Proceedings :-

In the Board Proceedings first cited, the following orders were issued :

- i) " the reimbursement claim per year be restricted to one month's basic pay and the dearness allowance component on pay, as on 1.1.1995. The ceiling will be this amount and will not be changed thereafter. The claims within this annual limit be allowed based on the essentiality certificate obtained from the Authorised Medical Attendant.

- ii) that the total medical reimbursement claims shall not exceed the above annual limit admissible to the Board employee concerned, irrespective of whether it is for Board employees or his dependants and whether it is the first claim for the incumbent or not.
- iii) those entered Board's service after the date of issue of these orders, shall be eligible for Medical Allowance only. "

2) The Government of Tamil Nadu, in the Government Order second cited, had issued orders to the effect that the annual ceiling on the reimbursement of the Medical expenses shall be 60% of the revised pay. All the Unions had been consulted and their views obtained. The matter was placed before the Board and the Board examined the issue.

3) The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, after careful consideration, hereby directs that the annual ceiling on the reimbursement of Medical expenses shall be 60% of the revised pay, which came into effect from 1.12.1996.

- 4) These orders shall take effect from the date of issue of orders.

The following Notification will be published in the next issue of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

1. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 88 read with Section 91-A of the E.S.I. Act, 1948 (Central Act XXXIV of 1948), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts, the permanent employees of Meter and Relay Testing and Telephone Sections of Mettur Electricity Distribution Circle of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, Mettur Dam, who are governed by Tamil Nadu State Medical Attendance Rules, from the provisions of the said Act from 12.8.1996.

1. The above exemption is subject to the following conditions, namely:-

The employer of the said Sections of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board shall submit in respect of the period during which that Company was subject to the operation of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as the said period), said returns in such form and containing such particulars as were due from it in respect of the said period under the Employees' State Insurance (General) Regulations, 1950.

3. Any Inspector, appointed by the Corporation under sub-section (1) of Section 45 of the said Act, or other official of the Corporation authorised in this behalf, shall for the purpose of -

- i. Verifying the particulars contained in any return submitted under Section (1) of Section 44 for the said period; or
- ii. ascertaining whether registers and records were maintained as required by the Employees' State Insurance (General) Regulations, 1950 for the said period; or
- iii. ascertaining whether the employee continues to be entitled to the benefits provided by the employer in cash and kind being benefits in consideration of which exemption is being granted under this Notification; or
- iv. ascertaining whether any of the provisions of the Act had been complied with during the period when such provisions were in force in relation to the said Sections of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board be empowered to -
 - a) require the principal or immediate employer to furnish to him such information as he may consider necessary; or
 - b) enter any factory, establishment, office or other premises occupied by such principal or immediate employer at any reasonable time and require any person found in charge thereof to produce to such Inspector or other official and allow him to examine such documents, books and other documents relating to the employment of persons and payment of wages or to furnish to him such information as he may consider necessary; or
 - c) examine the principal or immediate employer, his agent or servant or any persons found in such factory, establishment office or other premises or any person when the said Inspector or other official has reasonable cause to believe to have been as employee; or
 - d) make copies of or take extracts from any register account book or other document maintained in such factory, establishment, office or other premises.

Adverting to the Provisions in Regulation 19-29 of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, General Provident Fund Regulations, the Superintending Engineers were advised in Lr.No.56739/987/F/U-III/97, dated 2.3.97, to entertain Part Final & Temporary Advance withdrawal from Tamil Nadu Electricity Board GPF for making payment towards L.I.C. premium. Based on the Circular letter, certain SE's have allowed Part Final Withdrawal for those who have not completed 15 years of service and the audit has raised objection. The SE/ Tiruvannamalai has requested clarification on the eligibility to Part Final withdrawal, and direct payment to LIC from the fund. The audit objection and the clarification sought for have been examined carefully. According to Reg.29(A) payment of LIC premium as provided in Reg.19-29 through GPF can be made applicable only to the employees contributing to GPF (Madras), contributory Pension Provident Fund Scheme and Madras Contributory Provident Fund Pension Insurance Rules, 1950. However, for having allowed payment of LIC premium based on the Circular Lr.dated 2.3.97, I am directed to issue the following further instructions:-

- 1) Payment of LIC premium out of GPF shall not be entertained in respect of the subscribers to TNEB GPF. For the policies already enrolled based on circular Lr. dated 2.3.97, payment of premium shall be continued from the GPF, and no future enrolment is allowed.
- 2) The Board shall neither make any payment on behalf of the subscriber nor take any steps to keep the policy alive and the premium amount shall be paid by means of cheque in favour of LIC of India and handed over to the subscriber for remittance. The fact of remittance with receipt details shall be obtained from the subscriber and got incorporated in the ledger card.

