Sub: Establishment - TANGEDCO - Sanction of fees to Standing Counsels, Advocates, learned Advocate General/Additional Advocate General/Senior Advocate engaged by the corporation and payment then and there - Instruction - Issued.

In the orders issued from time to time, powers have been delegated to various authorities of the Corporation to sanction legal fees claimed by the Standing Counsels/ Advocates engaged by the Corporation and Advocate-on-Record/Supreme court. In respect of sanction of fees to other Advocates, Senior Advocates and learned Advocate General/Additional Advocate Generals of Tamil Nadu and special fees to the standing Counsels, the Chairman-cum-Managing Director has been delegated with powers to sanction the fees on case to case basis.

- 2. Of late, it is noticed that such fee claims are not sanctioned and paid then and there, which resulted in filing writ petitions against the Corporation for directions to the corporation to pay their fees with interest. It is also noticed that the fee claims, either made as per norms or special fee claims, as the case may be, are not processed but kept pending without any reason. In those Writ Petitions, the Hon'ble High Court has directed the Corporation to pay the fees in a time bound manner. Had the respective offices processed the claims for sanction and made payment then and there, such litigations could have been avoided. Further, such of those litigations cause much inconvenience and embarrassment to the Corporation.
- 3. Therefore, all the Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers and the officers in equivalent rank are directed to instruct their subordinate officers to consider the sanction of fees of the Standing Counsels, Advocates, Advocate-on-Record/Government of Tamil Nadu at New Delhi, Senior Advocates and learned Advocate General/Additional Advocate Generals of Tamil Nadu and to ensure that the actual payment has been made then and there.
- 4. Further, all the Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers and the officers in equivalent rank are also directed to ensure the compliance, in order to avoid frequent representation to the Top Officers of the Corporation and unnecessary litigations before the Court.

PROCEEDINGS:

The Chief Engineer/Mechanical/Thermal Stations/Chennai has submitted a proposal to create one post of Deputy Chief Chemist and and one post of Senior Chemist for Mettur Thermal Power station - II (1 x 600 MW) for the effective functions in Chemical Division to which he has elaborated that, maintaining of chemical parameters as per specification in various samples, monitoring generator coolant

stator water and hydrogen gas purity, analysis of coal; high quality of water regime and parameters to be mentioned in water steam cycle in parts per billion (ppb) levels; condensate polishing Unit (CPU) regeneration plant which involves Ion exchage technology for removal of traceable level of impurities such as dissolved minerals, suspended matters and silica etc; cooling water treatment with various chemical dosing system like chlorine dosing and biocide treatment have to be done for which separate chemical plant is provided in cooling water plant area; common effluent treatment plant and sewage disposal system which comes under stringent pollution control norms are to be monitored and reported periodically. SWAS - Steam water analysis system for boiler water, steam, feed water and condensate water; in addition to that express lab in shift, fuel lab and main lab are to be formed with adequate instruments and equipments for carrying out various routine and critical analysis works and to maintain chemical regime of 600 MW Thermal Power Plant. In para 3 of the Government order read above, among others, it has been ordered that the disciplinary cases of the pensioners who belong to State service along be sent to the Government and other cases shall be dealt with by the Heads of the Department concerned.

 Based on the above said Government Order, the following amendment is made to Rule-9 of Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978 and accordingly the following Notification will be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, <u>Extraordinary</u>, dated: 12.8.2013.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978:-

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules, in rule 9, -

- (1) In the marginal heading, "for the expression "Government", the expression "competent authority" shall be substituted.
 - (2) in sub-rule (1), -
 - (a) in clause (a), -
- (i) for the expression "The Government reserve to themselves", the expression "The competent authority reserves to itself" shall be substituted.
 - (ii) for the first proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely,

"Provided that before passing an order under this clause, if the pensioner does not agree to such withholding or withdrawal of the pension, the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission shall be consulted by the Government. In respect of pensioners who belonged to service other than the State Service, the Head of the Department concerned shall refer the case to the Government and the Government, after consulting the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, shall intimate the views of the Commission to the Head of the Department concerned for issue of final orders. The Tamil Nadu Public Service commission need not be consulted in cases where the pensioner agrees to withholding or withdrawal of the pension but a copy of the orders passed by the competent authority in such cases shall be sent to the said Commission":

