Sub : Public services - Departmental action - Consequent on the investigation by the DV&AC - Framing of Charge Memo-Guidelines - Issued.

Ref : 1. Circular Memo.No.93261/A/78-1, P&AR (Per.N) Department, dated 01.12.1978.

2. From the Principal Secretary to Government/P&AR (N) Department, Letter No.45403/N/2014-1, dt. 16.02.2015.

It has been brought to the notice of the Government that certain Disciplinary Authorities, while issuing final orders against the accused officers, are indicating the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption's reference No. and the U.O.Note Nos. of the Vigilance Commission and also about the enquiry conducted by the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and its report. Therefore, the Government have requested the Heads of Departments to follow the correct procedure stipulated in the Circular Memo. first cited in this regard. The same has been examined in detail and it has been decided to issue the following instructions to all the Disciplinary Authorities for strict adherence:-

Part-B note of the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption is a Confidential report containing only relevant information to be communicated by the administrative department of the Secretariat to the Head of the Department or the Tribunal for Disciplinary Proceedings, as the case may be, for taking disciplinary action against the Accused Officer and it should not be made available to the Accused Officer. The mention of the Vigilance Enquiry and Confidential Report in the charge Memoranda is in no way useful for the departmental enquiry, but it defeats the very purpose of maintenance of secrecy. On the other hand, such mention places the Directorate in an embarrassing position, since the Accused Officer may demand, as a matter of right, the filing of this Part "B" Confidential Report as an exhibit and the examination of the Investigation Officer of the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, as a witness in the disciplinary proceedings. To avoid such a situation, charges should be confined only to the offences or irregularities committed by the Accused Officers, as contained in Part-B of the Confidential Report of the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and copies of statement of witnesses, without indicating anything about the enquiry conducted by Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and his report.

PROCEEDINGS:

The Operation wing of TANTRANSCO is carrying out the functions of Load Despatch & Grid Operation of the Tamil Nadu Grid on real time basis, Operation and Maintenance of 5 Nos. of 400 KV Sub-Stations, 78 Nos. of 230 KV Sub-Stations, 15 Nos.of 110 KV Grid Sub-Stations with associated EHT lines with a circuit length of 21822 Kms., under the control of a Load Despatch Centre and 9 Operation Circles. At present, the Chief Engineer/Operation/Chennai is looking after the functions of

Load Despatch Centre comprising of one Main Load Despatch Centre and three Sub Load Despatch Centers and allied activities of TANTRANSCO in the capacity as State Transmission Utility (STU). Further, he is carrying out real time operation of balancing between the generation with the demand to carry out the power management, particularly on a day-to-day basis.

2. Now, TANTRANSCO is in the process of establishing 765 KV Sub-Stations, 400 KV Sub-Stations apart from other EHT Sub-Stations. Therefore, in order to oversee the functions related to Operation and Maintenance of Sub-Stations and its associated EHT lines, and to control all the existing 9 operation circles to have the entire jurisdiction of the state, the Director (Operation)/TANTRANSCO has proposed for redeployment of the existing post of Chief Engineer/Chennai Distribution Development/Chennai with designation as Chief Engineer/System Operation with Headquarters at Chennai and also to re-designate the existing post of Chief Engineer/Operation, Chennai as Chief Engineer/Grid Operation, Chennai, so as to look after the Load Despatch Centre and its allied works. The Chairman/TANTRANSCO has approved the above proposal.

3. Accordingly, sanction is hereby accorded for redeployment of the existing post of Chief Engineer/Chennai Distribution Development/ Chennai which was created and last continued in the references first and third read above, and re-designated as Chief Engineer/System Operation with Headquarters at Chennai to control all the existing 9 operation circles, for a period from the date of utilization of the post and upto 29.02.2016.

4. Consequent to the orders issued in para-3 above, the following are hereby ordered:-

i) The existing post of Chief Engineer/Operation, Chennai shall be re-designated as Chief Engineer/Grid Operation, Chennai and he shall look after the Load Despatch Centre and its allied works. He shall also function as Nodal Officer under the powers of the Headquarters, apart from carrying out the function as State Transmission Utility.

i) The redeployed post of Chief Engineer/System Operation, Chennai shall be delegated with powers to carry out the works relating to Administration, Procurement of Materials, equipments, execution of works, sanctioning of estimates and other powers exercised by the Chief Engineers/Distribution region and Chief Engineers/Transmission Projects-I&II.

5. The incumbent of the post ordered in para-3 above will be eligible to draw the usual pay, Grade Pay, Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance, City Compensatory Allowance and other allowances at the rates admissible under the orders in force wherever applicable.