The above instructions shall be followed scrupulously and this communication shall be acknowledged to Chief Internal Audit Officer, Audit Branch, Chennai-2.

But in the case of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board the product manufactured for sale in electricity. Hence the fuel is used in the manufacturing process itself and not one step away from manufacture.

Hence, fuels used in the manufacture of electricity for sale can be purchased against form XVII.

Proceedings :-

The quantum of Bonus and Ex-gratia payable for the accounting year 1999-2000 to the Workmen of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board covered by the Wage Revision orders issued in the B.P. cited has been discussed with the representatives of the Unions of employees.

2. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, after due consideration, hereby directs that for the accounting year 1999-2000 the workmen of the Board, covered by the Wage Revision Orders referred to in the B.P. cited, be paid a Bonus calculated at the rate of 8.33% of the salary or wage earned by them during the said accounting year, subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the payment of Bonus Act, 1965 as amended up to-date.

3. The workmen of the Board (monthly paid and full time workmen paid from contingencies), Helper (Trainees), Office Helper (Trainees) appointed on consolidated salary and also the workmen of the State Government, Central Government and other organisations who had worked on deputation in the Board during the accounting year 1999-2000 drawing a salary or wage, including those drawing pay exceeding Rs.3,500/- per month, will be eligible for the Bonus sanctioned in para-2 above.

4. Pending the concurrence of the Government of Tamil Nadu, the Board also directs that the workmen of the Board covered by the Wage Revision orders issued in the B.P. cited and the deputationists entitled to get bonus with reference to the orders in paras 2 and 3 above, shall also be paid an Ex-gratia at the rate of 11.67% of the salary or wage earned by them, during the accounting year 1999-2000.

5. Where the salary or wage of a workman entitled to Bonus and Ex-gratia exceeds Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two thousand and five hundred only) per mensem, the Bonus and Ex-gratia payable to such employee shall be calculated as if his salary or wage is Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two thousand and five hundred only).

6. Salary or wage for the purpose of payment of Bonus and Ex-gratia will include only the following:-

- (a) Basic pay-Leave salary.
- (b) All classes of special pay (including shorthand and typewriting special pay)
- (c) Personal pay.
- (d) Additional pay for additional charge.
- (e) Additional days wage paid for work on National Holidays and Festival Holidays.
- (f) Dearness Allowance.
- (g) Personal compensatory allowance given for protecting loss of pay; and
- (h) Deputation Allowance.

The term 'Salary' or 'Wage' will not include Interim Relief, over-time pay and allowances and will not include any pay and allowances other than those mentioned from (a) to (h) above. Salary or wage for the leave surrendered by an employee during 1999-2000 should not be taken into account for computation of Bonus.

7. All the workmen, who had worked in the establishment for not less than thirty working days in the accounting year 1999-2000, are entitled to the payment of Bonus and Ex-gratia.

8. The maximum Ex-gratia amount payable shall be Rs.3501 (Rupees three thousand five hundred and one only). This Ex-gratia will be reduced on actual basis if a workman has not worked on all the working days in accounting year 1999-2000 on the analogy of the provisions under Section 13 of the payment of Bonus Act. The maximum of Bonus and Ex-gratia payable to an employee shall not exceed Rs.6000/- (Rupees Six thousand only) for the full year.

9. The Board also directs that the workmen, who are under suspension but were on duty during the accounting year 1999-2000, also be paid Bonus and Ex-gratia for the year 1999-2000 subject to the conditions mentioned above.

10. If during any part of the accounting year 1999-2000, workmen, covered by the Wage Region Order referred to in the B.P. cited, is promoted to Officer category, whose pay scale is defined with reference to (Per.) B.P. (FB) No.59, (Sectt.Br.) dated 18.7.98, shall also be paid the Bonus and Ex-gratia in a proportionate manner for the period they had worked in workmen category.

