Proceedings:

In the Board's Proceedings first and second read above, among other things, orders have been issued for bifurcation of the Chennai Distribution Region as Chennai Distribution Region (North) and Chennai Distribution Region (South) duly redistributing the existing circles between the two regions and formation of Chennai Development Circle-II respectively.

2. In view of administrative convenience as well as geographical consideration, it has been decided to redistribute the existing distribution circles among Chennai Distribution Region (North), Chennai Distribution Region (South) and Vellore Distribution Region.

3. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby directs that the existing distribution circles in Chennai Distribution Region (North), Chennai Distribution Region (South) and Vellore Distribution Region be redistributed among the above three regions are detailed below:-

3.1) Chennai Distribution Region (North)

2. Estt. - Employees of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board - Grant of leave to take up employment abroad - Amendment to Regulation 98 of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations - Inclusion of names of certain officials in the respective panels for considering promotion - Further orders - Issued.

In the Board's Proceedings first read above, Board has prescribed a condition that a member of a service who had been on leave of any kind for a period of three years continuously for any reason except for higher studies or for a period of four years continuously for higher studies, shall not be considered for appointment to a higher category by promotion unless he had completed service for a period of one year from the date of which he joins duty on return from such leave.

2. In the Board's Proceedings second read above, orders have been issued to withdraw the above said condition with a view to utilize the experience gained by certain Engineers in the field of electricity with modernized equipments in abroad. But, in the said B.P. it has been ordered that the orders will take effect from the date of issue of the orders (i.e. 11.8.2008).

3. In view of the above, certain employees who have gone abroad by availing of more than

three years' Extra Ordinary Leave between 30.1.2001 to 11.8.2008 have lost their chance for inclusion of their names in the respective panels and thereby seniority also. Those officials have represented to consider their names for inclusion in the respective panels and requested promotion with due seniority, by extending the benefits ordered in the Board's Proceedings second read above.

4. Hence, the said request received from those employees has been carefully considered and it has been considered that the orders issued in the Board's Proceedings second read above shall be given effect to from 30.1.2001 (i.e. the date of issue of B.P. first read above) instead of 18.8.2008 (i.e. the date of issue of B.P. second read above). The Board has approved the above said proposal with a direction that this will be applied only to those who have secured their employment abroad in the connected subject area / Engineering activity.

5. In Government Order (Ms.) No.104, Energy (B2) Department, dated 16.12.2009, notification has been issued under the proviso to clause (a) of section 172 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) authorising the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board to function as the State Transmission Utility and a Licensee under the provisions of the said Act for a further period of three months upto 15.3.2010 beyond 15.12.2009. Therefore, the Board constituted under the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1948 (Central Act 54 of 1948) will continue to function as the State Transmission Utility and a Licensee and as such it can exercise its administrative functions as was done earlier and make regulations/amendments/orders providing for the service conditions of the officers and employees of the Board.

6. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board hereby makes the following amendment to (Per.) B.P. (F.B.) No.30 (SB) dated 11.8.2008:-

AMENDMENT

In the said B.P., for paragraph-4, the following paragraph shall be substituted, namely:-

"4. The above said amendment shall take effect from the 30th January 2001 and this will be applied to only those who have secured their employment abroad in the connected subject area/Engineering activity only"

The Chief Engineer/Gas Turbine Schemes. Chennai has sent a note seeking Administrative approval to run the canteen on "Leave on Licence basis" for a period of one year from 6.3.2010 to 31.3.2011 at Basin Bridge Gas Turbine Power Station, Chennai-600 002.

2. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Superintending Engineer/Basin Bridge Gas Turbine Power Station to run the canteen in Basin Bridge Gas Turbine Power Station Complex on "Leave on Licence basis" for a period of one year from 6.3.2010 to 31.3.2011 is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions.

- a. To accept the highest bid amount under Limited Tender.
- b. To provide water supply at free cost.
- c. To collect current consumption charges.
- d. To fix the rate of eatable as per prevailing market rate ensuring reasonableness.
- e. The contractor should not engage the Labourers who worked in the canteen under the old contract.
- f. It may be ensured tht no identity card/Gate pass be issued from the department to the employees of the canteen.
- g. The canteen employees should not be employed at any time continuously for more than 239 days.
- h. No loans and grants will be given to the proposed Canteen.

2. In the G.O. fourth cited, the roster prescribed has been revised so as to ensure adequate representation to the Backward Class Christians and the Backward Class Muslims. Accordingly, the rotations / turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen have been revised and prescribed as in the Annexure-I, II and III to this letter. In respect of reservation for the physically handicapped persons, the orders issued in the Government Orders first and fifth cited shall be strictly followed.

