In (Per) B.P. (FB) No.21 (SB), dated 13.5.1999, inter-alla, the Chief Engineers of Thermal Stations

(Sl.No.3) have been delegated with powers to sanction consent fees payable to the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board every year for renewing the consent order for existing Thermal Stations.

**Proceedings :**

There are 28 Nos. Captive Power Projects presently available with an installed capacity of 656 MW. Besides 5 Nos. new Captive Power Projects are in the pipe line with a proposed generating capacity of 215 MW. The Captive Power Project Division work involves handling of large number of correspondences with the Private Captive Power Producers and monitoring at every stage in order to ensure continuous flow of files without any backlogs. The number of correspondences received from the Captive Power Projects on various issues are increasing day by day and it is noticed that work load of the existing division has increased manifold. Further, handling of various issues related to 32 plus projects and various other projects in pipeline at a time by one division is a cumbersome exercise and it may lead to pendency of works at various stages. In the near future, more number of new Captive Power Projects are expected to approach Tamil Nadu Electricity Board for availing Open Access due to liberalised policy. Already several new aspirants are approaching in this



regard. Hence, the volume of work is increasing day by day. The processing of the request from Captive Power Projects involves Technical, Financial and Legal aspects. Already the existing Captive Power Projects division is handling 1 No. case in the Appellate Tribunal at New Delhi and 1 No. case in High Court/Madras. Four number cases of Appeal are to be preferred with Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi for which efforts are being taken. Efforts are also being taken for filing a review petition with Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission on suo-moto order No.4, dated 15.5.2006, constant follow up of Court Proceedings are required in this regard. In addition, the Counsels also have to be contacted to conducting the court cases in the interest of the Board for discussion etc. In order to cope with the requirements of Captive Power Projects and to maintain the files without delay, the Chief Engineer/Private Power Project has suggested to sanction one additional post of Executive Engineer/Electrical and one post of Assistant Executive Engineer/Electrical to look after Captive Power Project Wing under the control of Superintending Engineer/Power Purchase and Chief Engineer/Private Power Projects. The proposal has been examined carefully and decided to accept the said proposal.

2. Accordingly, sanction is hereby accorded for creation of one post of Executive Engineer/Electrical and one post of Assistant Executive Engineer/Electrical to look after Captive Power Project Wing under the control of Superintending Engineer/Power Purchase for a period up to 28.2.2007 from the date of utilisation.

Sub: Establishment - Payment of monthly salary through Canara Bank Extension Counter to Class I, II, III & IV employees of Chennai Development Circle - Regarding.

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The Extension Counter of Canara Bank in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board complex has been functioning from 22.8.2003.

2. The salary of Class-III & IV employees of Board Office Secretariat Branch, Administrative Branch, Audit Branch, Accounts Branch and Technical Branch in the Head quarters are being disbursed through Canara Bank Extension Counter in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board complex under the reference 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> cited.

3. Now the employees Class I, II, III and IV of Chennai Development Circle have opened their Savings Bank Accounts in Canara Bank Extension Counter for salary purpose. Cheque Books and Debit-cum-ATM Cards have been issued to the employees to facilitate easy withdrawal of cash. In the case of employees who have not opened Saving Bank Account a team of Canara Bank official will undertake the job of opening SB Account formalities at their workspot.

4. Hence, it has been proposed to permit Canara Bank to handle the pay roll accounts of all Class I, II, III and IV employees of Chennai Development Circle as it was done in the case of salary disbursement of Secretariat Branch, Administrative Branch, Audit Branch, Accounts Branch and Technical Branch in Head Quarters. The net salary of Class I, II, III and IV employees who are working in Chennai Development Circle, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board complex, will be credited to the Canara Bank Extension Counter by means of a single cheque and the bank in turn will credit the account of the individual employees concerned as per the details furnished to them in a floppy. The employees need not maintain any minimum balance in their account. The employees have been provided with ATM card and Cheque Book. The employees can have access to draw the salary from the ATM of Canara Bank elsewhere and Extension Counter at Tamil Nadu Electricity Board complex. The Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers of Chennai Development Circle, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board complex, are requested to instruct the pay drawing officers working under their control to submit separate bills for drawing the salary in respect of Class I, II, III and IV employees and it must be ensured that the white sheet recovery such as credit society/recurring deposit/co-optex have been recovered in the pay bill itself. Net amount payable to bankers should be shown so as to enable to draw cheque in favour of the Bank. The amount due to co-op. society which are hitherto recovered as white sheet recovery is now being deducted from pay bills. Hence the drawing officer will have to draw a separate bill for remittance of co-optex dues etc., as the case may be. The drawing officer shall arrange to obtain advance acquittance from all the Class I, II, III and IV employees. The advance acquittance shall be attached to the office copy of the respective pay bills as per the existing procedure.

