

Sub: Contractors' Labourers - Issue of Employment Certificate to the Contract Labourers by the Field Officers - Instructions issued - Regarding.

The attention of the Superintending Engineers is invited to the Circular Memo. No.049818/564/I.R.1(1)/ Adm.Br./87-1, dated 12.6.1987, wherein the issuance of Employment/Service Certificate to the Contract Labourers by the Junior Engineer/Assistant Engineers/Assistant Executive Engineers has been prohibited.

- 2) It has come to the notice of the Board that Assistant Engineers/Junior Engineers and other Officers are continuing the habit of issuing employment/service certificate to the Contract Labourers in violation of the orders of Board. Even though based on such certificate, a Contract Labourer cannot be deemed to have worked continously for 480 days in 24 calender months as such certificate cannot be taken as evidence for the purpose of the attendance, invariably all the Inspector of Labour rely upon these certificate and pass orders in favour of the petitioner.
- 3) The Superintending Engineers are therefore once again requested to adhere to the above instructions scrupulously. In case, if any Officer/Official is found to have issued Employment/Service Certificate to the Contract Labourers, the matter will be viewed very seriously and responsibility will be fixed for the disobedience of instructions of the Board.
- 4) These instructions, may be brought to the notice of all the Officers/Staff to ensure strict adherence of the instructions of the Board.

Due to capacity addition, the wind generation witnessed a phenomenal growth and hence in depth planning is required for the development of new substations and for co-ordination of the execution of schemes. Hence the post of Chief Engineer/NCES and R&DSM was re-designated as the Chief Engineer/R&DSM, vide ref (1) cited. If was therefore considered necessary that a separate post of the Chief Engineer/NCES is required and it was intimated in the B.P. cited under ref (2) that the same may be reviewed after a period of six months. It was also mentioned in the B.P. that till such time the services of the retired Chief Engineer, Thiru. G. Ramakrishnan who has got rich experience in the field of GCC, will be availed to look after the subject of NCES.

Consequent to suppression of the post of the Chief Engineer/NCES, a post of the Superintending Engineer/NCES was created at Head Quarters, vide B.P. cited under Ref (3) for a period upto 28.2.2006. Since the post of the Chief Engineer/NCES was suppressed, approval was obtained from Chairman that the following works carried out so far by the Chief Engineer/NCES may be done by the Superintending Engineer/NCES, on approval of the same by the CONSULTANT.

- 1) The registration of new windmill applications and Name transfer of windmill applications.
- 2) The Name transfer of Noted for Record letter.
- The Name transfer of existing wind farm HT services.
- 4) Change in wheeling and banking arrangements of existing wind farm services.

Further based on the tie up approval issued from this office, wind mills are tied up to the nearby feeder. These works are carried out by the developers themselves on the supervision of Board officials on DCW basis. For the same Board collects 11% of the estimated cost of the works. The estimates for the above works are sanctioned by the Additional Chief Engineer/WEDC/Tirunelveli, if it is within his power. If it exceeds the power delegated to a Superintending Engineer, the estimates are sent to Head Quarters office for sanction. Hither to these estimates were sanctioned by the Chief Engineer/NCES and R&DSM. In addition to the above, various sanctions such as acquisition of land for substations, construction of buildings at substations, approval for sanction of estimates for various vehicles used by field staff including Additional Chief Engineer/WEDC/Tirunelveli etc. are being sent to Head Quarters Office for sanctioning.

As per SI.No.4, Section 20.1 (of Powers of sanction of Officers, in page 6), Full power is delegated to the Chief Engineer and only an amount of Rs. 2 lakhs has been delegated to Superintending Engineer for DCW works.

Hence after careful consideration, the Chairman has approved the proposal of delegation of powers delegated to a Chief Engineer in SI.No.4 Section 21 of power of sanction to officers, to the Superintending Engineer/NCES, as a special case. The Chairman has further instructed that the above powers may be delegated to the Superintending Engineer/NCES, until creation of a post of the Chief Engineer for Non Conventiona Energy Sources (i.e.) on creation of a post of the Chief Engineer/NCES, the powers delegated to the Superintending Engineer/NCES automatically gets lapsed.

In the B.Ps 1st and 2nd cited, orders were issued to adopt the revised procedures for entry level training period for six months to the newly recruited Assistant Engineers and a sum of Rs. 2500/- per Month (Rupees Two thousand five hundred only) was fixed as consolidated pay. Based on the above, orders were issued during the year 1995 for 550 candidates appointing them as Assistant Engineer/Electrical, Mechanical and Civil (Trainee) with a consolidated pay of Rs. 2500/- Per Month (Rupees two thousand five hundred only) for six months. After completion of successful training, they were appointed as Regular Assistant Engineers and placed on probation for 2 years in the time scale of pay.

- 2) Based on the B.Ps. 3rd and 4th cited, the candidates who were recruited to the post of Assistant Engineer/Electrical were initially appointed as Assistant Engineer/Trainees for a period of 2 years, including "Induction training" for 3 months, with a consolidated pay of Rs. 7,500/- (Rupees Seven thousand five hundred only) and on completion of two years training period he/she will be appointed as Regular Assistant Engineer and placed on probation for 2 years in the time scale of pay.

In (Per) B.P. (FB) No. 5 (SB) Dated 25.1.1994, orders were issued for re-naming the post of Special Grade Revenue Supervisor as Senior Revenue Supervisor. Amendment to the Tamil nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations to this effect has not been issued so far.

