In the Board Proceedings mentioned above the employees of the Board desirous of seeking jobs abroad are permitted to apply and secure employment abroad either through Overseas Man Power Corporation Limited or other available sources. Among otherthings, it has been ordered that, if Contribution towards Pension is paid by the foreign employer or the employee such period will count for pension. Some of the officials, on expiry of leave on employment abroad, approach Audit Branch for assessing the demand towards Pension Contribution to be paid. As per provision under TNEB S.R. 72(1) the payment towards contribution for L.S. or pension is to be made before the end of 31st March of every year with a grace period of 15 days. If there is delay of remittances interest amount be paid to Board at the rate of 2 paise per hundred per day. Accordingly the Audit Branch issues the demand notice with the details towards Pension Contribution and interest on delayed payment. Certain officials had protested for payment of interest on delayed remittance stating that they were not aware of the rule position in this regard. It is the responsibility of the official concerned to remit the dues as per provisions under T.N.E.B. S.R. 71 (a). The quantum of amount payable shall be assessed by the official himself or herself. The Board Office Audit Branch may also be consulted if needed for arriving at the rate of Pension Contribution and interest on delayed remittance. With a view to avoiding complaints on interest on delayed remittance, the Chief Engineer / Superintending Engineer shall state the provision under T.N.E.B. S.R. 71 (a) and S.R. 72 (1) specifically in the relief order of the officials availing leave on employment abroad.

2. In consideration of the representations received from the Unions and the dependants of the employees of the Board requesting for reconsideration of the orders issued in para 3(3) of the Board's Proceedings first read above orders were issued in the Board's Proceedings second read above that in respect of Board employee who dies prior to 13.10.1995 the condition that they should apply within three years need not be applied and they may be permitted to apply without insisting on any time limit.

3. Subsequently, it has been brought to the notice of the Board that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in many cases has held that the very object of appointment of the dependants of the deceased employees who die in harness is to relieve unexpected immediate hardship and distress caused to the family by sudden demise of the earning member of the family. Hence, there cannot be any reservation of appointment on Compassionate grounds indefinitely for any number of years. The orders issued in Board Proceedings second read above that the Legal heirs of the employees who died before 13.10.1995 can apply for employment at any time on compassionate grounds amounts to another mode of recruitment which cannot be encouraged de hors the recruitment rules. Further, in many cases the Hon'ble High Court has already upheld the orders of the Board rejecting the claim of the applicant made after the stipulated period of three years and the scheme of appointment on Compassionate grounds issued in the Board Proceedings first read above stood the test of judicial scrutiny and time.

4. In view of the above it is felt necessary to cancel the orders issued in the Board Proceedings second read above.

5. Accordingly, the orders issued in (Per.) B.P. (FB) No.3 (Adm.Br.) dated 9.1.2007 is hereby cancelled and the orders issued in the Board Proceedings first read above shall govern the scheme for providing employment assistance on Compassionate grounds.

Sub: Applicability of VAT rates - Certain Instructions Issued - Reg.

The VAT Act 2006 has been implemented in Tamil Nadu from 1.1.2007. Various requests for clarification has been received at Headquarters on the applicability of VAT rate on the supplies made to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board.

The Joint Commissioner, VAT Cell has been requested to clarify certain provision of the VAT Act and applicability of concessional VAT rate to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board granted under the erstwhile TNGST Act 1959.

Pending receipt of clarification, wherever the suppliers claim VAT @ 4% may be admitted for payment for the due supplies made from 1.1.2007 in respective of the rate of Sales Tax specified in the P.O. The firms who claim VAT @ 12.5% their bills may be admitted for payment restricting the VAT @ 4% till receipt of clarification from Joint Commissioner VAT Cell.

The Surcharge on Sales Tax and Resale Tax is no longer in existence.

The detailed instructions in this regard will be issued separately.

In the letter under reference cited it has been communicated that Taxable services of aggregate value not exceeding Rs.4 lakh in every financial year has been exempted from the whole of Service Tax leviable thereon under Section 66 of the said Finance Act, subject to certain conditions noticed therein.

