In the B.P. (i) cited, Orders were issued deputing four Board Engineers of Bhavani Kattalai Barrage-1 Hydro Electric Project to Slovenia and Croatia for undergoing training relating to supply, erection, testing and commissioning of Turbine Generating Machinery.

2. Th.R. Ponchuvalayappan, Assistant Engineer/Electrical one among the four Board Engineers has returned to India without completing the training due to his ill-health. Hence, Chief Engineer/Projects has proposed Thiru S. Thangavel, Assistant Executive Engineer/Electrical to undergo the training in place of Th.R. Ponchuvalayappan, Assistant Engineer/Electrical.

3. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby accords approval that Th.S. Thangavel, Assistant Executive Engineer/Electrical, Bhavani Kattalai Barrage-II be deputed to undergo training in Croatia in assembling and testing the 2x15 MW Bulb generating Machinery for the Bhavani Kattalai Barrage-I Hydro Electric Project from 23.08.2003 to 02.10.2003 tentatively.

4. Sanction is also accorded for incurring a sum equivalent to 768.75 US Dollars (Seven hundred and sixty eight Dollars and seventy five cents) along with a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) to the above Officer towards daily allowance, Passport and Visa fees and non-recoverable kit allowance in connection with undergoing the above training. The Chief Engineer/Hydro Project/Bhavani will claim the above amount and make payment to the Officer.

Minutes of 864th Meeting of the Board held on 28.6.2003 (Item No.26).

Proceedings:

As per the existing Rules/Regulations, Tender Accepting Authority may place orders with the lowest evaluated tenderer for the entire quantity offered by such tenderer subject to his ability to supply and ensuring that the tenderer has satisfied with B.Q.R. conditions and other conditions laid down in the specification.

In some cases the lowest offer received from new entrant may be technically suitable as per the technical parameters stipulated in the specification but would not have supplied to any of the Power Utilities/ experience as required in the B.Q.R. and has to be rejected as per B.Q.R.

However, in order to have more competitive offers by having more number of sources and to encourage the new entrants, a proposal for placing order on New Entrant (with sufficient provision in BQR) for supplying upto 10% of tendered quantity who satisfies the technical parameters but does not have experience of having supplied to any Power Utility, provided, the new entrant is the lowest tenderer (LI), as there is no restriction in Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act 1998 and Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rules 2000 has been examined.

Tamil Nadu Electricity Board after careful consideration hereby orders the following guidelines:

1. Orders can be placed on new entrant where he is the lowest tenderer (LI) upto 10% of the total quantity even if the new entrant has not supplied to any of the Power Utilities and does not have previous experience but satisfies the technical/commercial terms stipulated in the specification, at the quoted/ negotiated rate of new entrant and to include such suitable provision in the B.Q.R.
2. Tender can be finalised at different rates for the remaining quantity when the proven source/ experienced supplier does not match the rate of new entrant as per Rule 31(3) of Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rules 2000. But this should be followed only when the New Entrant's rate is really unworkable and is considered as a rate enabling his entry.
3. Board's right to place upto 10% of the tendered quantity on New Entrant when the New Entrant is L1 who otherwise satisfies technical and commercial conditions except the BQR criterion of previous experience of supply to power utilities should be specifically incorporated in the tender specification.

The above guidelines have to be followed in all tenders floated in the Board with immediate effect.

The Data base of Marginal Farmers, Small Farmers and Hut consumers is available with all the Superintending Engineers of Distribution Circles. The Superintending Engineers of Distribution Circles are requested to arrange for assessment and collection of CC charges for Agricultural Service connections as detailed below at the rates ordered by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission in the Tariff Order dated 15.03.2003, communicated in the reference second cited.

The Government of Tamil Nadu has announced a cash subsidy of Rs.1000 per annum for all Marginal and Small Farmers who were availing free supply of electricity till 15.03.2003. Those with 5 HP pumpset and above will get Rs.1250 per annum. The Hut consumers will be paid Rs.100 per annum. The Government Order for release of the above cash subsidy is awaited. Hence the assessment for Marginal and Small Farmers and Hut consumers may be done after issue of the G.O. and issue of instructions in this regard from Head Quarters. **Therefore at present, the assessment of CC charges as per the orders of the TNERC may be done for Large Farmers only.**

- a. White meter cards and Green meter cards may be prepared for all the agricultural services metered and unmetered. The assessment shall be done between 16.9.2003 and 30.9.2003, for a six month period.
- b. Flat rate of Rs.250 per Horse Power per annum shall be charged in case of unmetered services. If metered service, tariff rate of 20 paise per unit subject to a monthly minimum of Rs.25 per service per month may be billed.
- c. Wherever meters have been provided prior to 16.3.2003 and the Board is not able to calculate the actual consumption from 16.3.2003, in view of non availability of readings as on 16.3.2003, the first assessment may be made based on flat rate. However readings have to be taken on the date of assessment in September 2003 for the purpose of subsequent assessments based on actual consumption.
- f. In respect of Self Financing Scheme services, they may be continued to be assessed and collected as per the existing procedure subject to levy of flat rate at Rs.250/HP/ Per Annum or 020 Ps/Unit if metered service.