- 2. Subsequently in (Per) B.P. (FB) No. 69 (SB), dated 25.11.2002, orders were issued abolishing the category of "Senior Revenue Supervisor" duly creating the post of "Assessment Officer". In the said B.P., it was also ordered that necessary amendment to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations would be issued separately.
- 3. In Government Order (Ms) No. 53, Energy (B2) Department, dated 9.6.2005, notification has been issued under the proviso to clause (a) of section 172 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) authorising the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board to function as the State Transmission Utility and a Licensee under the provisions of the said Act for a further period of six months beyond the 9th day of June 2005. ### Proceedings:

In the G.O.1st read above, the Government have issued orders that the Rural Electric Co-operative Societies at Kumbakonam, Vandavasi and Thirumayam shall be wound up and that the distribution of power supply in these areas shall be entrusted to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board. Subsequently, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, in her D.O. letter 2nd read above to the Chairman/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, has requested to take over the administration of 3 Rural Electric Co-operative Societies based on the G.O. 1st read above. Accordingly, the administrative functions of 3 Rural Electric Co-operative Societies at Kumbakonam, Vandavasi, and Thirumayam was taken over by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with effect from 6.4.2002. Pending finalisation of the process of absorption of employees, guidelines were issued in Administrative Branch Memo. No. 039942/01/G.44/G.442/2002-1, dated 16.4.2002 to run the day to-day administrative functions of Rural Electric Co-operative Societies at Vandavasi, Kumbakonam and Thirumayam.

2. The Superintending Engineer/Thiruvannamalai Electricity Distribution Circle has reported, in his letter 4th read above, that at Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society there is one Sub Division, 7 O&M

B.B.-2 (Sep.2005)

Distribution Sections, 379 Distribution Transformers and 39857 services. Whereas in the existing Vandavasi O&M Division, there are 2 O&M Sub-Divisions, 8 O&M Sections, 1 Nos. 110 KVSS 476 Distribution transformers and 34641 services and suggested to merge the Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative society with the existing Vandavasi O&M Division. The Superintending Engineer has also sent detailed proposal on the modalities of absorption of employees.

3. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Superintending Engineer/Thiruvannamalai Electricity Distribution Circle, it has been decided to merge the Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society with the existing Vandavasi O&M Division with Headquarters at Vandavasi and for permanent absorption of the 107 employees of the Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society, who were on the rolls on the vesting date (i.e.) 6.4.2002 and whose initial appointment is not irregular/illegal, and for termination of service of 5 employees whose appointment was made in violation of Rule 149 of Tamil Nadu Co-operative Society rules 1988 and in excess of cadre strength. Further, taking into account the cadre strength approved by Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Thiruvannamalai for the erstwhile vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society, the increased strength recommended by Deputy Registrar/Cheyyar and the number of incumbents as on the vesting date (i.e.) 6.4.2002 including one vacant post of Assistant Executive Engineer, the Board has decided to accord sanction of posts so as to enable absorption of the employees of Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society into Board's service, Sanction is therefore accorded for creation of 113 posts with effect from 6.4.2002 as detailed below, which will include, one vacant post of Assistant Executive Engineer/Electrical, 1 Supernumerary Assistant and 4 Supernumerary Helpers.

The Superintending Engineer/Thiruvannamalai is informed that 1 Supernumerary Assistant and 4 Supernumerary Helpers excluding 4 Helpers to be terminated from service shall be adjusted against the arising vacancies in the circle.

4. The employees of the erstwhile Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society have submitted an option for permanent absorption into Board's service as called for by the Board. Similarly, as there is common cadre to deal with Administrative and Accounts matter in Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society, employees

of erstwhile Vandavasi Rural Electric Co-operative Society have submitted an option to come over to Administration or Accounts cadre on absorption into Board's service.

Based on the number of H.T/L.T services, quantum of revenue, capital expenditure, revenue expenditure, number of Divisions and number of Revenue Branches, the post of Deputy Financial Controllers were created. During the annual works programme meeting for 2005-06 held on 04.06.2005 between Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and R.E.C., Director/Technical/R.E.C/New Delhi informed that the Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidyutikaran Yojana (RGGVY) projects are to be considered in two phases, the first phase to be executed in X plan and the second phase in XI plan and requested the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board to simultaneously taken action for awarding the contracts on turnkey basis so as to draw the funds under the programme without any delay. The erstwhile Terms and conditions of supply of electricity as well as the Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code has provision to exempt the services in the name of State Government Departments from payment of initial security Deposit as the payment of dues for the electricity supplied to such Government Services are secured as the dues could be recovered from Government.

The Vigilance Cell has pointed out that in Chennai City, advance supply is being given to some selected applicants due to delay in erecting new transformer, which is not in accordance with either Electricity Act 2003 or Terms and Conditions of Supply of Electricity. This will give room for corruption.

The remarks of the Vigilance Cell are examined in detail and following instructions are issued.

In as much as, there is no provision to effect advance supply either in Electricity Act 2003 or Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code and also to avoid malpractice as suggested by Vigilance Cell, advance supply need not be effected where extension works are pending to be completed by TNEB.

Sub: Electricity - Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code - Application Form for electricity service connection - Obtaining of signature from approved winng contractor - Instructions Issued.

As per Clause 27(3) of Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code, the application form for Low Tension supply (except agricultural category) including hut service shall be in Form No. 1&3 of annexure-III. In the application form, there is no provision with regard to obtaining the signature of licensed wiring contractor. Therefore, the field officers are not obtaining the signature of the wiring contractors in the application form.

- Some of the Licensed Wiring Contractor's Associations have represented that the signature of the
  approved wiring contractors is not obtained by the Board in the application form prescribed in the Tamil Nadu
  Distribution Code and requested to instruct the field officers to obtain the signature of the approved wiring
  contractors.
  - In this connection, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission in its letter addressed to Chief Electrical Inspector to Government has stated that.