In the Notification under reference cited, the threshold level of Service Tax exemption for Small Service providers has been increased from the present level of Rs.4 lakh to Rs.8 lakh with effect from 1.4.2007 provided that the aggregate value of Taxable services rendered by such provider of Taxable service from one or more premises does not exceed Rs.8 lakh in the preceding Financial year.

All P.O. placing authorities are requested to take note of the above amendment for admitting the Service Tax claim of the Service providers.

ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued sanctioning revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees as detailed below:-

Date from which payable	Rate of D.A. (per month)
1 st July, 2006	29 per cent of Pay plus Dearness Pay

2. The Government sanction the revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees as indicated below:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of D.A. (per month)
1 st January, 2007	35 per cent of Pay plus Dearness Pay

3. The Government also direct that the Dearness Allowance increase shall be paid in cash with effect from 1.1.2007.

4. The details of admissibility of revised Dearness Allowance for employees drawing pay at various stages are given in the Annexure to this Order. In cases where the pay of Government servants fall between two pay ranges indicated in column (1) in the Annexure to this order, the revised Dearness Allowance shall be worked out at the percentage rate. While working out the revised Dearness Allowance, fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise.

5. The Government also direct that the revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned above, shall be admissible to full time employees who are at present getting Dearness Allowance and paid from contingencies at fixed monthly rates. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order shall not be admissible to part time employees.

6. The revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order will also apply to the teaching and non-teaching staff working in aided educational institutions, employees under local bodies, employees governed by the University Grants Commission / All India Council for Technical Education scales of pay, the Teachers / Physical Directors / Librarians in Government and Aided Polytechnics and Special Diploma Institutions, Village Assistants in Revenue Department, Noon Meal Organisers, Child Welfare Organisers and Anganwadi Workers.

7. The expenditure shall be debited to the detailed head of account 03 Dearness Allowance under the relevant sub-minor, sub-major and major heads of account.

8. The Treasury Officers / Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to make payment of the revised Dearness Allowance when bills are presented without waiting for the authorisation from the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Chennai-18.

In principle administrative approval is hereby accorded to Chennai North and South Region's Computer Based Power Failure Redressal Centre for the following:-

(1) Enhancing the strength of outsourced call centre operators to receive the power failure complaints through "155333, SMS, Chairman Cell Phone numbers and TNEB Web Site from 16 Nos. (Sixteen only) per shift to 18 Nos. (Eighteen only) per shift.

(2) Recurring expenditure of Rs.2,16,000/- per annum (Two lakhs and sixteen thousand only) for outsourcing of the additional 2 Nos. operators per shift as detailed below:-

Salary of one outsourced operator	=	Rs.3000/- per month (Rupees Three thousand only)
Salary of 6 Nos. operators for 3 shifts	=	Rs.3000 x 6 = Rs.18,000/- per month
Expenditure incurred per annum	=	Rs.18000 x 12 = Rs.2,16,000/-

Proceedings :

Chennai Distribution network consists of nearly 20 lakhs LT consumers and nearly 1250 HT consumers

in the Chennai City and its surrounding areas. 58 fuse off call centres functioning in various parts of city are attending the complaints received from the consumers of these areas through the FOC vehicles based on the calls received through the Call Centre and from the local FOC centres by posting 3 shift duties. On receipt of the calls from the Call Centre/local FOC centre, the vehicles reach the spot and attend to the rectification works. Further due to boom in the power supply requirement in the IT corridor, quick restoration of power supply in case of any outage is of paramount importance for the satisfaction of the elite consumers particularly HT consumers.

To quicken the process of restoration of power supply in case of interruption in power supply to the bulk consumers, it is now proposed to go in for the implementation of the FOC vehicle tracking system using the satellite images of Chennai and its surrounding areas in the vehicles by using the GPS (Global Positioning System) based vehicle tracking arrangement.