GENERAL:

- a. Assessment of CC charges shall be entered in the Green Meter cards and White Meter cards. The WMC shall be handed over to the consumer at the time of assessment. Arrangements may be made for supply of adequate GMCs and WMCs to all sections.
- b. The assessment may be entered in the Meter Card Registers for accounting in Revenue Branches.
- c. Permanent Receipts may be issued at the time of collection. Therefore separate IA receipts Books may be used for this purpose.
- d. Collection Statements (Bill Abstracts) shall be prepared distribution wise in quadruplicate and copies of the same handed over to the Revenue Supervisor and one copy sent to the Revenue Branch. One copy to be made available for entering date of collection at the counter.

- e. Collection of CC charges may be made from 01.10.2003 to 15.10.2003.
- f. Necessary entries shall be made in the Collection Statement and PCBs shall be prepared.
- g. The receipts shall be signed and handed over to the consumer after collection.
- h. The amount Collected shall be handed over to the Inspector of Assessment/Revenue Supervisor/Section Officer for arranging remittance.
- i. At the end of the collection period necessary list of defaulters shall be prepared and handed over to the Section Officer for effecting disconnection.
- j. Disconnection of services of the defaulters shall be effected from 16.10.2003. However further communication will also be sent in this regard.
- k. The EE will issue authorisation for the persons who will attend the collection work and also arrange for providing suitable collection counters and records if field staff or outside agency is utilised.
- l. The Assistant Executive Engineers may be instructed to monitor proper assessment, collection and ensure remittance of the Board's money.
- m. Subsequent assessments shall be made once in six months from 16th to 30th/31st of March and September each year.
- n. Subsequent collections shall be made once in six months from 1st to 15th of April and October each year.
- o. The Executive Engineers may be directed to furnish the connected load details for all agricultural service to the Section Offices as per the data already collected and furnished to HQ.
- p. A honorarium of One Rupee per service for assessment work and 50 paise per service for collection work may be given. This work can be done by RS/IA/Assessor or by the field staff of the section. In the event of non-availability of adequate staff, outsourcing can also be done.
- q. Necessary information may be pasted in the Notice Boards available in Section Offices and Divisions exhibiting the following:
 "The Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission has fixed the following Tariff rates for Agricultural services with effect from 16.3.2003;
 - a. For metered services, 20 paise per unit subject to a monthly minimum of Rs.25 per service.
 - b. till meters are fixed, a flat rate of Rs.250 per Horsepower per annum.

The Current Consumption Charges will be assessed from 16.9.2003 to 30.9.2003 and collections will be made from 1.10.2003 to 15.10.2003 at the section offices concerned.

If the consumers fail to pay the charges on or before 15.10.2003, the services are liable for disconnection on 16.10.2003.

Subsequent assessments will be made once in six months from 16th to 30th/31st of March and September each year.

Subsequent collections will be made once in six months from 1st to 15th of April and October each year".

Proceedings:

There is a dedicated data link between Chennai and Bangalore for transmission of online data. Whenever there is a failure in this link, the entire activity of LD Centre is very much affected. To have an alternative data communication M/s. Bharath Sanchar Nigam Ltd. (BSNL) was contacted.

M/s. Bharath Sanchar Nigam Ltd. (BSNL) have suggested to avail DIAS (Direct Internet Access Service), which was introduced recently by them. With this facility we can connect internet for 24 Hrs. a day and both voice and data can be through the internet in the existing Telephone available with the customer at a minimal cost. In this a dynamic IP address (Internet Protocol address) is being provided and the computer available at LD Center can be made as an integral part of public network. Hence this computer can be connected to computers at SRLDC/Bangalore through VPN (Virtual Private Network) available at Bangalore. With this all the vital online data from SRLDC/Bangalore can be obtained at MLDC/Chennai through the secured channel.

When we are utilizing the DIAS for Data Transaction through the internet, Telephone calls may also be made simultaneously.

If the same is provided to the Sub LDCs, we can transfer data through internet on a reliable, secured network to Erode and Madurai, which is an alternate arrangement for costly Dedicated Leased Line Circuits.

Cost of availing the DIAS (Direct Internet Access)

Rs.3000/- towards Activation/Registration Charges (non refundable)

Rs.1800/- towards monthly rental up to 1.5 GB

Rs.100/- per 100 MB as additional charges over 1.5 GB.