5. This new system relating to payment of monthly salary to Class I, II, III and IV employees of Chennai Development Circle through bank will come into force with effect from the pay of September 2006 payable in October 2006 onwards.

6. The Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineer of Chennai Development Circle is requested to instruct the pay drawing officers under their control to follow the instructions in paras 4 & 5 of the Circular Memorandum for drawing salary in respect of Class I, II, III and IV employees and arrange payment to them through Bank.

### Proceedings :

In the Government Order first cited, the Government of Tamil Nadu have revised the rates of Dearness Allowance at 74% payable to their Pensioners/Family Pensioners with effect from 1.1.2006. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board had adopted the Government Order in the Board Proceedings second and third cited to Pensioners/Family Pensioners and Exgratia beneficiaries.

2. Orders have been issued in the Board Proceedings fourth cited for conversion of 50% of Dearness Allowance as Dearness Pension with effect from 1.8.2006 and in the Board Proceedings fifth cited for revised rate of Dearness Allowance at 24% to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners and 16% to the Exgratia beneficiaries with effect from 1.8.2006.

3. Now, the Government of Tamil Nadu in the Government Order sixth cited have revised the rate of Dearness Allowance at 29% payable to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners and 21% per mensem to the Exgratia beneficiaries with effect from 1.7.2006. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board has decided to adopt the Government Order to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board also.

4. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board directs that the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board shall be paid Dearness Allowance at the following rates:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (Per month)
1.7.2006 to 31.7.2006	79% of Pension / Family Pension
1.8.2006	29%

5. The families of deceased Contributory Provident Fund/Non-pensionable establishment beneficiaries who are in receipt of Ex-gratia payment of Rs.605/- per month with reference to (Per) B.P. (Ch) No.238 (SB) dated 22.9.1998 and (Per) B.P. (FB) No.15 (SB) dt.18.2.2006 of the Board shall also be paid Dearness Allowance at the rate of 21% per month with effect from 1.7.2006.

6. The increase in dearness allowance drawn from 1st July 2006 shall be paid in cash to the Pensioners/ Family Pensioners and Contributory Provident Fund. Non-pensionable establishment beneficiaries who are in receipt of Ex-gratia payment of Rs.605/- per month with reference to (Per) B.P. (Ch) No.238 (S.B.) dated 22.9.1998 and (Per) B.P. (FB) No.15 (SB) dt.18.2.2006. The amount of Dearness Allowance involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

7. These orders are applicable to the present and future family pensioners. In the case of divisible family pension, the Dearness Allowance shall be divided proportionately.

**TAMIL NADU ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION**  
**TAMIL NADU ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION (Amendment) CODE**  
**Notification No. TNERC/DC/8-5/dated 20.7.2006.**

WHEREAS it is considered necessary to issue amending Regulations to the regulations in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code removing certain difficulties in regard to the implementation of the regulations in the said code and the Amending Regulations providing for the above purpose shall be subject to the condition of previous publication;

NOW, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf and after previous publication, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby specifies the following amending regulations to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code issued under Notification NO. TNERC/DC/8/1, dated 21.7.2004 and published in Part VI - Section 2 (supplemental) dated the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2004.