3. Necessary amendments to the Tamil Nadu State and subordinate Services Rules shall be issued separately.

2. In the Government Order fourth cited, the roster specified has been revised so as to ensure adequate representation to the Backward Class Christians and the Backward Class Muslims. Accordingly, in the Government letter sixth cited, the rotations/ turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen have been revised. It has also been ordered therein that in respect of the reservation for the physically handicapped persons, the orders issued in the Government Orders first and fifth cited shall be followed strictly.

3. Based on the representation received from the Christian community, the Government in Tamil Nadu Ordinance No.9 of 2008 have now amended the Tamil Nadu Backward Class Christians and Backward Class Muslims (Reservation of Seats in Educational Institutions including Private Educational Institutions and of appointments or posts in the services under the State) Act, 2007 (Tamil Nadu Act 33 of 2007), thereby withdrawing the 3.5 percent reservation provided for the

Backward Class Christians so as to enable them to compete within the reservation provided for the Backward Classes. Consequently, the roster specified in the Government Order fourth cited has been revised in the Government Order seventh cited.

4. Based on this order, the rotations/turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen under Backward Classes (other than Backward Class Muslims) Category have been revised and refixed as in the Annexures-I, II and III to this letter. The Government also direct that in respect of other categories viz., General Turn, Backward Class Muslims, Most Backward Classes and Denotified communities, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes the rotations/turns already specified in the Government letter sixth cited shall be continued. In respect of the reservation for the physically handicapped persons, the orders issued in the Government Orders first and fifth cited shall be strictly adhered to.

3. In pursuance of the aforesaid Tamil Nadu Ordinance No.9 of 2008, the roster prescribed in the Government Order second read above is revised as in the Annexure to this order. The

Government direct that the roster prescribed in this order shall be made applicable in respect of those selections made by the recruiting agencies and appointments made on or after 22.10.2008 namely, the date of publication of the said Ordinance in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette. 2. **Definitions:-** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires.
 - a) "Act" means the Tamil Nadu Arunthathiyars (Special Reservation of seats in Educational Institutions including Private Educational Institutions and of appointments or posts in the Services under the State within the Reservation for the Scheduled Castes) Act, 2009 (Tamil Nadu Act 4 of 2009);
 - b) "Arunthathiyars" means the castes, Arunthathiyar, Chakkiliyan, Madari, Madiga, Pagadai, Thoti and Adi-Andhra within the list of 76 Scheduled Castes notified by the President of India under Article 341 of the Constitution of India by the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950 as amended from time to time.
3. **Reservation of seats for Arunthathiyars:-** In the sixteen per cent of seats offered to Arunthathiyars within the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes for admission in Educational Institutions including Private Educational Institutions and of appointments or posts in the services under the State the first seat shall be offered to Arunthathiyars as illustrated below:-

Out of 100 seats, 18 seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes in the following rotation:-

The seats to Arunthathiyars shall be offered in rotation 2, 32 and 66.

4. **Powers and functions of the competent authority:-** The competent authority shall have the power to inspect the Private Educational Institutions as to whether the seats offered to Arunthathiyars as provided in the Act as well as in Rules 3 is implemented in those Institutions. He shall also make enquiry when ordered by the Government.

5. **Period within which report under sub-section (1) of section 10 to 99 submitted:-** The competent authority shall report to the Government the result of the enquiry made or the proceedings taken by him within 30 days from the date of order.

In the Government Order second cited, the Government issued orders revising the 100 point roster prescribed in Schedule III to the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services into 200 point roster providing reservation for the Backward Class Christians and the Backward Class Muslims at three and one-half percent each, within the thirty percent reservation available for Backward Classes. Based on the above orders, in the Government letter third cited, the rotations/turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows, Ex-servicemen, Blind, Deaf and Orthopaedically Handicapped in each category of General Turn, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes (other than Backward Class Christians and Backward Class Muslims), Backward Class Christians, Backward Class Muslims and Most Backward Classes and De-notified Communities were specified.

2. In the Government Order fourth cited, the roster specified was revised so as to ensure adequate representation to the Backward class Christians and the Backward Class Muslims. Accordingly, in the Government Letter sixth cited, the rotations/turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen were also revised. It was also ordered therein that in respect of the reservation for the physically handicapped persons, the orders issued in the Government Orders first and fifth cited shall be followed strictly.

3. Consequent on the withdrawal of the 3.5 percent reservation provided for the Backward Class Christians, in the Government Order seventh cited, the said roster was further revised.

