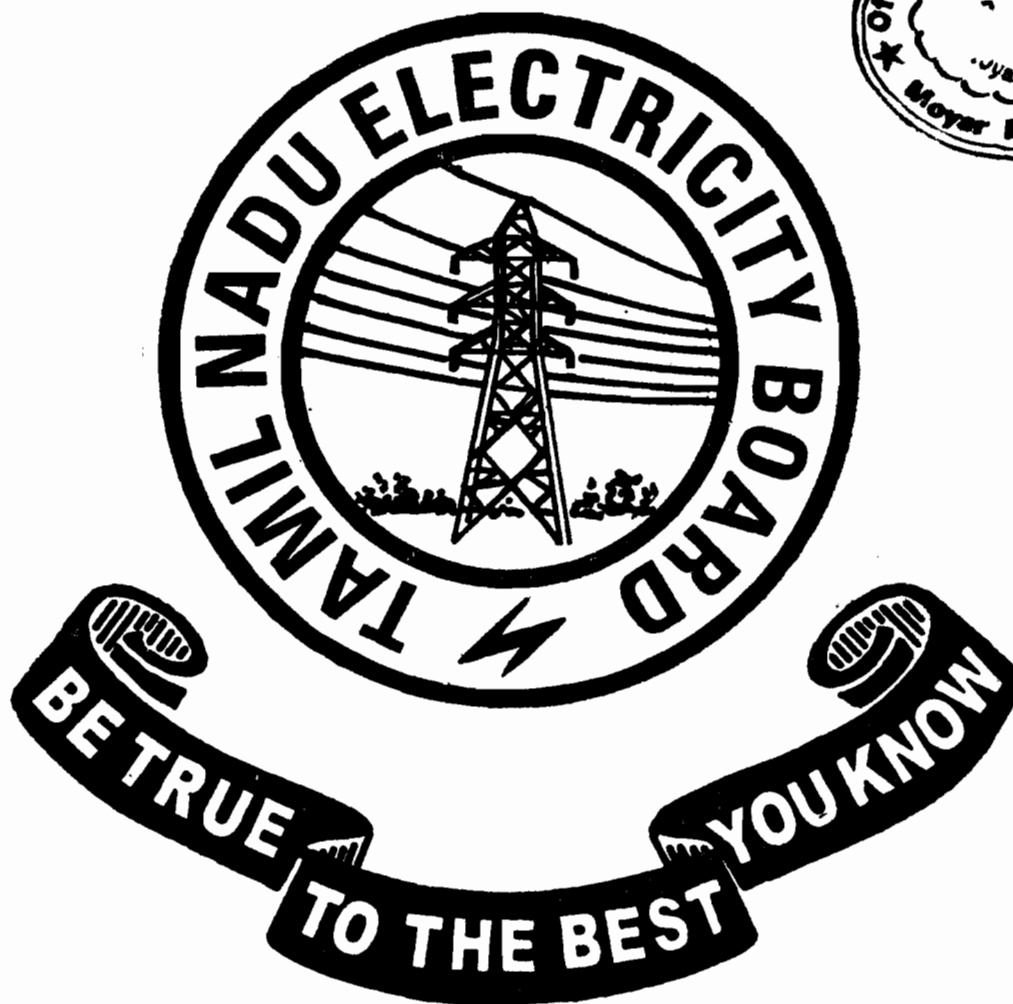

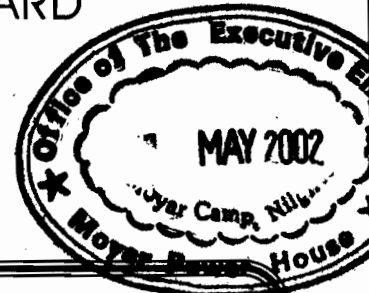

#### Proceedings:-

Orders were issued in the Board's Proceedings under reference cited, appointing certain personnel on Contract basis in the Office of the Resident Manager/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board at New Delhi and monthly consolidated wages are being paid to them. The Resident Manager/New Delhi has sent a proposal to regularise their services. As there were no regular posts to regularise their services, certain posts were created in the B.P. cited.

