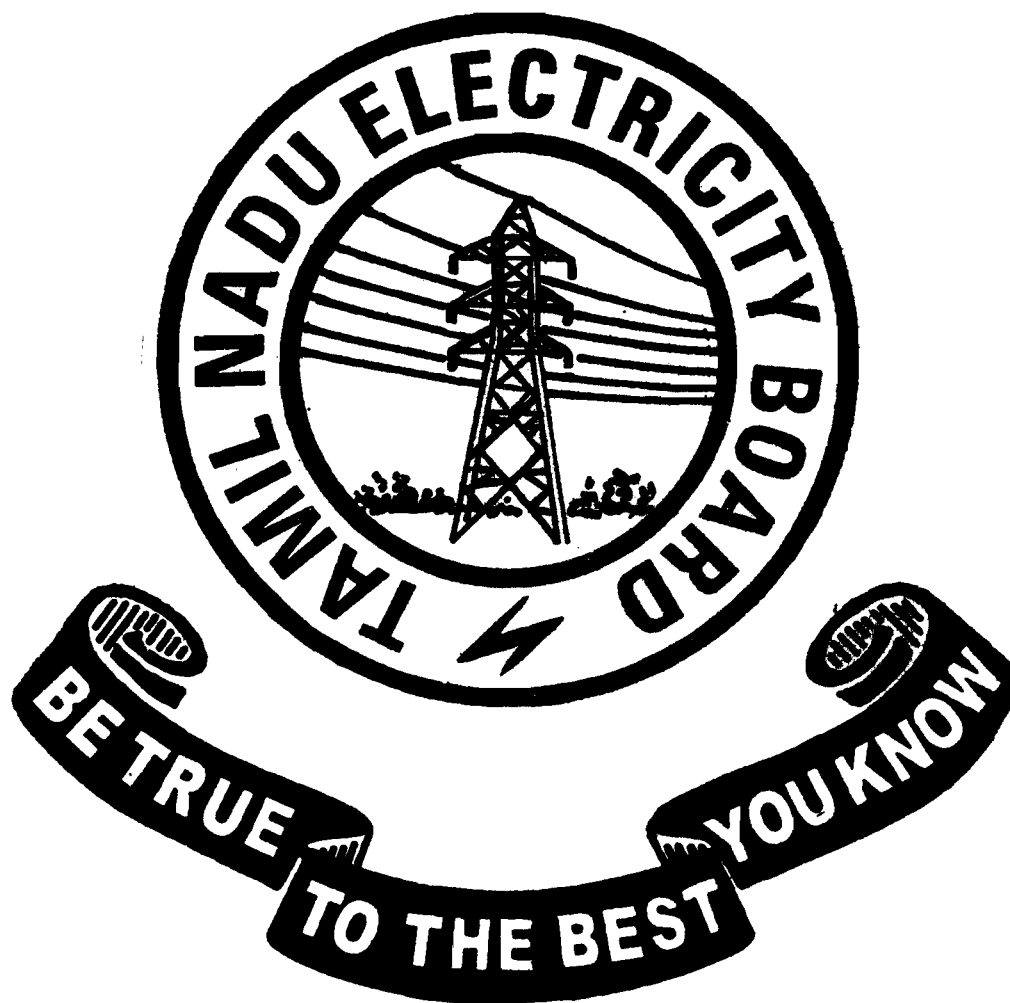

Recruitment - R.W.E. - Driver Qualification and method of appointment - Provision of internal selection to the category of Drivers - Orders issued.

Proceedings:-

As per provisions in Annexure-III to Regulation 92 of T.N.E.B. Service Regulations, the method of appointment, for all the categories of post in R.W.E. is by promotion from the next below category or by direct recruitment. The qualification prescribed for the post of Drivers in the Service Regulations is as follows:

- (a) must have passed VIII Std.
- (b) must possess Heavy Vehicle driving Licence without police/magisterial endorsement and
- (c) must have 2 years of experience in Heavy Vehicle driving.

2. There are number of vacancies of Drivers exist in the T.N.E.B. and the Chief Engineers and Superintending Engineers are pressing for filling-up these vacancies of Drivers urgently for the smooth functioning of various works in the Field.

3. As per the existing provisions only Vehicle Helpers are eligible to be considered for promotion to the post of Drivers. But there are qualified persons available in various categories of posts in R.W.E. as well as in Office Helper in provincial category. But, they could not be considered for appointment as Drivers through internal selection in the absence of requisite provision in the T.N.E.B. Service Regulations.

4. After careful examination of the matter, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board issues the following orders:-

- (i) the scheme of internal selection shall be extended to the post of Drivers and the method of appointment to the post of Drivers will hereafter be by internal selection or by promotion or by direct recruitment. The qualified employees in RWE and Office Helper in provincial category shall be considered for appointment as Driver by internal selection.
- (ii) The employee must have passed VIII Std.
- (iii) The employees must possess Heavy Vehicle driving licence without Police or magisterial endorsement and
- (iv) the rules relating to possession of 2 years practical experience in the case of appointment to the post of Drivers by internal selection need not be insisted.