Accordingly, in the Government Letter eighth cited the rotations/turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen under Backward Classes (Other than Backward Class Muslims) were also revised.

4. Now the Government of Tamil Nadu has enacted Act No.4 of 2009, thereby offering reservation to Arunthathiyars on preferential basis within the reservation available for Scheduled Castes and the said Act came into force with effect from 29.4.2009. In pursuance of the above Act, the roster prescribed in the Government Order seventh cited has been further revised in the Government Order ninth cited.

5. Based on this order, the rotations/turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen under Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Castes (Arunthathiyars on preferential basis) have been revised and refixed as in the Annexure-I, II, III, IV, V and VI to this letter.

6. The Government also direct that in respect of other categories viz., General Turn, Backward Classes (Other than Backward Class Muslims), Backward Class Muslims, Most Backward Classes and Denotified communities and Scheduled Tribes, the rotations/turns already specified in the Government Letters sixth and eighth cited shall be continued. In respect of the reservation for the physically handicapped persons, the orders in the Government Orders first and fifth cited shall be strictly adhered to.

7. Necessary amendments to the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules will be issued separately.

In the Government Order first read above, the Government issued orders revising the 100 point roster prescribed in Schedule-III to the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services into 200 point roster providing reservation for the Backward Class Christians and the Backward Class Muslims at three and one-half percent respectively, within the thirty percent reservation available for Backward Classes. In the Government Order second read above, the aforesaid roster was revised so as to ensure adequate representation to the Backward Class Christians and the Backward Class Muslims. Consequent on the withdrawal of the 3.5 percent reservation provided for the Backward Class Christians, in the Government Order third read above, the said roster was further revised so as to enable the Backward Class Christians to compete within the reservation provided for the Backward Classes.

2. Now the Government of Tamil Nadu has enacted Act No.4 of 2009, thereby offering reservation to Arunthathiyars on preferential basis within the reservation available for Scheduled Castes and the said Act came into force with effect from 29.4.2009. In pursuance of the above Act, the roster prescribed in the Government order third read above is revised as in the Annexure to this order. The Government direct that even after filling up of the required appointments or posts reserved for Arunthathiyars on preferential basis, if more number of qualified Arunthathiyars are available, such excess number of candidates of Arunthathiyars shall be entitled to compete with the Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars in the inter-se merit among them and if any appointments or posts reserved for Arunthathiyars remain unfilled for want of adequate number of qualified candidates, it shall be filled up by Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars.

3. The Government further direct that the roster prescribed in this order shall be made applicable in respect of those selections made by the recruiting agencies and appointments made on or after 29.4.2009. However, the recruiting agencies/appointing authorities are informed that the selections/appointments, if any, already made with reference to the 200 point roster prescribed in the Government Orders first, second and third read above need not be reopened and for further

selections/appointments, the revised roster prescribed in this Government Order shall be continued by the recruiting agencies/appointing authorities from the last turn upto which the selection was already made.

4. The rotations/turns earmarked in respect of Women, Destitute Widows and Ex-servicemen in this regard shall be issued separately.

5. Necessary amendments to the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules shall be issued separately.

Sub: Tamil Nadu Electricity Board - Establishment - Review of suspension cases - Certain guidelines - Issued.

In Chapter-II(3) of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees' Discipline & Appeal Regulations, it has been prescribed that all cases of suspension beyond the period of four months should be reviewed periodically either by the Chief Engineer or Chairman or by the Superintending Engineer as the case may be and in cases where the suspension is not justified for valid reasons, the appropriate authority can revoke the suspension. It has also been prescribed that in cases involving corruption, if the matter has been referred to D.V. & A.C., the suspension may be revoked after consulting the D.V. & A.C. not only as a measure to avoid hardship to the Board employee concerned, but also to reduce additional expenditure to Board. Eventhough specific instructions are available, certain competent authorities are unnecessarily prolonging the suspension cases without valid reasons, which result in unnecessary additional expenditure to the Board by the way of allowing Subsistence Allowance to the suspended employee and also in paying all the Pay and Allowances to the substitute posted in the place of the suspended employee.

