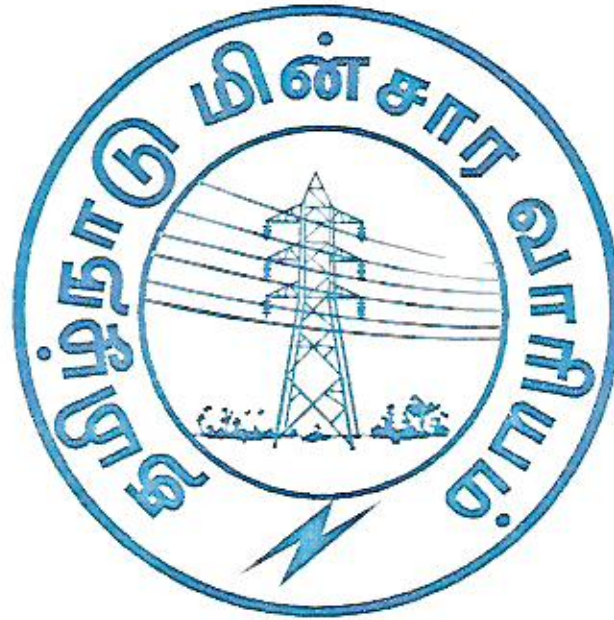

The Chief Engineer/Mechanical/Coal has stated that the following issues as listed below are in the advanced stage of finalisation and these issues are to be sorted out quickly :-

- i) PENDING ISSUES WITH M/S. PSC LTD.
- ii) PENDING COURT CASES PERTAINING TO HANDLING CONTRACTS AT LOAD / DISCHARGE PORTS
- iii) FUEL SUPPLY AGREEMENT (FSA) WITH COAL COMPANIES.

The Chief Engineer/Projects has submitted a proposal to utilise the services of Thiru **A. Sreenivasa Rao**, Executive Engineer/Electrical (Retired) as Consultant to assist the Arbitration Proceedings with M/s. Engineering Projects (I) Ltd., in respect of the contracts executed in North Chennai Thermal Power Station for Internal Coal Handling System (ICHS) - Package-I for a period of one year from the date of his appointment or till the completion of arbitration proceedings, whichever is earlier at a consolidated payment of Rs.750/- per day of service, subject to a maximum of Rs.9,000/- per month in addition to his eligible pension.

In the G.O. 1st read above, the Government have issued orders that the Rural Electric Co-operative Society at Kumbakonam, Vandavasi and Thirumayam shall be wound up and that the distribution of power supply in these areas shall be entrusted to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board. Subsequently, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, in the D.O. letter 2nd read above to the Chairman/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, has requested to take over the administration of 3 Rural Electric Co-operative Societies based on the G.O. 1st read above. Accordingly, the administrative functions of 3 Rural Electric Co-operative Societies at Kumbakonam, Vandavasi and Thirumayam was taken over by the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with effect from 6.4.2002. Pending finalisation of the process of absorption of employees, guidelines were issued in Administrative Branch Memo.No.039942/01/G.44/G.442/2002-01, dated 16.4.2002 to run the day-to-day administrative functions of Rural Electric Co-operative Societies.

2) The Ex-President, Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society filed W.P.No.3350/2002 challenging the take over of the Society by the Board. The High Court passed orders dated 11.4.2002 to maintain status quo. Subsequently, the interim orders dated 11.4.2002 have been vacated by the Division Bench of the High Court by order dated 22.7.2005 made in W.P.No.3350/2002 and W.A.No.994 of 2002.

3) Thiru R. Muthukumarasamy, then Additional Advocate General-I and Thiru G. Vasudevan, then Board's Standing Counsel have opined that in view of the vacation of the interim order by the

Division Bench of High Court, the Board, is free to absorb the employees of the Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society. Based on the opinion of Thiru. R. Muthukumarasamy and Thiru G. Vasudevan, the absorption of employees of Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society has been examined by the Board.

4) The Superintending Engineer/Pudukottai Electricity Distribution Circle has reported that at Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society there are two Sub-Division and 9 O&M Sections, 51,725 Services and 3 HT services 640 D.T. 412 L.T. services, 5616 Agriculture Services.

5) The existing number of services, number of Distribution Transformers etc. are not sufficient to consider formation of a separate Division at Thirumayam. However, in view of the pendency of W.P.No.3350 of 2002 and W.A.No.994 of 2002 against the take over of the society by the Board, the Board has decided that the function of the erstwhile Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society may be carried on as at present till the disposal of the Writ Petition/Writ Appeal. The formation of separate Division at Thirumayam will be examined separately after the disposal of the Writ Petition/Writ Appeal by the High Court.

