, it should indicate zero when the handle is cranked and infinity (OC) when leads separate.

When the measurement is being taken, the handle of the megger should be turned at a uniform speed for about one minute.

6. INSULATION RESISTANCE OF A WINDING :

It is said to be a measure of conductivity through the volume of insulation. Moisture infiltration is a Chief Factor clamping down the level of insulation resistance to lower values.

7. MEASUREMENT OF INSULATION RESISTANCE OF A POWER TRANSFORMER WINDINGS AND ARRIVING THE POLARISATION INDEX :

The reading obtained on the megger is determined by the ratio of D.C. voltage applied to the winding to the current output from the instrument. The current is made up of three components and does not attain a final value straightway. There is the capacitance charge which takes only a few seconds to supply. Secondly is the charge known as di-electric absorption due to the insulation being subjected to the strain. Then comes the constant leakage through and over the insulation and this may be reckoned as measure of the insulation resistance. Final value is reached once the other two charging currents die down.

From the above, it is patent that behavior of the pointer of the megger will be an index of the condition of insulation. The pointer's deflection to a value rather quickly despite continued cranking speaks of the leakage current predominating over the other two charges to show up damp or dirty insulation.

On the other hand if insulation is sound, the di-electric absorption prevails as the leakage current is small then. The effect of di-electric absorption is noticed with the pointer rising gradually as the megger is turned usually the reading after 15 seconds is compared to that obtaining at the 60 seconds using a motor operated megger or static megger and this factor obtained is familiarly known as the Polarisation index(P.I).

P.I. is the ratio of the insulation resistance of the winding at 60 seconds to that at 15 seconds.

P.I. close to unity is questionable and dangerous condition of the insulation requiring immediate attention.

Readings at low temperature may be deceptive and hence may not reflect the condition of the insulation. Oil temperature, winding temperature and ambient temperature are to be noted along with the insulation resistance obtained. Readings at 60° C oil temperature comparison at the start with one obtained after a period of service and correlation with standard prescribed, would be a rewarding exercise to further institution of corrective measures.

On conclusion of a di-electric absorption test, discharge the winding at terminals as otherwise stored energy is likely to impart shock.

Such behaviour on the part of few officials and their subordinates is not in tune with our efforts to achieve transparency in administration and improve customer satisfaction.

It is natural that the customers delivering any letters/complaints will expect an acknowledgement from the receiving officers. It is the duty of the receiving staff/official to furnish a dated acknowledgement. A format for issue of acknowledgement is enclosed. All officers of TNEB will ensure that their staff should issue dated acknowledgements whenever any letter/application/complaint is handed over to them. Any lapses in this regard has to be viewed seriously by the supervising officials and disciplinary proceedings have to be initiated on the erring official.

All officers are requested to cyclostyle enough copies and give to all applicants.

- Sub: Electricity - Connecting of additional loads in H.T. Services - Within the Sanctioned Demand - Based on CEIG's Safety Certificate - No approval from any Officers of the Board needed - Instruction - Issued.

In the B.P.s.cited orders have been issued that the H.T. Consumers are entitled to connect additional loads in the existing service connection only with prior intimation to the Board. For such cases of connecting additional loads without prior intimation to the Board, action has to be taken as per Clause 22.01 of Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity and no compensation charges need be levied.

Of late, some Superintending Engineers are giving approval for additions and alterations (such as additional load) in H.T. Services within the sanctioned demand. And even some Superintending Engineers are seeking permission from Head Quarters as to whether additional loads may be approved since the Consumer is a litigant, violation, theft has been detected and pending in his service etc., etc.

The attention of such Superintending Engineers/Electricity Distribution Circles is invited to the Clause 22.01 of Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity wherein it is stipulated that no H.T. Consumer except those under L.T. IV Two part Tariff System, shall connect any additional load in the existing H.T. Services Connection without obtaining the prior approval of Chief Electrical Inspector to Government as required under Rule 63 of I.E. Rules 1956 and without prior intimation to the T.N.E.B to enable the Board to take a Revised Test Report from the Consumer.

The above terms are framed based on the I.E. Act 1910 Schedule VI second proviso (d) which stipulate as follows:-

"The Licencee shall be entitled to discontinue such supply, if the owner or occupier makes any alterations or additions to any electric wires, fittings, works or apparatus within such property as aforesaid and does not notify the same to the licencee before the same are connected to the source of supply with a view to their being examined and tested.

Further, in respect of H.T. Services, being two part tariff one for the demand in KVA (which alone contracted with TNEB) and the other for consumption (i.e.) the Energy (Kwh), the connected load in no way effect in tariff or billing.

Hence, prior approval of the Board for connecting additional loads in H.T. Services is not necessary. As per Clause 22.01 of Terms and Conditions, on prior approval of Chief Electrical Inspector to Government as required under Rule 63 of I.E. Rules 1956 and prior intimation to the T.N.E.B. the Consumer can connect the additional loads in H.T. Services.

Therefore all Chief Engineers of Distribution Regions and Suprintending Engineers/Electricity Distribution Circles are informed that based on the Safety Certificate as per I.E. Rule 63 issued by Chief Electrical Inspector to Government, additional loads can be permitted by the Territorial Assistant Executive Engineer/Distribution incharge of the H.T. Service immediately after the receipt of intimation from the Consumer by taking a revised test report as per the Safety Certificate. One copy of Test Report may be sent to the H.T. billing section for making corresponding entry in the Central Office record. No approval from any Office of T.N.E.B. is needed to take a revised test report. Though it has been reiterated long back, Superintending Engineers are resorting to giving approval to the Consumer. This is against the provisions of Terms and Conditions of Supply and has delayed the connecting additional loads immediately after the receipt of Safety Certificate from the Chief Electrical Inspector to Government.

Receipt of the Memo may be acknowledged.