The salient features in this vehicle tracking system are explained below:-

- i) Movement of the FOC vehicle can be tracked in the headquarters call centre/scada and the vehicle can be immediately diverted to the areas where there are cases of emergency such as accident, fire shock, fire in cables due to puncturing of cables, ground shock due to insulation failure, snapping of overhead HT / LT conductors and interruption of power supply to the bulk consumers and during cyclone and floods in rainy seasons.
- ii) The complete movement of FOC vehicles can be monitored from single point thereby increasing the working efficiency of the manpower and time saving.
- iii) Increased consumer satisfaction due to immediate pooling of vehicles to the affected area and consequent reduction in the duration of power supply restoration
- iv) The duration of time taken for attending rectification of fault can also be monitored at any point of time.
- v) Improving the revenue to the Board by quick restoration of power supply.

In this connection, as a trial basis, this vehicle tracking arrangement can be tried in Chennai North and South Region at the rate of 10 vehicles for each Region. The entire package consisting supply of GPS equipment with monitoring station (PC) at the call centre including erection, testing and commissioning works out approximately Rs.50,000/- per vehicle. For 10 vehicles the total amount works out nearly Rs. 5,00,000/- per Region. After watching the satisfactory performance of this system, the same can be extended for the remaining FOC vehicles and for HT EBS mobile vans.

After careful consideration the following orders are issued.

- i) Approval is hereby accorded for implementation of GPS based FOC vehicle tracking system as a trial measure in Chennai North and Chennai South Regions at the rate of 10 vehicles per Region.
- ii) The Chief Engineers / Distribution, Chennai North and Chennai South Regions shall initiate tendering process for the supply, erection, testing and commissioning of the GPS based FOC vehicle tracking system.

Proceedings :

The HT SC No.2259 in the name of Dr. Rangabhashyam was effected on 12.3.1974. On detection of wrong adoption of multiplying factor, the bill was revised for the period from 12.3.1974 to 31.10.1981 amounting to Rs.2,70,628/- and the same was included with regular current consumption bill. The consumer approached the Board for payment of the same in instalments and he was allowed to pay the same in 24 monthly instalments. But, without paying the above amount in instalments, the consumer filed a C.S.No.256/83 and the court ordered the Board to limit the arrears up to 3 years based on the law of limitation Act. Then, the Board filed an appeal petition against the above order in O.S.A.No.354/2000. In the meanwhile, the supply was disconnected on 22.12.2005 due to non-payment of current consumption charges for 11/2005. Subsequently, the consumer represented for dismantling of service stating that the Hospital which was functioning in the above premises was closed. As the court case was pending, the consumer was replied that the dismantling of service will not be made as requested by the consumer.

2. The consumer approached the City Civil Court vide CMP No.18847/2005 in OSA 354/2000 and obtained order dt.18.4.2006 in which it was directed that the Board should dismantle the transformer and other equipments within a period of four weeks. Regarding payment of arrears, it was specified in the above order that they have referred the dispute of the appeals for Mediation and the question of payment for dismantling charges will also be considered by the Mediation Panel.

3. When the above matter was referred to Headquarters by the Circle, after taking into account the decision taken during the Chief Engineers (Distribution) meeting held on 2.9.2005 to realise the outstanding arrears in respect of disconnected services pending for a long duly considering the waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge, subject to payment of entire arrears by the consumer and in line with the above decision, it was informed in letter dt.26.7.2006 that during Mediation, the above consumer may be informed that if he agrees to pay the entire outstanding arrears along with dismantling charges in one lumpsum, the waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge will be considered by the Board. It was reported by the Superintending Engineer/ Chennai EDC (Central) that the Board's stand was informed to the consumer and the consumer accepted and paid all the arrears amounting Rs.5,15,799/- including dismantling charges.

4. The Belated Payment Surcharge works out to Rs.7,45,880.94/- (i.e. Rs.7,37,261.91 in respect of revision of bill for the period from 6.5.83 to 22.8.2006 and Rs.8,619.03 in respect of 11/05 & 12/05 current consumption charges).

5. After more than 20 years, the above outstanding arrears of Rs.5,15,799/- payable by the above consumer (except Belated Payment Surcharge) in respect of his HT SC No.2259 has been collected on 28.7.2006 & 22.8.2006 after persuading the consumer that the Belated Payment Surcharge will be waived if the arrears are cleared, in line with the instructions issued in circular memo. dt.29.7.2006. The Belated payment surcharge comes to Rs.7,45,880.94/- (ie. Rs.7,37,261.91 in respect of revision of bill for the period from 6.5.1983 to 22.8.2006 and Rs.8,619.03 in respect of 11/05 & 12/05 current consumption charges).

