PROCEEDINGS:

As per the proviso under regulation 36(a) of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations, the annual increments of the employees are regulated in four quarters viz. 1st January, 1st April, 1st July and 1st October. However, there is no provision to sanction annual increments in the case of the employees who have rendered one full year of service and retire on superannuation on the last date on completion of one year, as their increment due date falls on the next day of superannuation. As such, an anomalous situation arises in the case of those who retire on the day prior to the said dates, viz. 31st December, 31st March, 30th June and 30th September as the case may be, inspite of the fact that they have completed one full year of service which are countable for increment. In order to avoid such anomalous situation, the Government in its order third read above, have ordered that a Government servant whose increment falls due on the day following superannuation, on completion of one full year of service which are countable for increment, be sanctioned with one notional increment, purely for the purpose of pensionary benefits and not for any other purpose. After careful consideration, the Board of TANGEDCO has decided to adopt the same in TANGEDCO.

2. Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that an officer/employee of TANGEDCO whose increment falls due on the day following superannuation, on completion of one full year of service which are countable for increment under regulation 36(a) of TNEB Service Regulations, be sanctioned with one notional increment at the rate as described under regulation 6 of TANGEDCO Revised Pay (Workmen) & (Officers) Regulations, 2011, purely for the purpose of pensionary benefits and not for any other purpose.

3. The above orders shall be deemed to have come into effect from 31.12.2014, i.e. the date of issue of the G.O. third read above.

4. Necessary amendments to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations will be issued separately.

In continuation to the above, it is informed that the illustrations for billing for load change and tariff change are enclosed for deployment in the LT software billing.

2.0) As stated in the ref. (5), the rate of fixed charges is monthly/bi-monthly (i.e., 30 days/ 60 days). For calculating the Fixed charges during tariff change, load change, etc., the date of such change may be included in the new tariff/new load and calculated accordingly.

3.0) As far as Electricity Tax is concerned, the 5% should be calculated on consumption of unit charges and fixed charges as per Tamil Nadu Tax on Consumption or Sale of Electricity Act, 2003 and the details are as follows.

a) As per section 3 (1), Tax on the consumption or sale of electricity: " Save as otherwise provided in this Act, every licensee and every person other than a licensee shall pay every month to the Government in the prescribed manner, a tax on the **electricity sold or consumed** during the previous month at the rates specified here under....."

b) As per section 2 (7), "Energy Charge means the amount charged (whether as **energy charge or other charge**) by a licensee for the supply of electricity to a consumer before deduction of rebate, if any....."

c) As per Explanation II, to section 2 (7) "other charge" shall include **demand charge and power factor surcharge**.

4.0) In the tariff order issued by the Hon'ble TNERC, the fixed charges for certain categories, viz., II B(1), II B(2), III A (1), III A (2), III B, V & VI are based on the contracted demand. In view of the above, Electricity Tax 5% may be levied on consumed units on the energy charges and fixed charges, as specified by the Hon'ble TNERC.

Hence, it is requested that the above may be deployed in the LT software (legacy & RAPDRP) to levy E. Tax @5% on the energy and Fixed charges for the 7

categories furnished above. Further, the arrear slip may be raised (automatically) for the period from 12.12.2014, if the proportionate billing is not already made by the sections through Computer/HHD.

In principle approval is hereby accorded for implementation of Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) approved by Govt. of India in TANGEDCO. M/s. Power Finance Corporation (PFC) is the nodal agency for the above scheme. The salient features of the scheme are as follows:

a) NAD and DPRs shall be prepared circlewise to cover all the parts of Tamilnadu. It is proposed to implement the works under IPDS in 522 towns out of 721 statutory towns listed by Ministry of Power (MOP)/Government of India (GOI) after excluding towns where R-APDRP works are already being executed. (Annexure)

b) DPR for National Optic Fiber Network (NOFN) component shall be separately prepared and executed by the P&C wing and DPR for implementation of IT infrastructure in project towns and ERP shall be separately prepared and executed by the IT wing after issue of separate guidelines by MOP/GoI.

c) A dedicated team under one Chief Engineer shall be formed for execution of distribution strengthening works including metering and GIS mapping of assets. A separate note for the functions and responsibilities for the wing shall be put up for approval from the competent authority.

d) At present, CE/RAPDRP may be designated as nodal officer of TANGEDCO for the scheme. However, a dedicated cell with separate man power (technical and accounts) in Headquarters and Regions is proposed to be included in the proposal for preparation of DPRs and execution of works since RAPDRP is now handling Part-B works worth Rs.3445 Cr. with just 2 divisions of skeleton staff.

e) Compliance to accounting, fund management, fund utilization, posting of details in PFMS portal, auditing etc shall be handled by the separate accounts wing within the IPDS cell proposed to be created.

f) Roof top solar panels shall be included for own buildings of TANGEDCO as below:

CE office - 50 KW; SE office - 30 KW ; EE office - 10 KW : New SS under IPDS - 5 KW.

g) Strengthening of lines under NEF (National Electricity Fund) schemes are already under taken and hence can be excluded in IPDS.

h) Proof of Concept (PoC) in respect of Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) is being undertaken by CE (IT) and being implemented in Chintadripet O&M division. Hence separate DPR for provision of AMI/Smart meters in 7 Nos. SCADA/DMS towns under IPDS shall be prepared & submitted by CE (IT).

i) Establishment of 33 KV SS in select towns may be restricted to sites where lands inside the project towns are already available and ready to be handed over for construction.

j) Provision of SCADA system in all existing 33/11 KV SS with connectivity to source 110 KV SS is being considered under DDUGJY in R&M category and the same may be excluded under IPDS.

k) Conversion of OH to UG cables in major corporations (other than Chennai) wherever not covered under R-APDRP shall be included.

l) Distribution CEs may be requested to furnish the circle-wise NADs for the towns of their region to furnish the same to the Nodal agency.

m) Works may be executed departmentally with timely procurement of materials by MM wing/Field CEs by e-tendering system.

n) SE/System studies under CE/Planning and RC shall monitor and report TANGEDCO's reduction in AT & C losses as per the trajectory finalised by MoP to the Nodal Agency since SE/SS is already dealing the subject.

o) An appropriate Project Management Agency (PMA) will be appointed to assist in project management ensuring timely completion of the project.