ANNEXURE

Job Charter for the Officers and the Staff of the Flying Squad attached to the Board Office Audit Branch:

I. HELPER/WIREMAN - I

1. Opening the gate after removing the lead seal.
2. Cleaning the seal for checking the serial number.
3. Cleaning the yard, meter and metering box.
4. Resealing.
5. Safeguarding the metering arrangements.
6. Carrying the Testing Kits, Registers and Records.
7. Cleaning the Vehicle
8. Assisting in seizure and transport of materials.

II. HELPER/WIREMAN - II

1. Informing the consumer about the inspection.
2. Bringing the gate key and Meter Reading Card from the Consumer.
3. Opening the back cover of the LT Panel Box.
4. Arranging torch light for taking Tong Test Reading.
5. Closing of LT Panel Box after inspection.
6. Cleaning the name plates of machines and other connected load.
7. Assisting the Driver during the journey.
8. Cleaning the Office room, furniture etc.
9. Assisting for seizure and transport of material objects etc.

III. ASSISTANT ENGINEER - I & TECHNICAL ASSISTANT - I

1. To check, verify and confirm the genuineness of the Gate Seal.
2. To verify the defects in the metering arrangements.
3. To verify the seals in the Metering Box (minimum of 5 locations in each service).
4. To verify the seals in the R.M.G. (minimum of 11 locations in each service).
5. To conduct Power check and the Metering Point.
6. To reseal the Metering Box and the Gate after completion of the inspection.
7. To assist the Asst. Exe. Engineer/O&M in preparing the Intimation of Inspection letter to the consumer.
8. To assist the Asst. Executive Engineer/O&M in preparation of Seizure Mahazar at the scene of occurrence.
9. To assist the Asst. Executive Engineer/O&M in writing the complaint for filing FIR with the Police.
10. To send the Proformas and Reports to the Higher Officials.
11. To maintain the Tools and Plants and Scientific Instruments.

IV. ASSISTANT ENGINEER - II & TECHNICAL ASSISTANT - II

1. To verify and record the load current at the Consumers' end.
2. To verify the capacity of the transformer.
3. To verify and record the connected load scattered at various places in the consumer's premises.
4. To verify the Whiter Meter Card and the previous consumption pattern to find out any market drop in consumption.
5. To verify the Delivery Challans, Customs/Income Tax returns, Turn over chart etc. to confirm the genuineness for low consumption.
6. To assist the Asst. Exe. Engineer/O&M for taking load record Statement.

7. To assist the Asst. Exe. Engineer/O&M for assessment of loss of revenue to Board.
8. To assist the Asst. Exe. Engineer/O&M in preparing the list of material objects, evidences, extraneous materials, tamper devices, meters, wires, etc.
9. To prepare reports for the theft of energy detected.
10. To collect the information, particulars and data required by higher Officers.
11. To maintain various registers.
12. To maintain the vehicle and closing the LLB Register.

V. INSPECTOR OF POLICE/CONSTABLE

1. To give protection to the Flying Squad during the detection of theft of energy.
2. To travel in the vehicle along with the squad.
3. To preserve the evidences at the scene of occurrence.
4. To assist the Asst. Exe. Engineer/O&M in bringing the Police officials to the scene of occurrence.
5. To contact the local police officials effectively and get the complaint registered.
6. To maintain Police Station Register.
7. To contact the Police stations and to ascertain the present stage of each and every case.
8. Other words connected to the cases as instructed by the team leader.

VI. ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE ENGINEER

1. Leader of the Squad.
2. Overall supervision of the entire operation at site.
3. Guiding the staff and tackling the difficult situations.
4. Informing the Asst. Exe. Engineer/O&M, Asst. Exe. Engineer/MRT, Police Officers etc., and ensuring the presence at site.
5. Contacting higher officers for assistance in registering the FIR etc., whenever required.

2. For instance, in Item No.19, of the Check List, it has been asked to indicate whether the applicant has availed any benefit previously under the Health Fund Scheme either to his/her family dependant and to furnish the details.

3. In most of the proposals the forwarding authorities (Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers concerned) have not filled the Column No.19 properly, eventhough the employee has already availed assistance from Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Health Fund Scheme. It seems that most of the Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers concerned, have not ensured that the details of financial assistance granted to employees under Health Fund Scheme are entered in their Service Registers.

4. All the Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers are requested to ensure that the details of financial assistance sanctioned to the employees/officials under their control under Grant of financial assistance/Loan under Health Fund Scheme for self/dependant family members are entered in the Service Registers of the employees concerned promptly. This will help to fill up Item No.19 of the Check List by the Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers concerned after verifying the Service Register of employees.

5. The above instructions should be followed, scrupulously, by all Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers while forwarding the medical reimbursement claims of the employees for financial assistance under Health Fund Scheme.