2. With a view to regularise the Services of the staff, the proposal of the Resident Manager/New Delhi was placed before the Board for framing suitable Ad-hoc Regulations. The Board in its meeting held on 7.5.2001 approved the proposal.

3. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby directs that the following Adhoc Regulations shall be framed viz:-

### ADHOC REGULATIONS

The provisions of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board service shall apply to the holders of the temporary posts created in the Office of the Resident Manager/Guest House at New Delhi, subject to the modifications specified in the following Regulations:-

- i) CONSTITUTION: The posts shall constitute a separate Class in the said service.
- ii) APPOINTMENT: Appointment to the posts shall be made,
  - a) by direct recruitment (or)
  - b) by transfer from any equal class.
- iii) APPOINTING AUTHORITY: The appointing authority for the said posts shall be the Chief Engineer/Personnel, Board Office Administrative Branch.
- iv) The age, qualification and Scale of Pay for the temporary posts created in the Office of the Resident Manager/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Guest House at New Delhi shall be as indicated in the Annexure.
- v) The holders of the posts in time scale of Pay shall be eligible to draw the Dearness Allowance at the rates applicable to Regular Employees of the Board. The benefit of casual leave and all other kinds of leave shall be allowed as applicable to Regular employees of the Board.
- vi) Every person appointed to the temporary posts by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of one year within a continuous period of two years.

Provided further that --

- (i) his transfer or assumption of charge does not involve the handing or taking over of securities or of moneys other than a permanent advance;
  - (ii) his early departure does not entail a correspondingly early transfer from another station of a Board employee to perform his duties; and
  - (iii) the delay on his return does not involve a corresponding delay in the transfer to another station of the Board employee who was performing his duties during his absence or in the discharge from Board Service of a person temporarily appointed to it.
- (g) Unless the authority sanctioning the transfer in any case otherwise directs ---
- (i) if holidays including Second Saturday and Sundays are prefixed to joining time, the joining time and any consequent rearrangement of pay and allowances takes effect from the first day after those holidays;
  - (ii) if holidays including Second Saturday and Sundays are affixed or suffixed to joining time, the joining time is treated as having terminated on, and any consequent rearrangement of pay and allowance takes effect from the day on which the joining time would have ended, if holidays including Second Saturday and Sundays had not been affixed or suffixed.

Explanation: The term 'holidays' used in instruction 2 (f) and (g) shall mean-

- (a) holidays prescribed or notified by or under Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881 (Central Act XXVI of 1881) and
  - (b) with reference to any particular office, a day on which such office is ordered by notification of the Government in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette to be closed for the transaction of public business, without reserve or qualification. The term does not include such local holidays as may be granted at the discretion of Board or holidays which are merely permissible or discretionary;
- (2) For the Instruction 10, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(10) When a Board employee has not availed himself of the joining time in full at the time of transfer, the number of days of joining time which have not been so availed of, subject to a maximum of 15 days, shall be credited to his earned leave account, subject also to the condition that he should apply within six months from the date of his transfer and the number of days of joining time so credited and the earned leave already at his credit together shall not exceed 240 days as on the date of his joining in the new post. For calculation of the unavailed joining time excluding Second Saturday and Sundays and holidays, the due date of joining shall be arrived at first excluding Second Saturday, Sundays and holidays, with reference to the provisions under clause (f) of Instruction 2 and then the days short availed of by the Board employee shall be deducted, with reference to the actual date of joining duty from the due date of joining already arrived at".

In the Board's Proceedings cited, the Board fixed the rate of recovery of rent for occupation of Board's Quarters with effect from 1.12.88, based on Government orders. Subsequently, the Government of Tamil Nadu, while revising the scales of pay and allowances of the Government employees with effect from 1.1.96, have also revised the rent with effect from 1.4.98 for employees who are occupying Government quarters. The Tamil Nadu Elec'y.Board has also revised the scales of pay and allowances to its employees with effect from 1.12.1996 and the revised rates of House Rent Allowance allowed to the employees of the Board were the same as followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu to their employees with effect from 1.4.98. Therefore, the rates of rent for Board's quarters also require revision.