6. The expenditure is debitable to "TANGEDCO Funds – Revenue Expenses – 75 – Employees costs 75.1 – Salaries – 75.110 – Salaries Provincial".

PROCEEDINGS:

In the proceedings first read above, Board has constituted a fund called "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioner's Health fund" to provide financial assistance to pensioners for undergoing specialized treatment/surgery if they are affected by major ailments. Eye surgery/treatment was also included under Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health fund Scheme. The maximum limit entitled for the Pensioners is Rs.1.00 Lakh or 75% of the actual cost of treatment whichever is less. The said concession was subsequently extended to the spouse of the pensioner and family pensioners from 18.12.2010.

2. In the Government order fourth read above, the Government have issued orders launching the New Health Insurance Scheme for the Pensioner (including spouse)/Family Pensioners on certain conditions.

3. The TANGEDCO after careful consideration has decided to adopt said orders of the Government to the Pensioners (including spouse/family Pensioners on the following basis:

a) the New Health Insurance Scheme shall operate on a CASHLESS basis and it shall be made compulsory to all the pensioners (including spouse)/Family Pensioners;

b) the quantum of assistance shall be fixed as Rs.2.00 lakh (Rupees two lakhs) for both Pensioners (including spouse)/Family Pensioners for a block period of four years from the date of the launch of the Scheme.

c) If the spouse of the pensioners is also a pensioner, the recovery of subscription shall be effected from one person only, based on the option exercised by them.

d) The New Health Insurance Scheme shall be implemented by the Insurance provider finalized from among the Public Sector Insurance provider by following due tender procedure.

e) The amount of the Pensioners contribution to the scheme will be decided after the selection of the Insurance Company and finalization of the costs.

4. Further modalities/terms and conditions for the New Health Insurance Scheme for the Pensioners (including spouse)/Family Pensioners will be issued separately.

In the Board Proceedings first cited above, orders were issued that at the time of retirement, 50% of Unearned Leave on Private Affairs standing at the credit of the employees up to a maximum of 90 days, be entitled for encashment and drawal of full leave salary subject to fulfillment of conditions specified therein. In the Board Proceedings second cited, the above orders were kept in abeyance. In the proceedings third cited, the orders issued in the Board Proceedings first cited, was restored.

2. Now, it has been intimated that certain retired employees have not been sanctioned encashment of Unearned Leave on Private Affairs and the pendency is only due to non availability of Service Book in respect of the said retired employees. It is also to be mentioned that as orders were issued for payment of the instalments of encashment of unearned Leave on Private Affairs commencing from 1st April, 2014, the same was completed in January, 2015, almost all the Pensioners' Associations have requested for sanction of encashment of Unearned Leave on Private

Affairs on obtaining an undertaking from the employees due to non-availability of Service Books. The said requests have carefully been considered.

3. After considering the said requests, the following instructions are issued:-

a) the encashment of 45 days of Unearned Leave on Private Affairs (i.e.50% of the maximum number of days eligible to be encashed) be sanctioned pending availability of Service Registers by duly obtaining an Indemnity Bond, in the enclosed format;

b) the arrears consequent to the said sanction be paid in two monthly installments;

c) the remaining encashment of 45 days of Unearned Leave on Private Affairs (i.e. 50% of the balance number of days eligible to be encashed) be sanctioned only on tracing and verifying the Service Registers.

INDEMNITY BOND

This DEED OF INDEMNITY executed on this the day of Two Thousand and fifteen, by Thiru./Tmt./Selvi.S/o.D/o.W/o.....residing at, hereinafter called the Indemnifier (which term shall mean and include executors, administrators, legal representatives, heirs and assigns) TO AND IN FAVOUR OF the Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited, a Corporation registered under the Companies Act, 1956 and wholly owned by the Government of Tamil Nadu, one of the successor entity to the erstwhile Tamil Nadu Electricity Board (TNEB), represented by the (Sanctioning Authority having office at, hereinafter called the Indemnified or TANGEDCO (which term shall mean and include its successors and assigns).

WHEREAS the Indemnifier has retired from the service of the TNEB/TANGEDCO on Afternoon as (Designation with Circle/Region/office/Branch) and a pensioner assigned with PPO No.

WHEREAS, in (Per) B.P. (FB) No.75 (SB) dated 06.11.1996, orders were issued that at the time of retirement, 50% of UEL on PA standing at the credit of the employees upto a maximum of 90 days, be entitled for encashment and drawal of full leave salary subject to fulfillment of conditions specified therein.