**Amending Regulations**

**1. Short title and commencement**

- a. This code may be called, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution (Amendment) Code, 2006.
- b. This code shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

**2. (a) Amendment of regulation 29 of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code :-**

In the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code, in regulation 29, in sub-regulation (14) for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:

(a) "For indoor metering, an electrical room with RCC roof having a clear floor area 5m x 6m with a vertical clearance of 3.7 metres between the floor and the ceiling/beam bottom with locking facility, exhaust fan and adequate size of cable duct shall be provided at the ground/basement floor for installing the Licensee's equipments, etc. This room shall be of fireproof and weatherproof."

(b) in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Code, in form 4 in Annexure III for Note under item 6, the following note shall be substituted, namely:

**Note : The application shall be accompanied by the following documents**

(1)(a) When the applicant is the owner of the premises :

Certified copy of the sale deed for the premises executed in his favour.

(or)

Property Tax receipt for the premises in the name of the applicant.

(b) When the applicant is not the owner of the premises :

Consent letter from the owner of the premises

(or)

Proof of legal occupation (including lease deed) along with the following:

(a) Indemnity Bond in Form 6.

(b) Letter of acceptance to pay security deposit at twice the normal rate.

(2) Partnership deed in case the applicant is a partnership firm or Memorandum/Articles of Association in case of companies registered under Companies Act.



- (3) Letter/Resolution authorizing the signatory.

**TAMIL NADU ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION  
 CHENNAI  
 Notification No.TNERC / SPR / 9 / 1-4 dated 25.7.2006.**

WHEREAS the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission specified and notified in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2004, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Standards of Performance Regulations 2004 under section 86 of the Electricity Act 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003), providing for enforcement of standards with respect to quality, continuity and reliability of service by licensees.

AND WHEREAS the Distribution licensee (Tamil Nadu Electricity Board) expressed certain difficulties in implementing certain provisions of the above regulations.

AND WHEREAS it is considered necessary to issue Amending Regulations to the above Regulations for removing the difficulties and the Amending Regulations providing for the above purposes shall be subject to the condition of the previous publication and accordingly undergone such previous publication.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 181 read with section 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby specifies the following Amending Regulations to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Standards of Performance Regulations 2004 issued under Notification No.TNERC/SPR/9/1/Dated 21<sup>st</sup> July 2004 and published in Part VI - Section 2 (supplement) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2004.

**Amending Regulations**

**1.0 Short Title and Commencement**

(a) These regulations may be called the "Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Standards of Performance (Amendment) Regulations 2006"

(b) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

(2) In the Tamil Nadu Electricity Distribution Standards of Performance Regulations 2004,

(i) in regulation 4, for the existing table along with the note, the following tables shall be substituted, namely:

"Table I :

Category	Time Schedule for LT
(a) Involving no extension or improvement work	Preferably within a week but not exceeding 30 days.
(b) Involving Extension and Improvement without Power Transformers	60 days.
(c) Involving Extension and Improvement with Power Transformers	90 days.

Table II :

Category	Time Schedule for HT / EHT	
	HT	EHT
(a) Involving extension and improvement work	60 days	150 days
(b) Involving the enhancement of Power Transformer/ Addition of Power Transformer	120 days	180 days
(c) Involving the Commissioning of new substation	180 days	270 days

- (I) The Licensee shall issue advice slip/notice/letter indicating the prescribed charges payable with proper acknowledgement.
- (II) The Consumer shall remit the above charges within the stipulated period but not exceeding fifteen Days from the date of receipt of advice slip/notice/letter.
- (III) In exceptional/deserving cases, permission may be granted by the respective Chief Engineer and Superintending Engineer or the person designated for this purpose by the Licensee for remittance of charges by the Consumer beyond the prescribed fifteen Days for HT/EHT and LT services respectively.
- (IV) The time taken by the Consumer to remit the prescribed charges from the date of receipt of demand notice will not be covered in the above time schedule.
- (V) The time schedule is also applicable for additional loads."

(ii) In regulation 7, the following note shall be added, namely:

**"Note :** The time taken by the Consumer to remit the prescribed charges from the date of receipt of demand notice will not be covered in the above time schedule.

In exceptional / deserving cases, permission may be granted by the respective Chief Engineer and Superintending Engineer (or the person designated for this purpose by the Licensee) for remittance of charges by the Consumer beyond the prescribed fifteen Days for HT / EHT and LT services respectively."