11. The workmen covered by the order cited, who had worked in accounting year 1999-2000 fully or partly but had retired/Died subsequently, shall be paid the Bonus and Ex-gratia.

12. The expenditure on the payment of Bonus shall be debitable to "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Funds - Revenue Expenses - Account No.75.501 and the Expenditure on the payment of Ex-gratia shall be debitable to Account No.75.502".

The Chairman/TNEB has accorded approval for disbursement of the above amount among eligible employees of ETPS, MTPS & TTPS as per the following guide lines :

1. ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES :

- TTPS - TNEB employees on rolls of TTPS and TTPPs.
- MTPS - TNEB employees on rolls of MTPS and MTPP
- ETPS - TNEB employees on rolls of ETPS

2. All the employees who were on rolls during the year of reward (viz. 1997 & 1997-98) and who were on actual duty (including casual leave but excluding other kinds of leave) for a minimum of 200 days during the year shall be eligible to receive the reward.

3. The reward amount shall be distributed in proportion to the salaries drawn by the employees as on 31.12.1997/31.3.1998 respectively. The terms salary means Basic Pay + Dearness Allowance.

4. The reward amount to the eligible employees of ETPS, TTPS & MTPS shall not exceed the employee's one month's wages.

The Chief Engineers/ETPS, TTPS & MTPS hereby authorised to take speedy action to disburse the reward amount confirming to the eligibility as per the above guidelines and furnish the utilisation certificate to Central Electricity Authority at once with intimation to the Chief Financial Controller and this office within three months from the date of this order.

The portion of the amount which is not utilised for the purpose for which it is sanctioned, is to be surrendered immediately to the Central Electricity Authority, New Delhi and a separate account is to be maintained in respect of this grant.

The Income Tax Circular regarding Tax deduction at source from Salaries U/S.192 of the Income Tax Act-1961 is yet to be received from the Government. Pending receipt of the circular, the following salient features are furnished below :

According to the Income Tax Act 1961, as amended by the Finance Act 2000, Income Tax is to be deducted from the Income chargeable under the head "Salaries" for the Financial Year 2000-2001 at the following rates :

6. Contribution to approved Superannuation Fund.

8. Subscription upto 10,000/- to any units of Mutual Fund or to any pension fund set up by any Mutual Fund notified under clause 23-D of Section 10 of Unit Trust of India Act 1963 as the Central Government may specify by notification.
9. Subscription to National Savings Certificate/NSS 1992 as the Govt. may notify.
10. Repayment of principal amount towards House Building Advance subject to a maximum of Rs.20,000/-.

Additional Tax Rebate

In addition to the Tax rebate of Rs.12,000/- further Tax rebate of Rs.4,000/- is allowed (i.e. maximum of Rs.16,000/- if an amount equal to Rs.20,000/- is invested on the following :

(a) Subscription to equity shares or debentures in a public company engaged in infrastructure facilities including public sector.

(b) Units of Mutual Fund referred to U/S.10 (23 D) approved by the Central Board of Direct Taxes.

Therefore, a maximum rebate of Rs.16,000/- is allowed for a maximum savings of Rs.80,000/- as stated above.

After claiming the eligible deductions under Chapter VI A and further rebate under Chapter VIII, the amount of Income Tax so arrived shall be increased by the surcharge as follows :

Rebate of Income Tax U/S.88C in case of Women Assesseees

Women Assesseees are eligible for a rebate of (1) 100% of their Tax or (2) Rs.5,000/- whichever is less. They can claim tax rebate U/S.88C of the Income Tax Act 1961. Surcharge is to be calculated after allowing this rebate and further rebate U/S.88 and relief U/S.89 (1).

Further, 10% of salary being perquisite for those officials provided with rent free quarters is to be included in the taxable income as communicated in this Office Lr.No.CFC/G1/DFC/BS/IT/AB-D5-D51/F20B/60008/2000, dt.10.02.2000.