This proposal envisages the road map and strategy for implementation of ERP in TANTRANSCO.

A visit was made by a team of officials comprising of Chief Financial Controller/TANTRANSCO, EE/ERP and AEE/ERP of TANGEDCO to MAHATRANSCO for studying the ERP implemented in their organisation and the best practices followed in MAHATRANSCO was studied. It is seen that with an exclusive dedicated team of willing employees and support from the Top Management, ERP could be implemented successfully in TANTRANSCO. Based on the study, the road map and strategy for implementation of ERP in TANTRANSCO have been formulated.

I. Road Map for implementation of ERP in TANTRANSCO:

a) Administrative approval has been accorded vide Permanent (CH) TANTRANSCO Proceedings No. 222, dt. 12.12.2014 for providing network connectivity for all the offices of TANTRANSCO upto the level of Assistant Engineer and providing delegation of powers to Chief Engineers/Transmission Projects, Operation and Protection & Communication for procuring and maintenance of Computer Hardware. The server for implementing SAP ERP in TANTRANSCO has already been procured in 2012 and is readily available. However the sufficiency of Hardware and technical suitability for implementing all the modules and future expansion will be studied separately in detail and additional hardware if any required would be procured at a later stage.

b) SAP ERP will be implemented in TANTRANSCO in a phased manner. Initially, the following modules which are very vital for effective monitoring and control of Finance will be implemented in the first phase. The other modules which are essential for effective monitoring and control of works and Purchase/Contract Orders etc will be implemented in the second phase. Implementation of Phase I will be done in the GCC circles (Chennai and Coimbatore), Operation Circles (Chennai and Coimbatore), the Protection & Communication circle (Madurai, Coimbatore and Trichy) and the Chief Engineers/Transmission Projects/Chennai and Trichy, Chief Engineer/Operation, Transmission at Head Quarters.

The Hon'ble Commission have issued amendment to regulation 5(6) of TNE

Supply Code and regulation 37 of TNE Distribution code relating to shifting of service/ Line, structure and equipments at the request of consumer, vide Notification No. TNERC/SC/7-36 dated 01.07.2014 and Notification No. TNERC/DC/8-19 dated 01.07.2014. The same has been published in ref. (2) cited.

Hence, superseding the instructions already issued vide ref. (1) cited, the following instructions are issued in respect of preparation of estimates for shifting of service/ line, structure and equipments at the request of consumer.

i) The shifting estimates shall be prepared as per the model estimate enclosed herewith using latest cost data rates.

ii) The reusable materials dismantled at the old site may be utilized for the new work as far as possible, subject to the following conditions.

a) Except RCC/PSC poles, pin insulators, strain disc which are more prone to crack while dismantling, all other dismantled materials which are reusable, may be utilized in the new site. It shall be specifically approved by the sanctioning authority and included in the estimate sanction itself.

b) The damaged insulators etc. that cannot be devoluted to stores as SCRAP should be discarded without giving credit to the consumer. Corroded iron materials such as LT & HT metal parts, pin etc. shall not be reused but devoluted to stores as SCRAP.

c) The reusable materials dismantled at the old site shall not be utilized for the new work as a routine, since it may lead to prolonged interruption of supply which in turn will cause revenue loss to TANGEDCO. Hence, the sanctioning authorities shall permit to reuse the dismantled materials only in the cases where the dismantling of the existing network and re-erection at new site with the dismantled materials, may be carried out with least possible interruption of supply.

d) The sanctioning authorities should not permit to reuse the materials dismantled in large scheme works such as shifting due to road widening at the request of NHAI, Highways, Urban local bodies etc. where the dismantling and re-erection of electrical utilities could not be taken up simultaneously.

iii) The Nett amount of the estimate shall be arrived by deducting the depreciated value of reusable materials devoluted to stores (which should be not less than value of 20% of present value of reusable materials) and 10% of present value of scrap devoluted to stores. The Nett amount of the estimate shall be charged to the consumer. The revised rate of depreciatiion has been communicated vide Lr.No. DFC/BS/D1/D11/F.Depreciation/2014 dated 03.07.2014. The same may be used for calculation of book value/written down value for the re-usable materials devoluted to stores, until further amendment is communicated.

iv) The shifting work shall be commenced only after collection of the estimate amount in full along with an undertaking to pay the shortfall amount if any. A copy of original estimate and also a revised estimate after completion of works have to be furnished to the consumer.

v) Work order shall be closed immediately on completion of the work and excess/short expenditure shall be arranged to be refunded/collected accordingly within 3 months.

vi) Calculation of Labour & Transport charges and Dismantling Charges:

Labour and Transport charges (for loading, unloading and erection of new materials at new location) @15% of cost of materials.
Labour & Transport charges for re-erction of dismantled reusable materials at new site (for loading from old site, unloading at new site and erection at new location) @20% of present value of dismantled materials to be reused at new site.
Dismantling charges for the materials dismantled and to be devoluted to stores @10% of present value of dismantled materials
