

In continuation of the Board's Memorandum First and Second cited, a copy of the Government's letter third cited is communicated to all officers of the Board to follow the modified instructions detailed therein.

  - 3) From the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai-28, Letter No.00811/VAC.3/2004, dated 28.1.2004 and dated 9.2.2005.
  - 4) From the ADGP(Intelligence), Chennai-4, Letter C.12 No.50/VR/2004/T, dated 27.1.2004 forwarded by DGP, Chennai-4 in Letter RC.No.25151/Pen.1/2004, dated 17.2.2004.

I am directed to invite attention to the Government letter second cited wherein instructions were issued that before accepting the notice for voluntary retirement or before accepting the notice for voluntary retirement or before allowing a Government servant to retire on superannuation, the appointing authority should also ensure that no criminal case or prosectuion is contemplated or pending against the Government servant and the appointing authority should satisfy himself that the Government servant is free from such course of action by obtaining clearance from the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption / Crime Branch C.I.D. / S.B.C.I.D. wherever necessary.

2. In the letter reference third cited, the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption has now stated that the instructions issued in the above letter resulted in an ambiguous situation and the departmental authorities have started addressing the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption for vigilance clearane for cases of retirement of normal superannuation in addition to cases of voluntary retirement. It is not possible for this Directorate to give clearance for these normal retirement cases also. Hence, the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption

has requested to issue suitable instructions to the Heads of Departments and departmental authorities that they need not get clearance from Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption in respect of normal retirement on superannuation.

- 3. Similarly, in the letter fourth cited the Additional Director General of Police Intelligence (S.B.C.I.D.) has stated that verification reports are called for by all the Heads of Departments routinely who opt for voluntary retirement as well as retirement on superannuation. He added that an average of 150 verification rolls for voluntary retirements were received in a month. Consequent on the issue of instructions in Government letter, dated 14.11.2003, more than 2000 verification rolls are expected every month. As there is no sufficient manpower to do this job, there is a possibility of delay in proceeding the case. The Additional Director General of Police (Intelligence) has, therefore, requested to issue necessary instructions directing all Heads of Departments.
  - (i) to get verification reports directly from the concerned Deputy Superintendents of Police / City Commissioners of Police as well as Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and C.B.C.I.D. if necessary, since they are dealing with criminal cases / criminal enquiry.
  - (ii) Verification only on Special Branch C.I.D. point of view may be obtained directly from S.B.C.I.D. if necessary.

The Direction General of Police, Chennai-4 has forwarded and recommended the above suggestions of Additional Director General of Police, Intelligence, Chennai-4.

- 4. After careful consideration, the Government have decided to accept the suggestions of the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and Additional Director General of Police (Intelligence) recommended by the Director General of Police. In continuation of the instructions issued in Government letter, second cited the following modified instructions are issued to all Heads of Departments and appointing authorities for guidance;
  - (a) The department authorities need not get clearance from the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption in respect of normal retirement on superannuation. The departmental authorities should satisfy themselves that no such adverse aspects are pending against the Government servant.
  - (b) The departmental authorities should maintain a register showing the details of officials against whom enquiries / investigation are pending in Director of Vigilance an Anti-Corruption. This register should be referred to before clearing the proposals of cases of retirement on superannuation.
  - (c) It is enough if the appointing authority satisfies himself that no criminal case or prosecution is pending or contemplated against the Government servant who opt for voluntary retirement. In case where the departmental authorities consider that verification reports are absolutely necessary, such report may be obtained directly from the concerned District Superintendent of Police / City Commissioner of Police and C.B.C.I.D. as the case may be. The departmental authorities may obtain the verification report directly from the S.B.C.I.D. only in cases involving Special Branch point of view. However, as statutorily provided under FR.56(3)(e) it is mandatory on the part of the appointing authority that a report from DVAC should be obtained in cases of voluntary retirement in addition to satisfactory fulfilment of the other conditions laid down thereunder.

Note from the Member (Generation), Chennai dated 25.5.2005.

In the Independent Power Project Circle, the following works have to be finalised and settled immediately:-

- i) The important task of finalising the completed capital cost in respect of M/s. ST.CMS, M/s. PPN, M/s. Madurai Power Corporation and Samalpatti Power Corporation is under progress. Discussions with Central Electricity Authority on the above subject are over and the recommendations and findings on the completed capital cost is to be put up to Board and sent to Government of Tamil Nadu so as to enable them to send their recommendation to the Government of India.
- ii) The capacity of the plant at Pillaiperumalnallur, the land cost in respect of M/s. GMR Vasavi, finalisation of foreign exchange rate variation in respect of M/s. ST CMS have to be finalised expeditiously. The promotors are pressing for the release of withhold amount on account of the settlement of above issues.
- 2. To finalise and settle the above issues, it is considered that services of an experienced officer are absolutely necessary to continue to deal with the issues.
- 3. Accordingly, Thiru A. Sardar Mahaboob Jan, Chief Engineer / Independant Power Project (Retired) is hereby appointed as Officer on Special Duty initially for a period of one month with effect from 1.6.05 F.N. to attend and finalise the works mentioned in para 1 above. He shall be paid a consolidated pay of Rs.15,000/-(Rupees fifteen thousand only) per month. He shall also be permitted to retain the official vehicle and residential telephone during his tenure as Officer on Special Duty.
- 4. His payment shall be claimed and paid by the Assistant Personnel Officer / Unit-II of the Headquarter, Chennai - 2.
- 5. The expenditure is debitable to "T.N.E.B. Funds Revenue Expenses 75 Employees Costs -75.1 - Salaries - 75.110 - Salaries Provincial"