2. The question of refixing the rent for the Board's quarters meant for occupation on rental basis was examined. The Chief Engineer/Personnel was requested in 5/2000 to get the concurrence of the Unions for adoption of orders of the Government on the revision of rent as was the practice. The Chief Engineer/Personnel had issued many references commencing from 24.5.2000 till April 2001 to the Unions with a view to give them an opportunity to express their views, if any. But the Unions have not responded so far and thus failed to avail the opportunity. As the revision in the rates of rent should be followed by the revision in the scales of pay and House Rent Allowance, it has been decided to refix the rent for Board's quarters by adopting the same method as was followed in the last occasion.

3. Accordingly, in supercession of the orders issued in the Board's Proceedings first cited, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby directs that the rent for the Board's quarters provided to the employees on rental basis shall be as follows:-

With a view to expedite the settlement of all terminal benefits on the date of retirement, the Board, in its order first cited, has directed the sanctioning authorities to effect payment of 90% of Death Cum Retirement Gratuity as well as first month pension on the day of retirement. This procedure is being followed almost in all circles except in five Branches of Chennai Head Quarters Office. As far as the retirees in the category of Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineer, and all employees in Five Branches of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Head Quarters Office, the first month's pension, 100% Death Cum Retirement Gratuity etc., are being authorised by the Audit Branch for making payment through Indian Overseas Bank Branch concerned.

2. Of late, inconveniences are being experienced by the retirees in Five Branches and by the Officers in the rank of Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers in getting payment on authorisation through the nominated Branch of Indian Overseas Bank. The matter was discussed with I.O.B. Agency Division, Chennai. It was agreed and decided to adopt a uniform procedure and accordingly the following instructions are issued.

a) The Drawing & Disbursing Officer in respect of employees of Five Branches and in respect of Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers and equal rank, shall release 100% DCRG on the day of retirement after getting sanction from the sanctioning authorities along with encashment of Earned Leave, G.P.F. Final Settlement, Special Provident Fund - Cum - Gratuity, etc., provided the pension proposals are prechecked by the Audit Branch. The first month full pension shall be authorised by the Audit Branch along with Capitalised Value. In case where precheck is not exercised by Audit Branch for obvious reasons, the instruction contained in B.P. Sub: Service Tax liability for remittance exemption for certain services - Instructions - Issued - Reg.

Ref: Circular No.889/98-2/X/T/A1(A/cs. Branch), dated 7.1.99.

In the reference cited, instructions have already been issued that the Chief Engineers/ Superintending Engineers who are availing the services of clearing and forwarding of goods transporters have to collect service tax at the rate of 5% from each bill of the service providers and remit the amount to Central Excise Authorities.

However the Government of India in the Notification No.48/98-ST, dated 2.6.98 have ordered the following:-

In the table giving details of service attracting service tax, the item in Sl.No.11, "Goods Transport Operator" may be deleted. Hence the name of service " Goods Transport Operator" mentioned in the Circular under Sl.No. 11 may be deleted.

Further as per Notification 7/99-ST/23.8.99 the clearing and forwarding agents shall hence forth pay the Service Tax in respect of taxable service rendered by them instead of the person who engages such agent with effect from 1.9.99.

In the Circular it is stated that in respect of clearing and forwarding agents, Board may have to pay service tax. In as much as in the Government of India Notification the responsibility of remitting the service tax was shifted to the clearing and forwarding agents. It is informed that in respect of all services mentioned in the list enclosed only the service provider has to remit to the concerned Excise Authorities.