Since the introduction of availability Based Tariff in Southern Region from 1.1.2003, all bills with RAW datas are being sent through the internet, in which the data size is about 1 to 2 MB each. Since the DIAS facility offered is of higher speed of 128 kbps, downloading the bills and the RAW datas will be easier without any breakage in communication as in the case of dial-up. Also the generation schedules from all IPPs can be transacted.

There have been representations from the consumers of multi tenant houses that the owners of residential buildings are charging the entire consumption by the tenants at the highest slab applicable for domestic tariff and that the tenants are not able to avail the lower slabs in paying the current consumption charges. The Commission, suo-motu considered these representations and obtained the opinion of TNEB.

2) Tamil Nadu Electricity Board suggested the following two options to reduce the tariff burden on the tenants in the multi tenant residential buildings.

- (i) To permit the owners of the multi tenant residential buildings to avail separate service connection under LT Tariff I A for each tenant without ceiling limit to the number of services in the same premises and without collecting additional charges.
- (ii) To notify the multi-tenant residential building under LT Tariff I C.

The Commission after having considered all aspects passes the following orders.

"The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board shall permit the owners of multi tenant houses to get separate service connection for each tenement in the same building premises without collecting Development Charges and service connection charges to the additional service connections so that the tenants can avail the benefits of lower slab. This is

applicable only to the **existing multi tenant** house services. TNEB shall follow the other conditions applicable for giving such multiple services except that more than one service is permitted in the same Door No. This order will take effect from 1.7.2003."

Proceedings:

With a view to obtaining more information on theft of energy and to make the existing Reward Scheme more effective and attractive to the Board's employees who are not in-charge of detection of theft of energy and also the members of public the following revised scheme of cash reward in respect of detection of energy theft is introduced with immediate effect.

(i) Quantum of Cash Reward:

The amount of cash award shall be 10% of the extra levy realized subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only). The award shall be given after the revenue become final, settled and collected.

(ii) Interim Cash Reward:

As the collection of entire assessed amount is likely to take considerable time, an interim cash award will be paid to the informant as soon as information is received about theft of energy and the theft of energy is detected. The interim cash award shall be 5% of the amount assessed subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only).

The details of revised scheme viz. furnishing information about theft of energy, protecting the identity of the informant, mode of payment to the informant and payment of final reward amount are indicated in Annexure-I.

ANNEXURE - I

Revised Scheme of Cash Reward(i) **Eligibility for the Reward**

The reward scheme shall be applicable only in respect of information relating to Theft of energy cases received from the members of public as well as Board's staff **who are not in charge of detection of theft of energy cases**. As the accent is on curbing theft of energy, this reward scheme is not applicable in respect of information received about violations such as unauthorised extension, connection of additional load, violation of peak hour restrictions etc whether they bring additional revenue to Board or not.

(ii) **Quantum of Cash Reward**

The amount of cash award shall be 10% of the extra levy realised subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only). The award shall be given after the revenue becomes final, settled and collected.

(iii) **Interim Cash Reward**

As the collection of entire assessed amount is likely to take considerable time, an interim cash award will be paid to the informant as soon as information is received about theft of energy and the theft of energy is detected. The interim cash award shall be 5% of the amount assessed subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees five thousands only). To avoid delay in the payment of initial reward amount of Rs. 5,000/- the Executive Engineers of Enforcement Wing are authorised to make the payment to the informant after due identification and after obtaining stamped receipt from them. The C.I.A.O. will arrange for payment in respect of theft of energy detected by Flying Squads. After payment, the Chief Internal Audit Officer/ Executive Engineer/Enforcement will inform the Additional Director General of Police/Vigilance and Chairman about the payment made.

(iv) **Furnishing of information about Theft of Energy**

In order to become eligible for the reward, the informant should furnish full particulars required for prompt detection of theft of energy, such as name and address of the consumer, manner in which theft of energy is committed etc., either in person or in writing. The information about theft of energy may be given over phone also. Information about theft of energy could be given to any of the following officials:-

1. Chairman/TNEB
2. Additional Director General of Police/Vigilance/TNEB
3. Chief Engineer/Enforcement/Chennai
4. Chief Internal Audit Officer.

In case, where the Information has been furnished by more than one person in a single case, the reward will be given to the person who has furnished the information first, in writing.

Protecting the identity of the Informant

The identity of the informant shall be kept Secret.

Maintaining of Register to record information about theft of energy and assignment of Secret Number.