- (b) in clause (b),
- (i) for the expression

"The government shall also have the right of ordering recovery", the expression "the competent authority shall also have the right of ordering recovery" shall be substituted;

(ii) for the proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

"Provided that before passing an order under this clause, the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission shall be consulted by the Government in respect of pensioners belonged to state service and in respect of pensioners who belonged to service other than State Service, the Head of the Department concerned, after arriving at the amount of recovery, shall refer the case to the Government and the Government, after consulting the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission shall intimate the views of the Commission to the Head of the Department concerned for issue of final orders";

- (2) In sub rule (2), -
- (a) in clause (a), for the proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

"Provided that where the departmental proceedings are instituted by an authority subordinate to the Government, that authority shall submit a report recording its findings to the Government in case of pensioners who belonged to the State Service:

- (b) in clause (b) in sub-clause (i), the expression "in respect of pensioners who belonged to State Service" shall be added at the end:
- (2) in sub-rule (5), for the expression "Where the Government decide", the expression "Where the competent authority decides" shall be substituted.
 - (3) after sub-rule (6), the following sub-rule shall be added, namely:-
- "(7) For the purpose of this rule, the term 'competent authority' shall mean the Government in respect of the pensioners who belonged to State Service and the Head of the Department concerned in respect of other pensioners".

Please refer to the instructions issued in ref. (1) to (4), on insisting of planning permit and Compliance certificate from the competent authority for providing power connection to the Special and multistored buildings and the definition of Special buildings as per the Development regulations for Second Master plan for Chennai Metropolitan area and clarifications issued by CMDA.

As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court in common order dated 6.9.2013 in W.P.Nos16780 of 2013 and etc. batch, the following instructions are issued for strict adherence.

- By virtue of common order dated 6.9.2013 in W.P.Nos16780 of 2013 and etc. batch, it is made clear by the High Court itself that the mandate of the First Bench of the Madras High Court in Consumer Action Group Vs-State of Tamil Nadu {2006 (4) CTC 483} has to be followed.
- 2) Therefore, in respect of pending and future writ petitions on effecting of electricity service connection to the Special and Multi-storied buildings, the CEs/SEs concerned shall file Counter affidavits duly mentioning the decision of the First Bench (High Court order dt. 23.8.2006 in W.P.No.18898 of 2000 and etc. batch) and the instructions issued by the Board/TANGEDCO from time to time and the common order issued in W.P.No.16780 of 2013 and etc. batch dt. 6.9.2013. The Standing Counsels may be requested to ensure the above while filing Counter Affidavits.
- 3) In respect of all future orders, if any passed by the learned Single Judge in writ petitions directing the TANGEDCO to effect service connection to the Special/Multi-storied buildings without insisting Completion Certificate from the competent authority, the CEs/SEs concerned shall file writ appeal thereagainst (together with affidavit and stay petition) immediately, without referring such orders to the Headquarters, so as to file such appeal within the limitation period of thirty days and to await the order that may be passed in such writ appeal. In that case, the thread on initiation of contempt proceedings may be avoided.

PROCEEDINGS:

This proposal envisages the approval for providing capacitor banks, necessitated at sub-stations for compensating the VAr requirement by distribution loads.

- 2) Installation of capacitor Banks are very much required to keep bus voltage within the standard limit to supply quality power and in turn useful to limit the VAr Generation in all generating stations. The National Power Committee has suggested that capacitor installation plan at 132 KV and below needed to be carried out by the States.
- 3) Based on the suggestion, the Shunt Compensation studies has been carried out for 2013-2014 conditions and it is required to install 11KV capacitor banks of 110.4 MVAR, 22 KV capacitor banks of 44.4 MVAr, 33 KV capacitor banks of 2.4 MVAr and 110 KV capacitor banks of 168 MVAr in the Substations listed in Annexure - I.
- 4) The tentative estimated cost works out to Rs.21.20 Crores Gross and Nett. and is based on the TANTRANSCO cost data for the year 2013-14. The rate adapted for 33 KV Capacitor bank is the prevailing market rate. The detailed estimate is enclosed as Annexure -II.
 - 5) The CMD/TANGEDCO, after careful consideration approves the following:
- i) Installation of 110.4 MVAR Capacitor banks at 11 kv level, 44.4 MVAR Capacitor banks at 22 kv level, 2.4 MVAR Capacitor banks at 33 kv level and 168 MVAR Capacitor banks at 110 kv level at an estimated cost of Rs. 21.20 Crores.
- ii) Execution of above works by the Transmission wing with budgetary provision based on the different field condition and space availability.