6. Since the consumer viz. Dr. Rangabhashyam of HT SC No.2259, Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle / Central has paid the arrears of current consumption charges in full and in line with the circular memo.

dt.29.7.2006, the proposal for waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge of Rs.7,45,880.94/- (ie. Rs.7,37,261.91 in respect of revision of bill for the period from 6.5.1983 to 22.8.2006 and Rs.8,619.03 in respect of 11/05 & 12/05 current consumption charges) was placed before the Board.

7 The Board in its 900th meeting held on 20.2.2007 has approved the proposal for waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge of Rs.7,45,880.94/- in respect of HT SC No.2259, Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle/ Central of Dr. Rangabhashyam.

Proceedings :

The HT SC No.1119 relating to M/s.South India Pulverising Mills of Chennai EDC / North was disconnected on 2.5.1994 due to non-payment of current consumption charges and the accounts were closed and the service connections lines were also dismantled. After adjusting the available current consumption deposit at his credit, the remaining balance amount of Rs.54,235/- including dismantling charges is payable by the above consumer, excluding Belated Payment Surcharge.

2. In order to realise the outstanding arrears due from the consumers of disconnected services pending for quite a long time, instructions have been issued in circular memo. dated 29.7.2006 to all the Chief Engineers (Distribution) / Superintending Engineers of Distribution Circles that where the collection of arrears and Belated Payment Surcharge could not be made even after continuous efforts taken for collection and also such consumers are not in a position to get the service reconnected, in such cases, if the consumer is willing to pay the entire outstanding arrears in one lumpsum except Belated Payment Surcharge, the entire outstanding arrears may be collected in one lumpsum except Belated Payment Surcharge and to send necessary proposal for waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge.

3. After more than 12 years, the above outstanding arrears of Rs.54,235/- payable by the above consumer (except Belated Payment Surcharge) in respect of his HT SC No.1119 has been collected on 22.11.2006 after persuading the consumer that the Belated Payment Surcharge will be waived if the arrears are cleared, in line with the instructions issued in circular memo. dt.29.7.2006. The Belated payment surcharge after closure of accounts ie. from 18.11.1994 to 22.11.2006 (ie. the date of payment of outstanding arrears by the consumer) comes to Rs.88,531/-.

4. Since the consumer of HT SC No.1119, Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle / North, M/s.South India Pulverising Mills, has paid the arrears of current consumption charges in full and in line with the circular memo.dt.29.7.2007, the proposal for waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge of Rs.88,531/- (ie. from the date of closure of accounts ie. 18.11.1994 to 22.11.2006 ie. the date of payment of outstanding arrears by the consumer) was placed before the Board.

5. The Board in its 900th meeting held on 20.2.2007 has approved the proposal for waiver of Belated Payment Surcharge of Rs.88,531/- up to 22.11.2006 in respect of HT SC No.1119, M/s. South India Pulverising Mills, Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle / North.

6. The Superintending Engineer / Chennai EDC / North shall arrange to withdraw the Belated Payment Surcharge of Rs.88,531/- by adjustment in respect of HT SC No.1119, Chennai Electricity Distribution Circle/ North of M/s. South India Pulverising Mills.

Sub: Tender - Secondary and Higher Education cess on Excisable goods - Reg.

In the Central Budget for 2007-2008, a new cess called Secondary and Higher Education cess @1% of the aggregate of duties of Excise has been imposed on excisable goods. This cess would be in addition to the existing Education cess of 2% imposed in Budget 2004.

This levy came into force with immediate effect, (Clauses 126 read with 128 of chapter VI of Central Excise Act 1944) by virtue of the declaration under the provisional collection of Taxes Act 1931.

Hence all P.O. placing authorities are instructed that appropriate amendment may be issued to P.O's and the claim of the suppliers for the total education cess @ Rs.3% for the due supplies to be made may be admitted.
