When a government servant is facing disciplinary action under rule 17(b) of the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, and he reaches the age of superannuation, the appointing authority has to decide, depending on the gravity of the lapses, whether to allow him to retire and to continue the disciplinary proceeding under the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978 or to keep him under suspension and to retain him in service under FR 56(1) (c). When the lapses are not so grave and not warranting imposition of any of the major penalty viz. removal or dismissal for service or compulsory retirement, the delinquent officer is allowed to retire by mentioning in the retirement order that he is permitted to retire from service without prejudice to the disciplinary action pending against him.

- 2) The Division Bench of the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, in its order dated 2.12.2010 in W.A. (MD) No. 698 of 2010 and W.A. (MD) No. 721 of 2010, while deciding the issue whether a government servant facing disciplinary proceedings can be allowed to retire from service on attaining the age of superannuation without prejudice to the pending disciplinary Proceedings, has observed that, the expression "without prejudice to the pending disciplinary action and other statutory actions" found in the impugned order should be constructed to mean that the disciplinary proceeding initiated under section 17(b) of the Rules shall be deemed to be a proceedings initiated under rule 9(2) (a) of the Pension Rules and the same may be continued, which may result in any order under Rule 9(1) of the Pension Rules.
- 3) Based on the said observation of the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in W.A. (MD) No. 698 of 2010 and W.A. (MD) No. 721 of 2010. the government examined the issue in detail and decided not to use the expression "permitted to retire from service without prejudice to the disciplinary proceedings pending". Instead, in such cases, where the disciplinary authority decides that the lapses/charges are not so grave in nature and does not warrant imposition any of the major penalty like removal or dismissal or compulsory retirement, the authority may allow the delinquent officer to retire from service by specifically mentioning in the retirement order that the disciplinary proceedings pending shall be continued under rule 9 of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978.
- 4) Taking into consideration the need for uniformity in this regard, the Government hereby prescribe a model format annexed to this letter.
- The disciplinary authority concerned are requested to adopt the above format scrupulously.

The main objective of Renovation and Modernization of power generating units is to make the operating units well equipped/ modified/augmented with latest Technology equipments/components/ systems with a view to improve their performance in terms of efficiency, output, reliability and availability to the original values, reduction in maintenance requirements and ease of maintenance and to overcome problems due to generic defects, design deficiency, ageing obsolescence of equipments, non availability of spares, inefficiency of generating units, stringent environment regulations and safety requirements, etc. The normal waxpacted of generation of a B.B.3 (Sep.13)

thermal unit varies from 25 to 30 years. The life of these units can be further extended to another 15 to 20 years by carrying out necessary Residual Life Assessment (RLA) & Life Extension (LE) studies followed by Renovation and Modernization works. The Central Electricity Authority has identified Tuticorin Thermal Power Station Units I, II,& III and Mettur Thermal Power Station Units I & II under National Perspective Plan for Renovation and Modernization and life extension of Thermal Stations, as the 210 MW Units have completed/are near completion of their normal design life. Moreover, proposal for conducting Energy audit in all Thermal Power Stations are under process to improve the performance of the Thermal Power Stations.

- 2. Further, heat rate target has been fixed by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency under Perform, Achieve and Trade (PAT) scheme which has to be achieved by all Thermal Stations before March 2015 or otherwise the Central Electricity Authority will impose penalty for non achievement of heat rate target fixed by them. In the Government letter (Ms) first cited, detailed instructions were issued fixing the time limit for disposal of disciplinary cases at various levels.

- Further, in the Government Order second cited, instructions were issued to avail delay in processing the disciplinary cases and to ensure that suspension orders are not issued on the date of retirement of the Government Servant.
- In the letter third cited, instructions were issued to follow the time limit in finalising the Disciplinary/Vigilance cases without fail so as to avoid delay.
- 4. Inspite of the above instructions/guidelines, certain Heads of Departments are still sending the proposal at the eleventh hour to the Government leaving no time to examine the case in a detailed manner. It also causes much administrative inconvenience to the Government. Further, prolonged delay in finalizing the disciplinary proceedings has also been adversely commented by the Hon'ble High Court in various judgments.
- 5. In view of the above, all the Departments of Secretariat and Head of Department are requested to follow the instructions issued in the references cited and finalise the disciplinary proceedings within the prescribed time limit. If at all the Heads of Department feel that the Government Orders are necessary in a disciplinary proceedings, the proposal should be sent to Government well in advance. It is also reiterated that, it is the responsibility of the Disciplinary authority to ensure that the above instructions are followed scrupulously.