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF DEPUTATION OF BOARD ENGINEERS FOR STUDYING DIPLOMA COURSE IN INDUSTRIAL SAFETY AT BOARD'S COST:

1. The period of deputation shall be from the date of commencement of the course in the academic year in which the Officers are deputed to the date of completion of the course in the last semester.

The date of commencement and completion of the course would be as intimated by the Regional Labour Institute, Chennai.

- 2. The period of deputation shall be treated as on duty. The pay of the Officer shall be claimed against the post from which he was deputed and has to be disbursed by the respective pay disbursing Officer directly according to the rules inforce. The Officer deputed will continue to be allowed to draw during the period of deputation, besides their pay and D.A. other allowances lke HRA, CCA, etc. as applicable to that place where he worked prior to deputation excluding special pay, if any. They are not eligible for any other allowances during the period of deputation.
- 3. (i) The Officer deputed should arrange to pay all the fees himself to avoid delay in payment and get it reimbursed from the concerned pay disbursing officer on production of the receipts issued by the Institution.

The officer deputed should draw an advance amount from the pay disbursing Officer and make the payment to Institute and immediately settle the advance by producing the receipts issued by the Institute.

- (ii) The payment towards admission fees, application fees, tuition fees, special fees, examination fees, students aid fund fee, fee for mark sheets and grade certificates is to be met by Board.
- (iii) It is the responsibility of the Official deputed to get refund of the Caution deposit, if any remitted, at the end of the Course and remit it back to the Board.
- (iv) Payment towards Co-operative Society etc. has to be met only by the Officer deputed and it will not be reimbursed. The pay disbursing Officer can refer to the Institute in case of any doubt.
- (v) The other expenses which are not specified above and are trivial in nature have to be met only by the Officer deputed.
  - 4. The Officer deputed should himself meet the deposits, expenses etc. of the hostel accommodation.
- 5. (i) The Officer deputed is eligible for TA and DA as applicable for normal transfer according to TA regulations inforce.
- (ii) The Officer deputed is eligible for only the actual journey time and is not eligible for joining time.
- 6. (i) The Officer deputed should execute a bond on-judicial stamp paper to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with condition to continue in the employment of service to which he belongs or to which he may be transferred subsequently by the competent authority, for a period of 7 years after the completion of the course and also to refund the entire cost to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board in case he fails to qualify for the degree or if he happens to quit the service of the Board before expiry of 7 years from the completion of the course.
- (ii) The value of stamp paper shall be Rs.40.00 and the amount of bond is for the actual cost of training plus actual salary etc. received during the Training period.

- (iii) The sureties should be of departmental employees only.
- (iv) The Officer deputed will be relieved from the post to the deputation only on submission of the surety bonds.
  - (v) The bonds should be sent to Director of Training for acceptance and for custody.
- (vi) The provision for recovery of the bond amount is intended only to meet contingencies which make it impossible for the Board to ensure the continued service of the individual for the prescribed period. A statement showing the maximum inventory level fixed to the Circles for the year 2005-2006, is enclosed herewith for strict adherence. Actual inventory level in the Circles should not exceed the level now fixed at any point of time during the year 2005-2006. Excess inventory results in unnecessary lock up of Board's money and other associated costs such as interest cost, inventory carrying cost, obsolescence etc. At the same time it should also be ensured that required materials for effective new service connections, for executing budgetted Capital programmes, for routine maintenance are available in time to achieve the target.

- 2. Further in view of the tight financial conditions prevailing in the Board, the Superintending Engineers and Chief Engineers are requested to ensure that all efforts should be made to control the inventory to keep it within the prescribed level, by adhering to the following:
  - i) To be more cost conscious in inventory management.
  - ii) By regulating the P.Os. and delivery schedules to suit the work schedule requirement, the inventory is kept for minimum period in stores. Wherever necessary, the delivery can be rescheduled after getting Competent Authority's approval. The concept of "Just in Time (JIT) inventory management can be achieved over a period so that the inventory cost gets considerably reduced.
  - iii) Scraps and empties must be disposed-off then and there and money realised to Board's account without any delay.
  - iv) Periodical review and inspection of stores by Superintending Engineers/Chief Engineers and other inspecting officers may be ensured to keep a watch over the inventory level and to ensure that the level is maintained within the limits prescribed. The materials arrived in stores should be taken in to stock immediately for beneficial use and should not wait for more than three days for want of check measurement etc.
  - v) Maximum inventory level fixed should not be taken as an authorisation to keep the inventory at that level.
  - vi) SEs/CEs must bestow their personal attention on the usuage of IMS package and the various output reports designed in the programme to control the inventory.
- 3. The maximum inventory level should not exceed the limit prescribed for 2005-'06 under any circumstances and proposal for ratification of the excess stock held in the Circles will not be entertained.