Commercial Services as per Power Purchase Agreement inforce may be allowed to continue such adjustment of the wind energy in the L.T. Commercial Services as being done as per B.P. (FB) No.63, dated 12.4.2000 and B.P.(CH) No.252, dated 26.11.1991.

The adjustment of wind energy in L.T. Commercial Services has to be made on cost to cost basis (i.e.) the wind energy generated will be calculated at the H.T. Industrial tariff I rate prevailing and this amount will be deducted from the current consumption bill of the L.T. Commercial Services.

The Member (Distribution) was empowered to allow the consumers to pay the ACCD for more than three instalments. The above subject was subsequently transferred to Accounts Wing as per Circular Memo.No.SE/Comml./EE.1/FG.1/D.536/2001, dt. 10.9.2001.

After careful consideration, the Board in its 851st meeting held on 11.1.2002 has decided to delegate the powers of allowing more than three instalments to the consumers for paying ACCD to Member (Accounts) instead of Member (Distribution) in view of the transfer of the subject to Accounts Branch.

Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 49 of the Electricity (Supply) Act 1948 (Central Act LIV of 1948), the TNEB issues the following amendment to the Terms and Conditions of Supply notified in B.P. Certain shortcomings in storage and disposal of Scrap materials were noticed by the Vigilance Wing during their Inspection as noted below:

1. The Scrap materials are not properly arranged and found near the new materials causing chances of mixing.
2. The successful bidders back out without remitting the sale amount and thus causes accumulation of scraps.

To avoid such shortcomings, the Superintending Engineers/Electricity Distribution Circles are requested to issue suitable instructions to the officers concerned and ensure the following:

1. The Scrap materials in the Stores should be kept isolated away from the new materials to avoid possibility of mixing.
2. Speedy action shall be taken to dispose off scrap materials then and there as per the guidelines issued in (Per.) B.P. (FB) No.273, Tech. Br., dt. 22.11.96 and subsequent instructions.
3. If the successful Bidder against scrap tender does not pay the sale amount and lift the auctioned scrap within the stipulated time/extended time the E.M.D. shall be forfeited as per TR 1991 under Clause-29. If such Company's performance continues to be poor they may be recommended to the Competent Authority for Black listing. This type of clause may be stipulated in the Tender Schedule and implemented strictly.

The receipt of this memo. shall be acknowledged to Superintending Engineer/Materials Management-I.

Tender Regulations - Amendment to Transparency in Tenders Act 1998 and Rules 2000 - Price Preference to Domestic Small Scale Industrial Units and Public Sector Undertakings of the Government - Amendment - Issued.

Proceedings:

The Government of Tamil Nadu have issued the following amendments to Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act 1998 and Rules 2000.

1. In Rule 14, after Sub Rule 7 the following Sub Rule shall be inserted as 7A.

(7-A) the Tender documents shall clearly indicate the criteria for evaluation and comparison of tenders and shall also provide for Price Preference of Fifteen percent for Domestic Small Scale Industrial Units and Ten percent for the Public Sector Undertakings of the Government in respect of products and quantities manufactured by them.

2. In Rule 29, in Sub Rule 2 after clause (e) the following clause shall be added:

(f) the evaluation and comparison shall include Fifteen percent Price Preference for Domestic Small Scale Industrial Units and Ten percent Price Preference for the Public Sector Undertakings of the Government in respect of products and quantities manufactured by them.

3. In Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act 1998 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) after clause (a), the following clause shall be inserted namely:-

"(aa) domestic small scale industrial units means an industrial unit in which the investment in fixed assets in plant and machinery, whether held in ownership or on lease or by hire purchase, does not exceed Rupees One hundred lakhs, and which manufactures the goods within the State and registered with the Director of Industries and Commerce".

4. In Section 16 of the principal Act after clause (d) the following clause shall be inserted namely:-

"(dd) from domestic small scale Industrial unit for the reserved items identified by the Central Government.

Provided that where a procuring entity intends to procure any of such reserved items, the procuring entity shall procure such item from the domestic small scale industrial units and the provisions of sections 9 and 10 shall apply to such procurement".

5. After clause (f), the following clause shall be added, namely:-

"(g) of cement from the Tamil Nadu Cement Corporation Limited, or of paper from the Tamil Nadu Newsprints and Papers Limited.

Provided that:

- (a) A Committee consisting of the Secretary to Government, Industries Department, the Secretary to Government, Finance Department and the Chairman-Cum-Managing Director or the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Cement Corporation Limited shall determine the price of cement to be procured;

- (b) The price of paper shall be negotiated with the Tamil Nadu Newsprints and Papers Limited by the procuring entity.

The above amendments come into immediate effect and all the tender inviting/accepting authorities have to adhere strictly to the above Rules and Act in the tenders. However, while procuring cement from TANCEM the price determined by the authorities mentioned above may be obtained from M/s. TANCEM and Orders placed.