In nutshell in the event of service provider claiming service tax the same shall be admitted by the bill passing authority subject to the provisions of purchase order and confirmation as to the remittance of service tax (can be obtained in the Auditor's Certificate) from the service provider before releasing the Earnest Money Deposit/Security Deposit retention amount etc.

A detailed list of services for which service tax is applicable is enclosed for ready reference.

In Circular Letter first cited, the employees were permitted to make payment to L.I.C. by making withdrawal from their G.P.F. Accounts. Based on the Circular Letter No.56739/987/F/U-III/97, dt.2.3.1997, Part-final withdrawal and Temporary Advance were allowed in certain Circles. The Superintending Engineer/Tiruvannamalai E.D.C. raised a clarification on payment of premium by availing part-final withdrawal by Subscribers who have not completed 15 years of service in the Board.

2. A detailed review was made and it is observed that according to Regulation 29-A of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board G.P.F. Regulations financing of L.I.C. Premium through G.P.F. shall be made applicable only for the employees subscribing to G.P.F. (Madras) or to CPPF Scheme and the employees governed by the Madras Contributory Provident Pension Fund Insurance Rules 1950. Thus, the employees who are admitted to T.N.E.B. G.P.F. Scheme are not eligible for payment of L.I.C. Premium covered under TNEB G.P.F. Regulations 19 to 29.

3. Based on the above Rule position, a revised instruction was issued in reference 2nd cited to the effect that for the policies enrolled with reference to Circular letter No.56739/987/F/U-III/97, dated 2.3.1997, payment of premium was allowed to continue from G.P.F. as a special case and there should not be any future enrolment.

4. The matter has been further reexamined and it is considered that a uniform policy should be followed. As it is not possible to extend the benefit to the employees of other Circles, it has been decided to withdraw the instructions issued in Circular letter dt.2.3.1997 and 16.10.2000.

5. With a view to following strictly the provisions of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board General Provident Fund Regulation on a uniform basis, it is hereby ordered that the financing of L.I.C. Premia from the G.P.F. in respect of T.N.E.B. G.P.F. Subscribers already enrolled in certain Circles be stopped forthwith. However, no recovery need be made for the payment of premium already made from Tamil Nadu Electricity Board General Provident Fund.

#### Proceedings:-

In the Board's Proceedings first cited, the Board issued orders introducing a scheme of payment of Monthly Thermal Incentive Allowance and Annual Thermal Incentive Bonus to the employees of North Chennai Thermal Power Station. The eligibility norm fixed for North Chennai Thermal Power Station is achievement of a minimum output corresponding to an annual rate of 6000 KW.Hr./KW/Year of installed capacity whereas it is 5100 KW.Hr./KW/Year for Tuticorin Thermal Power Station and Mettur Thermal Power Station.

2. It has been represented that the norms fixed for North Chennai Thermal Power Station are too high and that the same may be revised on par with Tuticorin Thermal Power Station and Mettur Thermal Power Station. The request has been carefully considered by the Board and the Board has decided to revise the norms for North Chennai Thermal Power Station.

3. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board in partial modification of the orders issued in the reference first cited, directs that the eligibility norms for drawal of Monthly Thermal Incentive Allowance and Annual Thermal Incentive Bonus to the employees of North Chennai Thermal Power Station shall be revised as below on par with Tuticorin Thermal Power Station and Mettur Thermal Power Station:-

- i) The minimum output for eligibility of Monthly Thermal Incentive Allowance shall be 5000 KWH/KW instead of 6000 KWH/KW.
- ii) For every 100 KWH/KW over and above 5000 KWH/KW (instead of existing 6000 KWH/KW), Annual Thermal Incentive Bonus shall be admissible. The quantum of Annual Thermal Incentive Bonus admissible for 5100 KWH/KW shall be the same as ordered for 6000 KWH/KW in (Per.) B.P. (FB) No. 11, (SB), dated 17.2.98.

4. There shall be no change in the existing rate of bonus admissible for every slab of further 100 KWH/KW and in the other existing conditions to be satisfied for becoming eligible for the payment of Monthly Thermal Incentive Allowance and Annual Thermal Incentive Bonus.