#### Proceedings:-

In the Board's proceeding first cited, Orders were issued that all the employees of the Board including the persons on deputation or on foreign service who have obtained House Building Advance under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board House Building Advance Rules and have more than 5 years of service left for retirement shall be required to pay a subscription at the rate of 1% of their total monthly instalment recovered towards repayment of House Building Advance. The subscription shall continue till the date of superannuation or the date of repayment of advance together with interest thereon whichever is earlier. In the event of death of an employee before repayment of the House Building Advance in full together with interest thereon, the amount due from him towards repayment of the loan shall be met by the Board, provided the subscription from the employee has been commenced and continued till the month of his death.

The Government have examined the question that when a Government servant dies in harness in the middle of the month, whether the monthly instalment towards repayment of the principal/interest amount of the House Building Advance need be recovered for that month from the duty pay/leave salary of the deceased Government servant. After examination, the Government have issued orders in the Government order second cited to the effect that if a Government servant, enrolled under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees House Building Advance Special Family Benefit Fund Scheme and eligible for grant, dies in harness in the middle of a month before the repayment of the entire advance amount, the monthly instalment intended to be recovered for that month towards the principal/interest shall be recovered in full if there is sufficient amount available in the monthly salary; and the recovery shall be ignored if the amount available is insufficient to make the recovery and in such cases, the remaining dues of House Building Advance including that month's instalment can be waived under the above scheme.

- 3. It has been decided to follow the Orders of the Government issued in the Government Order second cited by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board.
- 4. Accordingly it is hereby ordered that if a Board employee, including the person on deputation or on foreign service, who has obtained House Building Advance under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board House Building Advance Rules and enrolled in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees House Building Advance Special Family Benefit Fund Scheme and eligible for grant as per the orders in (Per.) B.P. (FB) No. 61 (SB) dated 15.7.1986, dies in harness in the middle of the month before the repayment of the entire advance amount, the monthly instalment intended to be recovered for that month towards the principal/interest shall be recovered in full if there is sufficient amount available in the monthly salary and the recovery shall be ignored if the amount available is insufficient to make the recovery and in such cases, the remaining dues of House Building Advance including that month's instalment can be waived under the scheme.

In this office letter under reference 1st cited above, certain guidelines were issued to minimize Banking Cash Transaction Tax newly introduced through Finance Bill 2005 with effect from 1.6.2005, which provides for levy of Tax @0.1% on cash withdrawals from Banks exceeding one lakh rupees on a single day from accounts other than a Saving Bank account.

In this office letter under reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited above, further guidelines were issued stressing that payment of staff entitlements by issue of Individual Name cheques, shall be considered/adopted only at the willingness/option of the employees concerned and payment by Cheque need not be insisted.

B.B. - 4 (June 2005)

However, representations are received at Headquarters that employees are being persuaded to furnish their option / willingness, in some quarters, for receiving their entitlements by cheque.

After careful consideration and taking into account of the difficulties of the employees in receiving their entitlements by cheque, it is informed that the existing procedure in the mode of payment of staff entitlements only by cash shall be continued without any change.

Instances have come to the notice of the Board that the correct procedures for admitting the payment to contractor have not been followed structly. Hece the following instructions already issued are reiterated once again for strict adherence of the same.

Works involving extension of lines/services and capital improvement undertaken through outside agencies shall be excuted through Chit Agreement/ K2 Agrrement with reference to the powers delegated under T.R. and payments made accordingly.

All the works which are susceptible to measurements shall be executed only through K2/Chit Agreement. They shall not be undertaken through Temporary Advance (or) Booked under imprest.

The name of staff who have supervised the work and relevant extract of job allocation register for allocation of works to the above supervising staff and other staff should be furnished in the bills/M. Books.

In respect of Bills received under K2 Agreement/Chit Agreement, the same shall be accompanied with proper copies of the sanctioned estimates, Pole/material requirement schedules, requisition, devolution Nos. for the drawal/ devolution etc.

When more than one person is to be engaged for a works (a group of people required for a particular work) such loading & unloading of poles, cable drum, transformers, structures, etc., and payment is proposed under Imprest's veuchers/ Hand Receipt should be narrated as furnished below:

(payment towards supply of labourers for executing works)

Materials drawn for a specified work shall be utilised for the same work. Any surplus material after completion of a particular work shall be devoluted to stores forthwith, instead of adjusting the same to other works.

The works should be check measured by the competent authority immediately after date of completion of works and the payment may be arranged within a month from the date of completion. Subject to availability of funds.

Payment for the works should be made to the contractor only through cheques drawn in favour of the contractor concerned.

Temporary advance should be opened in exceptional and extra ordinary emergent circumstances only after getting due approval from the competent authority.

The receipt of this circular instructions may be acknowledged to the Deputy Financial Controller/ Works.