- 2.0 Load flow study has been conducted for the power evacuation from M/s. Tannex Power Generation Ltd.'s 2x55 MW CPP and the following transmission scheme has been finalized.
- a) "Erection of 1.25 Km of 230 KV DC Line on DC Tower from M/s. Tannex to Cuddalore-Villupuram 230 KV Line thus making LILO at power plant end"
- b) "Erection of 230 KV Switching station at the LILO point in the company premises" and charging the O&M expenses of 230 KV Switching station to the company.

The above Transmission scheme has been finalized by restoring the 230 KV Cuddalore - Villupuram line.

REPORT TO ACCOMPANY THE ESTIMATE

This proposal envisages Transmission scheme for solar power evacuation in Ramnad and Virudhunagar Districts in Tamil Nadu at an estimated cost of Rs 208.50 Crores (Gross) & Rs.204.70 Crores (Nett).

2 NEED

To accommodate 430 MW of Solar plants under LOI scheme & REC Scheme in Ramnad and Virudhunagar districts, it is essential to establish a new 400 KV SS at Kamudhi area and a new 230KV SS at Muthuramalingapuram area and few more 230 KV substations in Virudhunagar district. Erection and commissioning of new substation takes a minimum of 15 -18 months. But the solar plants under LOI Scheme have to be connected to the Grid, within the time frame stipulated in the Letter of Acceptance.

- 2.1 Hence the following Transmission scheme as an interim measure is proposed at Kamudhi area for connecting the solar power plants in and around Muthuramalingapuram and Kamudhi area.
- Erection of 65 Km 230 KV DC line with Zebra conductor from the proposed 230/110-33 KV SS near Muthuramalingapuram to Kavanoor 230/110 KV SS to be LILO at the proposed New Kamudhi SS, initially charged at 110 KV level.
- Enhancement of 2x50 MVA 230/110 KV Auto Transformers into 3x100 MVA 230/110 KV Auto transformers at Kavanoor 230 KV SS.
- \bullet Enhancement of 1x16 MVA 110/33 KV Power Transformer into 1x25 MVA and erection of additional 2x25 MVA 110/33 KV Power Transformers at Muthuramalingapuram 110 KV SS.
- Erection of 230 KV DC line with Zebra conductor from Kavanoor to Karaikudi 230/110 KV SS for a distance of 85 Km.

3.0 PROPOSED CONNECTIVITY ARRANGEMENTS:

- There will be 230 KV and 110 KV bus without 230/110-33 KV Transformers at New 230/110-33 KV SS near Muthuramalingapuram. As an interim measure, the two buses will be temporarily looped so as to energise the 230 KV lines towards Kavanoor initially with 110 KV supply.
- The 230 KV DC line from New Kamudhi to Kavanoor will be terminated at 110 KV side of Kavanoor SS as an interim measure. But in the Permanent arrangement it has to be shifted to the 230 KV side of Kavanoor 230 KV SS.

- During interim arrangement, the 230 KV lines and the New Kamudhi 230 KV bus is charged at 110 KV level, M/s. MBDL Ltd. who has sought for 100 MW connectivity, will be limited to 60 MW at 110 KV level along with their 10 MW plant. The entire quantum of M/s.MBDL will be connected at 230 KV level, once the permanent arrangement is established.
- The existing bus at the existing Muthuramalingapuram 110 KV SS has to be separated into two buses(A&B) with Bus coupler (Normally kept open) arrangement. The 25 MW plant of M/s.Cape Infrastructure Ltd. is to be connected in the existing 110 KV bus (A) section. All the three 110/33 KV, 25 MVA Power transformers are to be connected to Bus (B) which will be in turn connected with Kallurani SS by erecting 110 KV DC lines.
- M/s.KSK Ltd's 41 MW plant and M/s.Swiss Park &Co Ltd's 36 MW plants are to be connected to Kallurani SS at 110 KV level.