5. These Proceedings shall take effect from the date of issue.

Training & Development - Regular and Short term programmes for Technical & Non-technical Personnel and Prepromotion Training - Proposal approved - Orders issued - Regarding.

#### Proceedings:-

Two months regular training programmes are being conducted to the various categories of field staff in the 15 training centres and Institutes of the Board covering 1450 staff in each year. The percentage of staff trained including those covered under many special programmes are about 10%. With the present training mode, many staff may not get training in their life time.

2. TNEB having 800 Substations, 5.5. lakh Km. lines, 133 lakh consumers is aiming at excellence in service by way of quality upgradation, and minimising interruption to consumer satisfaction. To achieve this, standards in construction and maintenance are vital. If all field staff are given training once in 5 years by way of refresher courses and regular training, standards and safety can be ensured.

3. In this regard, Director/Training & Development has evolved a proposal for imparting field oriented training to all Officers and staff of the Board at various level of cadre including prepromotion training. In view of this, regular training for 2 months is restricted to 1 month confining to necessary aspects of that field only with practical orientation of 50% by concentrating onsite handson training, involving Development activities like technical adoption of Distribution Transformer structure and allied lines in coordination with the field officers.

4. Short term programmes varying from 1 to 6 days hitherto given to certain categories is extended to other categories not covered so far. One to two days training programme enabling field staff & Engineers, for awareness on Earthing and Averting Distribution Transformer Failures with practical training are also proposed.

5. Prepromotional training to all categories of staff & officers according to their turn for promotion within a year is imparted on the duties & responsibilities of the promoted post, so as to make them aware of the promoted post and discharge duties without any difficulty on promotion.

After careful consideration, Board in its 846th meeting held on 29.6.2001 has accorded approval for imparting regular, short term and prepromotional trainings, to all categories of staff/Engineers and officers in 661 training programme annually in the 15 training institutions of the Board and to incur an expenditure of Rs.90,54,030/- (Rupees Ninety lakhs fifty four thousand and thirty only) annually for conducting the training programmes as per Annexure-I & II.

Board has also accorded approval to incur an expenditure of 7,07,000/- (Rupees Seven lakhs and seven thousand only) towards the purchase & provision of 2 Nos. LCD multimedia projectors with Computer each one to Thermal Training Institute/Ennore & Transmission & Sub-Station Training Institute/Madurai at the rate of 3,53,500/- per projector, etc.

6. In respect of Thermal and Hydel personnel, many onsite programmes have been proposed separately.

7. The abstract of the proposed training programmes to be conducted in each Institute/Centre are furnished below:-

Superintending Engineer/Trichy Elec. Distn. Circle/North in the reference 2nd cited has sought clarification for correctness of Tariff applicable for the co-generation plant, HT SC No.41, M/s. Kothari Sugars and Chemicals Ltd. when there is no export of power as Board Office Audit has raised an audit objection to the tune of Rs.6,84,824/- stating that the tariff applicable for the above co-generation plant is tariff-III when there is no export of power.

It is clarified that as per Tariff Notification G.Os. if a H.T. consumer under Tariff-I (Industry) does not use the power load for more than thirty days, then the billing should be done under HT Tariff-III (Commercial). Hence, during the non-crushing period (off season) irrespective of the fact whether there is import or export of power, the HT billing should be done as below:-

- (i) Billable demand shall be sanctioned demand or recorded demand whichever is higher.
- (ii) Energy consumptions at the unit rate applicable for HT Tariff-III.

Further, it is informed that wherever the above method is not followed, billing should be revised and short fall collected from the consumers.

(Ms.) No.224, Finance (Allowances) Department, dated 7.6.2001 has fixed the rate of interest at 9.5% per annum on the accumulation at the credit of the subscribers to GPF for the financial year 2001-2002, besides allowing the rate of interest at 9.5% per annum on belated final payment of General Provident Fund accumulation remaining unpaid for more than three months on its becoming payable.