As already informed in the reference I & II cited, the Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) are requested to deduct the Income Tax every month on the amount payable at the average rate of Income Tax on the estimated income of the Assesseees at the time of payment of salary as per the provision U/s.192 (1) of the income Tax Act 1961. The Income Tax deducted from the salaries of the employees/Officers should be remitted to the Government Account within 7 days from the date of deduction.

Any lapses on the part of the Officers/Staff concerned for the belated recovery/remittance will attract interest U/S.201 (I.A) and penalty U/S.221 of the Income Tax Act 1961.

It is therefore informed that the Officers/Staff concerned will be held responsible for failure to deduct and remit the Income Tax within the time stipulated as stated above and the Penalty/Interest will be recovered from the Officers/Staff concerned if any imposed by the Income Tax Department.

iii) The minimum current consumption deposit (initial current consumption deposit) to be held or the quantum prescribed as per (ii) above, whichever is higher is to be taken into account at the time of review. If available deposit is less than the revised Current Consumption Deposit, the balance will be collected as Additional Current Consumption Deposit.

(iv) The first review of adequacy of C.C.D. in respect of new service shall be done after 12 months from the month of service connection.

(v) As and when the adequacy of C.C.D. is reviewed, the consumer may be informed of the amount available at credit in his account towards C.C.D.

(vi) In respect of agricultural service connections other than those eligible for supply of electricity free of charge, the review will be conducted with reference to Clause 15.03."

Sub: Distribution Transformer Earthing - Instructions - Issued.

During detailed examination of distribution transformer earthing by excavating the earth, it is brought to the notice of the undersigned that in many distributions, the earth wires of ACSR used for inter-linking the earth pits and the earth connecting wire from LAs, Transformer neutral, structure earthing underneath the earth, the aluminium strands are completely corroded leaving the steel wire alone; this tantamount to no earthing at all. The fuses during earth fault current will not blow as the fault current magnitude is choked to a very great extent. The earth GI pipes are also completely eaten away below the ground leaving the portion above the earth, giving an idea that the GI earth pipe is in tact. In some distributions in the urban area recently erected within five years, the corrosion as above is taken place due to acidity conditions arounds the structure location. This corroded earthing system will definitely give rise to earth pipe resistance to ground to a high inadmissible values and this would have been revealed if earth resistance measurements are taken periodically and compared with the bench mark values obtained in the past.

However, it is a fact to be admitted that earth resistance measurements are either not at all taken or taken in an improper way and no improvements to the distribution transformer earthing laid before a few decades is not at all undertaken in majority of cases.

It is the personal responsibility of the Assistant Engineer/Junior Engineer/O&M for measuring the earth resistance and it is the personal responsibility of Assistant Executive Engineer/O&M for the completion of the work as per the schedule maintenance, specified in the code of Technical Instructions.

It is therefore instructed that the earthing of Distribution Transformer should be personally ensured by AE/JE/O&M and AEE/O&M and lapse on this will be viewed seriously.

While checking the earthing system or while providing it afresh, due to corrosion, the following aspects should be borne in mind.

1. In the past the maximum permissible earth pit resistance is 25 Ohms. Now it has been amended to 5 Ohms - refer code of Technical Instructions.

2. The GI pipe life is about 12 years as per IS-3043. It is therefore expected that once in 12 years the earth pipe is to be thoroughly examined and replaced if condition warrants.

3. GI earth pipe length should be 3 m (10 ft) and it should be driven and it should not be buried. This is as per TNEB earthing practice as per sketch No.8M/71-72 dt. 17.4.71 approved by Board and earth pit should be provided with RCC through and earth pit top should be covered with RCC slab to provide safety to the human beings and animals by preventing the inadvertent coming into contact with the earth pipe and curiosity touching etc.

4. Earth electrode resistance depends upon the following:-

i. The earth wire connections with the earth pipe. Proper Terminal lugs and GI bolt and nuts with GI washers should be provided so that resistance offered at this terminal connections will be negligible.

ii. The earth pipe to soil contact resistance. This will be negligible if it is driven to the ground thereby firm compactness between pipe and soil will be established. If desired compactness could not be established by driving the electrode, use of bentonite powder will solve this problem. For use of this, a hole bigger in size than the diameter of the earth pipe may be made and bentonite powder may be used as a back fill for the space around the earth pipe from the very bottom. The bentonite powder properties are: it will absorb 5 times of water as its weight and it swells 13 times in volume as that of its dry volume. Hence the compactness between pipe and soil will be firmly established by using bentonite powder .

iii. Soil resistivity. This in turn depends upon the soil content of electrolytes consisting of moisture, mineral and dissolved salts.