A register will be maintained in the personal custody of Chief Engineer/Enforcement/Chennai and Chief Internal Audit Officer/Chennai. Information about the name and addresses of the offender, name and full address of the informant, Date of receipt of information, brief details of information about theft of Energy, Amount assessed, the amount of reward given, date of payment of Reward etc and other relevant information will be recorded in the register at each stage. Chief Engineer/Enforcement/Chennai and Chief Internal Audit Officer/Chennai after recording each information about the theft of energy, will assign a special number called as Reward Information Scheme No.(RIS). The contents of the information about theft of energy quoting only the RIS No. will be passed on to Executive Engineer/Enforcement Wing/Flying Squad by Chief Engineer/Enforcement and Chief Internal Audit Officer respectively for investigation and detection of alleged case of Theft of energy. The name and addresses of informant **will not be divulged** on any account.

Procedure for recording information about theft of Energy received in person as well as over phone.

Information about theft of energy received over phone shall be recorded in a Register with the details as indicated in Annexure-II.

The Informer may be identified by calling and confirming his/her phone/mobile number and the confirmation recorded. The informant may also be informed that unless he/she sends the information by post (preferably Registered Post with Acknowledgement due) he will not be eligible for cash reward. On receipt of information the same shall be registered, RIS No. assigned and forwarded to the Executive Engineer/Enforcement/Flying Squad concerned.

Information received in person may also be registered in the same Register and the persons identity (ID card/Ration card/any other identity) may be recorded. The signature, Thumb Impression of the informer may also be obtained in the register.

Communication about theft of energy cases detected by the Enforcement Wing/Flying Squad

Executive Engineer (Enforcement)/Flying Squad as the case may be, on detection of theft of energy will report to the Chief Engineer/Enforcement/Chennai & Chief Internal Audit Officer in the existing proforma the details of the energy theft detected specifically mentioning the RIS number allotted by the Chief Engineer (Enforcement)/Chief Internal Audit Officer.

Issue of Sanction order

The Deputy Secretary/Vigilance will arrange to issue sanction order for the initial Cash Reward in the case of Theft of energy detected by the Enforcement Wing. Similarly the Chief Internal Audit Officer will issue sanction order in respect of Theft of energy detected by Flying Squad. For this purpose necessary proposals will be sent by Chief Engineer/Enforcement and Assistant Executive Engineer/Flying Squad to the Deputy Secretary/Vigilance/Chief Internal Audit Officer respectively. In the sanction order only RIS Number will be mentioned and the order will not contain anything about the identity of the informant.

Drawal of Bill for Reward Amount

For every sanction, a bill will be drawn by the Under Secretary/ Establishment/BOSB (for cases detected by Enforcement) and CIAO (For cases detected by Flying Squad) respectively quoting only the RIS No. and enclosing a copy of the sanction order issued by Deputy Secretary/Vigilance or Chief Internal Audit Officer as the case may be.

The bill will be presented to Board Office Audit Branch. The passed bill will be sent to Board Office Accounts Branch for issue of cheque.

Drawal of cheque

The name of the informant and RIS No. allotted will be furnished to the Chief Financial Controller / Accounts Branch by the Chief Engineer/Enforcement/Chief Internal Audit Officer as the case, may be, for issue of cheque. The Chief Financial Controller will arrange to issue crossed cheque in favour of the informant. For payment outside Chennai, the Chief Financial Controller will arrange for "at par facility" for encashment of cheques.

Mode of payment to the Informant

In respect of the initial payment to the informant (Source information) the crossed cheque for the amount along with the name and address of the informant will be sent to the concerned Executive Engineer/Enforcement and Flying Squad who will make the payment after due identification and after obtaining stamped receipt from the informant. The informant can be identified, based on documents such as Family Ration Card, Voters identity Card, Passport, Bank Pass Book, Certificate of identification from revenue officials such as Village Administrative Officer/Revenue Inspector etc., Executive Engineer (Enforcement)/Assistant Executive Engineer/Flying Squad shall send the stamped receipt to Deputy Secretary, Vigilance/Chief Internal Audit Officer indicating details of payment made.

Payment of final reward amount

When the assessment is final, settled, collected and appeal from the consumer, if any, is disposed off, the final payment will be made. The same procedures indicated above will be followed for payment of final reward amount also.

Competent authority in case of disputes etc.

In case of dispute regarding quantum of award payable to the informant, the decision of Additional Director General of Police/Chief Internal Audit Officer in respect of theft of energy cases detected by Enforcement Wing/Flying Squad respectively will be final.

Publicity about the Cash Reward Scheme

The Chief Public Relation Officer will arrange to give wide publicity of this scheme through posters, news papers, hoardings electronic media etc.,

Review of the Scheme

A report on the efficacy of cash Reward Scheme will be put up by the Additional Director General of Police/ Vigilance/Chief Internal Audit Officer to the Chairman by the end of each financial year.