6) The Board hereby accords sanction for the creation of 154 posts which includes two posts of Assistant Executive Engineer (On Deputation) taking into account the posts that existed in the erstwhile Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society, the incumbents as on the vesting date (i.e.) 6.4.2002 and the number of employees eligible to be considered for absorption so as to enable absorption of the employees of erstwhile Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society into Board's Service subject to the outcome of the W.P.No.3350/2002 and W.A.No.994/2002. The Five post of Office Helper indicated vide item 11 in the Provincial Cadre and the eight posts of Watchmen indicated vide item No.6 in the R.W.E. Cadre may be converted as Helper with effect from the date of issue of B.P.

7) The employees of the erstwhile Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society who are proposed for absorption have submitted an option for permanent absorption into Board's service without prejudice to the pendency of W.P.No.3350/2002 and W.A.No.994/2002 on the file of High Court as called for by the Board. Similarly, as there was a common cadre to deal with Administrative and Accounts matter in Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society, clerical employees of erstwhile Thirumayam Rural Electric Co-operative Society have submitted an option to come over to Administration or Accounts cadre on absorption into Board's Service.

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8) The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby directs that 19 employees who are appointed without approval of Co-operative Department and in violation of the instructions issued by the Co-operative Department may be provisionally continued in service till a decision on their absorption or otherwise is taken by the Board. - x) TNEB reserves the right to revise the service charges for the collection of dry ash over a period of time based on various aspects / direction of Govt. of Tamilnadu.

WHEREAS the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission specified the Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code under section 50 of the Electricity Act 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and published in Part VI Section 2 of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dt. 1.9.2004.

AND WHEREAS the said code provide for permitting the consumers of disconnected LT services who come forward to remit the charges within 2 years from the date of disconnection, to get reconnection;

AND WHEREAS the LT Agricultural consumers and the Distribution Licensee expressed difficulties in implementing the provision in view of the long wait to get agricultural service connection;

AND WHEREAS it is considered necessary to issue Amending Regulations to the Regulation of Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code removing the difficulties and the Amending Regulations for the above purpose shall be subject to the condition of previous publication and accordingly has undergone such previous publication;

NOW, therefore , in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 50 of the Electricity Act 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby specifies the following amending Regulations to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code issued under Notification No.TNERC/SC/7/1 dt.21.7.2004 and published in Part VI Section 2 (Supplement) of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 1.9.2004.

Amending Regulations

(1) Short title and Commencement

(1) This Code may be called the Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply (Amendment) Code 2006.

(2) It shall be deemed to have to come into force from 1st September 2004 on which the Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code came into force.

(2) In the Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply Code, in Regulation 22, for sub-regulations (6) and (7), the following sub-regulations shall be substituted, namely;

"(6) (i) When a service connection remains disconnected for non payment of electricity charges beyond the notice period of three months, if the consumer comes forward within the period mentioned below to pay the actual dues and agrees to remit the charges in clause (ii) below, the official authorized by the Licensee may grant extension of time beyond the notice period and revoke the termination of agreement provided that the lines feeding the service connection have not been dismantled, so as to facilitate reconnection of the disconnected service.

Category	Period for reconnection of disconnected service
HT consumers	Within five years from the date of disconnection
LT Agricultural consumers	-do-
Other LT consumers	Within two years from the date of disconnection

(ii) In accordance with sub-regulation (4), the authorized Officer of the Licensee may permit such consumer to pay the outstanding in instalments and to avail reconnection on receipt of 40% of the total arrears outstanding after closing of account due to the licensee, which include -

- (a) Arrears on the date of disconnection
 - (b) Tariff minimum and meter rent for the period of six months from the date of disconnection (including the notice period).
 - (c) The applicable BPSC / interest upto the date of payment.
 - (d) The balance 60% of the amount shall be collected in ten monthly instalments.
 - (e) In addition to the above, the full amount of Security Deposit adjusted while closing of account shall be collected in one lumpsum before effecting new service connection.
- (7) If the Consumers of the disconnected service come forward for reconnection after the period mentioned in sub-regulation (6) (i), the licensee shall treat them as new applicants and supply effected after recovering all charges applicable to a new service connection and all other arrears with BPSC."