(iii) For regulation 10, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely

**"10. Complaints in Billing, etc.**

(i) Any complaints in billing received prior to the due date for payment shall be resolved before the next billing along with refund/adjustments, if any. However, the complaints in respect of arithmetic error if any received three days prior to the due date for payment shall be set right within the due date for payment.

(ii) The consumer shall not, on the plea of incorrectness, withhold any portion of the amount billed."

(iv) In regulation 12, for the existing table under Clause (II) the following table may be substituted, namely.

and in the proviso under sub-regulation (III) of regulation 12, the words "land slides in hill areas" shall be added after the word "cyclone,".

(v) In regulation 13, for the expression "uninterrupted, reliable and quality" the expression "uninterrupted and reliable" shall be substituted.

(vi) For regulation 17, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely:

**"17. Responding to Consumer's Complaint**

If any consumer makes a complaint in writing to the Territorial Engineer of the concerned licensee then, the Territorial Engineer concerned shall reply to the consumer within ten days after receipt of the letter. In case the Territorial Engineer requires to visit the site or consult any other officer to give a comprehensive reply, the Territorial Engineer shall explain to the consumer as to why a substantive response cannot be sent immediately and intimate the name address and telephone number of the Officer dealing with the complaint. The Territorial Engineer shall also ensure that a substantive response is sent to the consumer within twenty days of receiving the complaint letter."

(vii) For regulation 25, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely:

**"25. Service reliability**

The following reliability/outage indices are prescribed by the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) Standard 1366 of 1998. The Licensee shall compute and report the value of these indices as per the formula and methodology specified below.

- (a) System Average Interruption Frequency Index (SAIFI)
- (b) System Average Interruption Duration Index (SAIDI)

**Method to compute Distribution System Reliability Indices :**

The Indices shall be computed for the Distribution Licensee as a whole by stacking, for each month, all the 11 KV/22 KV feeders in the supply area, excluding those serving predominantly agricultural loads, and then aggregating the number and duration of all interruptions in that month for each feeder. The Indices would then be computed using the following formulae:

$$1. \quad SAIFI = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^n (A_i * N_i)}{N_t} \quad \text{Where,}$$

$A_i$  = Total number of sustained interruptions (each longer than 5 minutes) on  $i^{th}$  feeder for the month.

$N_i$  = Connected load of  $i^{th}$  feeder affected due to each interruption

$N_t$  = Total connected load at 11/22 KV in the Distribution Licensee's supply area

$n$  = number of 11/22 KV feeders in the licensed area of supply (excluding those serving predominantly agricultural loads)



$$2. \quad \text{SAIDI} = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^n (B_i * N_i)}{N_r} \quad \text{Where,}$$

$B_i$  = Total duration of all sustained interruptions on  $i^{\text{th}}$  feeder for the month.

**Note :** The feeders must be segregated into rural and urban and the value of the indices must be reported separately for each month.

(i) The Licensee shall compute the value of these indices separately for feeders serving predominantly agricultural loads. The methodology for computation of indices shall remain the same as in the case of other feeders.

(ii) Based on the information provided by the Licensees, the Commission would notify the target levels for these indices annually."

(viii) In regulation 27, the following may be substituted :

(a) For clause (i) the following clause shall be substituted, namely:

"(I) The standards of performance specified in this regulation shall remain suspended during Force-majeure conditions or cause beyond the control of the Licensee".

(b) Re-number clause (II) as clause (III) and before the said clause as so re-numbered, the following clause may be inserted namely:

"(II) "Non-compliance of the Standards contained in this regulation by the licensee shall not be treated as violation and the Distribution Licensee shall not be required to pay any compensation to affected consumers if such violation is caused due to grid failure, or a fault on the Transmission Licensee's network, or on account of the instructions given by the SLDC/SSLDC, over which the Distribution Licensee has no reasonable control".

4. The hut services in the areas covered by the Government in the next phases of the distribution of free Colour TV scheme are to be energized on priority as per the time schedules fixed by the Government.