2. The T.N.E.B., has decided to adopt the above Government Orders. Accordingly, the Board hereby directs that the rate of interest shall be at 9.5% per annum on the accumulation at the credit of the subscribers in TNEB GPF for the financial year 2001-2002 commencing from 1.4.2001.

3. The rate of interest on belated final payment of GPF accumulations remaining unpaid for more than three months of its becoming payable shall also be at 9.5% per annum.

### Proceedings:-

1. Neyveli Lignite Corporation has proposed to set up a new thermal Station of 1X500 MW capacity as Thermal Station Expansion II. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board in its 845th meeting held on 7.5.2001 approves the proposal for availing entire out put of 500 MW from the Proposed T.S. II Expansion.

2. The above issue was placed before the 127th meeting of the Southern Regional Electricity Board held at Chennai on 16.6.2001, to get the concurrence of other constituents of Southern Region for allocating the entire power to Tamil Nadu. This was done as per the latest directions of Government of India. The KSEB, KPTCL and the Govt. of Pondicherry wanted a share from the proposed expansion plant but they have not indicated the quantum of power in absolute terms. The APTRANSCO clearly indicated that they do not require power from this plant.

3. The Neyveli Lignite Corporation has to submit the detailed project report and get it cleared through CEA and Govt. of India for implementation. It is expected that this plant would commence commercial operation during 2006-2007. The cost per unit from this station will be worked out based on the outcome of the petitions filed with the various High Courts against the orders of the CERC on the financial and operational norms to be adopted for existing as well as future stations effective from 1.4.2001.

4. The Board after careful consideration approves to sign a Power Purchase Agreement with Neyveli Lignite Corporation for purchase of power from the proposed thermal station II expansion with one unit of 500 MW capacity to the extent of allocation of power to Tamil Nadu as decided by the Government of India.

### Proceedings:-

National Thermal Power Corporation is expanding the existing Ramagundam Super Thermal Power Station (2100 MW) by adding one more 500 MW unit to have an ultimate capacity of 2600 M.W. The proposed expansion is having a capacity of 500 MW and the share to Tamil Nadu from this additional unit will be 118.20 MW. The project is being cleared by CEA and this power will be available from the year 2005-06.

This unit will be operated on merit order dispatch and the capital cost is indicated as Rs.3.60 crores per MW. The levelised tariff on a 25 year basis would work out to Rs.2.93 per unit. The beneficiary EBs should sign the necessary PPA for enabling the NTPC to proceed further for setting up this plant.

The Power Purchase Agreement has been examined and clause 5 relating to Return on Equity and incentive and clause 6 relating to Billing and payment need further negotiation with NTPC Chairman and AM, TNEB may be authorised to negotiate and finalise these clauses with NTPC.

The Board after careful consideration approves to sign a Power Purchase Agreement with National Thermal Power Corporation for supply of 118.20 MW of power from their proposed Ramagundam Expansion with one unit of 500 MW on the terms and conditions as discussed above.

#### **Proceedings:-**

A condition has been stipulated in the terms and conditions of supply vide clause 22.03 that no additional load/demand will be sanctioned unless all outstanding dues in the same service connections have been paid.

But no such condition has been stipulated in the Terms and conditions of supply to insist the LT/HT consumers for payment of dues when they apply for reduction of load/demand. In order to realise the arrears quickly and to safeguard the interest of the Board's revenue, it is considered absolutely necessary to incorporate the said condition in the terms and conditions suitably, as in the case of additional load/demand. This requires amendment to clause 22.03 of the Terms and condition of supply.

Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 49 of Electricity (Supply) Act 1948 (Central Act LIV of 1948) read with Section 79 (J), TNEB issues the following amendments to the clause 22.03 of Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity notified in B.P. (F.B.) No.61, (Adm.Br.), dated 24.12.88 and amended upto 31.8.95 and published in Part-VI Section 3 (b) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette No.7, dated 21.2.96 and further amended subsequently.