Where the soil resistivity is high, periodical use of salt and watering will solve the problem. Frequent watering the earth pits during dry season is essential.

iv) No joints in the earth wire should be used.

v) The earth pipe should not be installed in a rocky ground, as this will insulates the earth pipe from the remote ground offering very high resistance to the return path for the earth fault current flow and consequently the very purpose of earthing itself will be defeated.

Minutes of the 836th Meeting of the TNEB held on 16.10.2000 (Item 37).

Proceedings:-

As per the existing procedure, the prospective L.T. Domestic and Commercial consumers have to undergo the following procedure for getting service connection:

- i) Obtain the prescribed application form from the Section Office and submit the filled in application duly paying registration fee.
- ii) The Wiring in the premises should have been done by a licensed electrical contractors.
- iii) The application is to be signed by the Licensed electrical contractor who has done the Wiring.
- iv) The applicant should produce proof to the effect that he/she is owner of the premises or lawful occupant.

On receipt of the application in complete shape, the Section prepares estimate, collect the prescribed charges, draw materials from stores and effect supply.

2. There are complaints of avoidable delay in effecting service connections due to the procedures prescribed and hence it was felt that the procedures should be simplified to quicken the process of service connections so that the consumer is satisfied besides augmenting revenue to the Board.

3. Based on this, suggestions were called for from the Public and the Public have responded with many ideas and suggestions for simplifying the procedure. Hence, a Committee was constituted to study the various suggestions putforth by the Public to implement the system of effecting new service connections in a simplified form.

4. After, a detailed study and examination on the suggestions, a proposal was placed before the Board in its 836th meeting held on 16.10.2000 for implementing the simplified procedure for effecting new service connections in respect of all L.T services duly revising the existing application form. The Board has approved the above proposal and accordingly, the following instructions are issued for implementations:

- i) The revised application Form appended herewith is to be used hereafter for effecting new service connection in respect of all L.T. consumers
- ii) In the revised application two new undertaking are incorporated to the effect that the applicant should certify that (a) he/she is the legal owner or occupant of the premises and (b) wiring of the electrical fittings are done by the competent Licensed Contractor/Electrification.
- iii) The Board need not insist on the production of ownership documents or tenancy agreements. The Board can accept the certifications by the applicant stating that he is the legal owner occupant of the premises.
- iv) The Board may also do away with the signature and the rubber stamp of the Licenced wiring Contractor since an undertaking to the effect that the wiring is done by the Licenced wiring Contracor and as per the conditions stipulated in the Electricity Act and Rules is incorporated in the application itself.
- v) For mere service connection, the existing standardised rates (as per Annexure enclosed) may be given wide publicity. Applications can be submitted along with the Demand Draft. Any excess or shortfall in the amount may be adjusted in the ensuing current consumption bills.
- vi) The applicants may be advised to submit the applications after completing the wiring.
- vii) An official should invariably be present in the Section Office during working hours to receive the applications.
- viii) The application form shall be made available free of cost from all our offices and also through Internet. A specimen form shall be exhibited in the Notice Board of the field Offices. The xerox copies of the application form may also be accepted.
- ix) The Applications shall be accepted either in person or by post. The applicants may also be permitted to drop the applications in the Box provided for that purpose even after office hours.
- x) The intermediaries and Brokers should be discouraged to visit our offices.
- xi) While energising the services, Board shall ensure the quality of the wiring through meggering.

- xii) As it has been decided to dispense with the obtaining the signature of the Wiring Contractor in the Original Test Report, the ORIGINAL TEST REPORT format shall be modified so as to delete the signature of the wiring contractor.
- xiii) The Original Test Report shall be signed by the applicant at the time of effecting service connection.
- xiv) No other conditions need to be insisted for the service connections.

5. An amendment to the Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity incorporating the above provisions wherever necessary will be issued separately by Superintending Engineer/IEMC.