2. In view of the above, the following additional instructions/guidelines are issued in respect of all suspension cases, apart from the guidelines prescribed in Chapter-II under the heading "Suspension" of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees' Discipline & Appeal Regulations:

a) If the period of suspension of an employee exceeds five years and the criminal proceeding is not yet finalized, then, such case may be considered for revocation of suspension, after following the due process, subject to the outcome of the order of the Criminal Court;

b) The post which are non-sensitive in character may be identified in each cadre for the purpose of posting the employees concerned after revocation of suspension on review in such cases:

c) In every Division, an Executive Engineer level Committee should be constituted to review the suspension cases once in every three months;

d) In the case of suspension of an employee on the charge of defalcation of Board money where the quantum of such money is very small and if the case could not be finalized before the date of superannuation of the employee, the employee may be allowed to retire revoking the suspension, after framing appropriate charges;

e) The cases of suspension of an employee for the charge which relates to his family / personal reasons and outside the purview of the affairs of the Board, may be considered for revocation;

f) The disciplinary authorities should follow the instructions issued in B.P. Ms. (Ch.) No.142 (SB) dated:13.4.1987 in connection with the time limit prescribed to issue Charge Memo. (The said instructions were also reiterated in Memo. (Per.) No.68860/A23/A232/99-1 (SB) dated:1.2.2000);

g) In cases, where the employees are suspended / proceeded with Disciplinary Proceedings on the charges of production of false certificate / forged evidence of records for securing employment in Board or otherwise, a standard charge sheet may be followed as prescribed in Memo.No.78170/P1/97-5 (SB) dated 20.4.1998. They may also be dismissed from service as per the time limit prescribed in Memo. (Per.) No.68860/A23/A232/99-1 (SB) dated 1.2.2000 after following the procedures laid down in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Employees Discipline & Appeal Regulations and relevant Standing Orders, without any deviation;

h) All the Chief Engineers should conduct quarterly review of the D.P. / Suspension cases under their jurisdiction and send the periodical report to the Secretary / T.N.E.B. in respect of Class I Officers and to the Chief Engineer/Personnel in respect of Class-II, III and IV employees.

3. All the competent Authorities / Officers of the Board are instructed that the above guidelines should be followed scrupulously.

In the Board's Proceedings first cited, the Board has introduced the Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS) to all the employees of T.N.E.B. recruited on or after 1.4.2003. Based on the order, the Board issued guidelines for implementation of CPS vide Proceedings 2nd cited.

2. Accordingly the recoveries made from the employees who are recruited on or after 1.4.2003 have to be maintained in order, as the new Pension Scheme involves investment and management of funds with PFRDA (Third Party) as per Government Order.

3. The following further instructions are issued:

- (a) The total amount lying in CPS fund may be continued to be utilised as internal resources similar to the case of GPF, since Board's borrowing rate is costlier than the applicable rate of GPF interest, till such time of receipt of directions from G.O.T.N. in this regard.
- (b) The entire CPS data (employee-wise & month-wise) may be consolidated from the Circles and updated as on date so as to be ready at any time for remittance by Board Office Audit Branch (BOAB).
- (c) To maintain individual-wise accounts of CPS subscribers, necessary data has to be obtained from concerned Circles every month. For that trial Software already under preparation has to be reviewed and arranged for implementation as pilot study in co-ordination with Computer Centre by Board Office Audit Branch (BOAB).
- (d) To facilitate effective CPS data processing approval is hereby accorded for procuring a server at a cost of Rs.2 Lakhs (Rupees Two Lakhs only) by Chief Engineer/IT after obtaining necessary technical sanction and budget provision.

All the Superintending Engineers are therefore advised to intimate their deductees (Officers/ Staff, Suppliers, Contractors including Non-Resident Contractors etc.,) to obtain and furnish their PAN **on or before 31.03.2010** so as to avoid TDS at a higher rate. PRESS RELEASE

A new provision relating to tax deduction at source (TDS) under the Income Tax Act 1961 will become applicable with effect from 1st April 2010. Tax at higher of the prescribed rate or 20% will be deducted on all transactions liable to TDS, where the Permanent Account Number (PAN) of the deductee is not available. The law will also apply to all non-residents in respect of payments / remittances liable to TDS. As per the new provisions, certificate for deduction at lower rate or no deduction shall not be given by the assessing office under section 197, or declaration by deductee under section 197A for non-deduction of TDS on payments shall not be valid, unless the application bears PAN of the applicant / deductee.

2. All deductors are liable to deduct tax at the higher rate in all transactions not having PAN of the deductees on or after 1st April 2010. In order that there is no dispute regarding quoting / non-quoting of PAN or accuracy thereof, the law requires all deductees and deductors to quote PAN of deductees in all correspondences, bills, vouchers and other documents sent to each other. All deductors are, therefore, advised to intimate their deductees to obtain and furnish their PAN so as to avoid TDS at a higher rate. All deductees, including non-residents having transactions in India liable to TDS, are advised to obtain PAN by 31st March 2010 and communicate the same to their deductors before tax is actually deducted on transactions after that date.

3. The procedure for obtaining PAN is simple, inexpensive and quick. Application for PAN can be filed in Form 49A to National Securities Depository Ltd. (NSDL) or Unit Trust of India Investor Services Ltd. (UTIISL) or their intermediaries. Non-residents can apply through the local embassy / consulate of India. Applications can also be filed, paid for or tracked online through the

In continuation of the above references, the following clarification are issued regarding deduction under section 80CCD for contribution made under pension in the light of Circular No.1/2010 Dt.11.1.2010 (vide reference 2 cited) issued on the subject of Deduction of Tax at Source etc.

1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 80CCD, deduction in respect of contribution made by an individual in the previous year to his account under a pension scheme notified, is allowed in computation of his total income in the case of an employee, ten per cent (10%) of his salary in the previous year.

2. Further where the **Central Government or any other employer** makes any contribution to the account of employee for the pension scheme, the assessee shall also be allowed a deduction in the computation of his total income of the whole of the amount contributed by the Central Govt. or any other employer as does not exceed 10% of his salary in the previous year.

3. The Salary for the purpose of section 80CCD includes dearness allowance if the terms of employment so provide, but excludes all other allowances and perquisites.

4. The Aggregate limit of deduction under section 80CCD along with Sections 80C, 80CCC shall not in any case exceed Rupees One lakh.

In order to connect the wind mills to the Substation for power evacuation of wind energy, Board has collected the Infrastructure Development charges (IDC) as per the request of the generator, since they cannot establish and maintain sub-station and tie lines and dedicated transmission lines as per section 10(1) of EA 2003. Since the TNERC has stayed the BP (FB) No.146, dt.4.7.2005 for enhancement of IDC amount from Rs.25.75 Lakhs to Rs.28.75 Lakhs/MW, the Board has been collected Rs.25.75 Lakhs/MW.

Based on the petition MP No.27 of 2008 filed by the Indian Wind Energy Association, the Hon'ble TNERC on 19.9.2008 had ordered that the BP under reference (1) & (2) are set aside and restrained the Board to collect the IDC amount from the wind mill Generators.

Against the TNERC order dt.19.9.2008, the Board has filed an appeal petition No.93 of 2009 at Hon'ble ATE, New Delhi. On 8.1.2010, the Hon'ble ATE has delivered the Judgment as follows.

"Para 12. In view of the above situation, the expenditure has been incurred by the Appellant for establishing, operating and maintaining the sub-stations on behalf of the generators to do the evacuation work up to the interconnection point. The Generating Company is liable to pay the said expenditure to the Appellant in the name of IDC fixed by the Appellant through various circulars as per the mutual arrangement and mutual agreement between the parties.

Para 13. In view of the above, the impugned order dated 19.9.2008 is incorrect in law and therefore the same is liable to be set aside. Accordingly set aside. The Appellant is entitled to continue to collect IDC from the generators so long as the facility is availed of by the generators, as per the circular".

As the TNERC restrained the Board from collection of IDC amount vide its order dt.19.9.2008, the Board has been permitted Wind Generators for registration of application and commissioning

of their WEG's without IDC amount with a condition that if the judgment is in favour of Board for the appeal petition filed against the TNERC order dt.19.9.2008, the Wind Generators are liable to pay the IDC amount as per the order.

Since the TNERC order dated 19.9.2008 has been set aside by the Hon'ble ATE, in order to collect the IDC amount from 19.9.2008, demand notices were sent to the wind energy generators to pay the IDC amount @ Rs.28.75 Lakhs / MW along with interest at 12% from the date of registration of the application within 15 days.

For the notices given, the Indian Wind Turbine Manufacturers Association has requested to collect the IDC @ Rs.25.75 Lakhs/MW with 12% interest from the date of ATE's order dt.8.1.2010 and to adjust the IDC amount in the September 2009 and October 2009 power purchase bill amounts to be settled to the Generators for the WEG commissioned cases.

After careful consideration Tamil Nadu Electricity Board approves the following proposals:

The Board directed that the IDC approved by Board at the relevant point of time is to be paid with the interest @ 12% till the final settlement. However if any installment or adjustment is requested for, the Chairman is authorized to adjust or collect 50% first in one go and the balance in a maximum of 6 (six) monthly installments.

2. Amendment of sub regulation (7) of regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations:

In sub regulation (7) of the regulation 7 of the principal Regulations, for the expression "the forum shall complete enquiry" the following expression namely:-

"the forum shall initiate an enquiry in regard to the complaint after serving a notice of the said enquiry on the complainant and the licensee concerned, mentioning "date, time and venue" of the enquiry by registered post with acknowledgement and complete the said enquiry" shall be substituted.