WHEREAS, in (Per.) B.P. (FB) No.76 (SB) dated 11.09.1997, the said benefit was withheld.

WHEREAS, the TANGEDCO, in (Per) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No.52 (Secretariat Branch) dated 14.02.2014, has restored the benefit of encashment of 50% of Un-Earned Leave on Private Affairs (UEL on PA) standing at the credit of the employee at the time of retirement as specified therein.

WHEREAS, as per the said proceedings, dated 14.02.2014, an employee who has not availed even a single day UEL on PA out of maximum 180 days while in service of the TNEB/TANGEDCO, is entitled to encash 90 days of UEL on PA subject to fulfillment of conditions specified.

WHEREAS, to sanction the aforesaid restored benefit by the TANGEDCO, Service Register of the Indemnifier requires verification to ascertain the actual number days of unavailed portion of UEL on PA as on the date of retirement.

WHEREAS representations are received from the retired employees/pensioners that they have not been sanctioned and paid the encashment of UEL on PA on the ground of non-traceability of their Service Registers till date and have expressed hardship.

WHEREAS it has been informed that the Service Register of the Indemnifier could not be traceable in the office of the sanctioning authority concerned of the TANGEDCO till date and as such the actual number of days of unavailed portion of UEL on PA as on the date of retirement could not be verified/ascertained.

WHEREAS to mitigate the hardship caused to such of those retired employees/pensioners due to non-traceability of the Service Registers, it is decided by the TANGEDCO to sanction and draw 45 days of UEL (i.e. 50% of the maximum number of days eligible to be encashed) in two instalments and to sanction and draw the remaining eligible days of UEL on PA for encashment purpose on tracing and verifying the Service Register, subject to execution of a Deed of Indemnity by the retired employee concerned, Indemnifying the TANGEDCO against any excess payment/loss discovered at a later date.

AND WHEREAS the Indemnifier, who, to the best of his knowledge, has not availed the UEL on PA during his/her service, agreed to execute the Indemnity as aforesaid and the TANGEDCO has also agreed to honour the same.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSES THAT in consideration of the TANGEDCO sanctioning and drawing 45 days of UEL on PA (i.e. 50% of the maximum number of days eligible to be encashed), the Indemnifier hereby unconditionally undertakes to pay on demand to the TANGEDCO, all monies which may be discovered to have been paid in excess of actual eligibility together with all costs and expenses and the TANGEDCO, in addition to proceed against the Indemnifier in accordance with law, shall also have the right to recover such excess payment from any of the amount that may be due and payable to the Indemnifier and this Deed of Indemnity is irrevocable.

In the proceedings cited, orders have been issued for creation of two posts of Internal Audit Officer in the Office of the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Audit Branch, Chennai temporarily to authorize the pension/family pension and to supervise the pension works for a period of one year from the date of utilization of the posts (or) till the completion of the said works, whichever is earlier. Sub : Establishment – TANGEDCO – Transfer and Postings - Guidelines reiterated - Additional Instructions - Issued.

Ref : Memorandum No. 21060/A18/A181/2015-1, dt.07.04.2015.

In the Memorandum cited, certain instructions have been issued to streamline the transfers and postings of officials. It has been brought to the notice that transfer orders issued by the Secretariat Branch and Administrative Branch of Headquarters are not complied with meticulously in various circles/offices. The failure of the competent authorities in relieving the officials (under orders of transfer) within a reasonable time, creates lot of inconvenience to such officials in assuming duties at the new posts. Due to this, the Headquarters could not maintain the exact incumbency list & vacancy position. Hence, it is considered necessary that the competent authorities, on receipt of transfer orders from the Headquarters, should comply with it immediately, by relieving the individuals from the present post, so as to enable them join in the new post. Accordingly, the following instructions are issued to all the Competent Authorities for strict adherence:

- (a) All the orders issued by the Headquarters should be obeyed immediately;
- (b) The orders of transfer/posting should be implemented within a reasonable time;
- (c) The officials transferred should be relieved off by making suitable alternative arrangements. Only after relieving the particular individual, the fact should be reported to the Headquarters for posting a suitable substitute or otherwise;
- (d) The status of implementation of the transfer orders should be informed immediately and a report in this regard, should be sent to the Competent Authority immediately;
- (e) Suitable disciplinary action will be taken against the concerned officers who failed to adhere to the aforesaid instructions.

On re-introduction of double channel of promotion for Regular Work Establishment categories in Distribution Circles, the Regular Work Establishment employees were permitted to exercise option to chose their line as Commercial Assistant- Commercial Inspector - Foreman I Grade or Wireman - Line Inspector - Foreman I Grade.

3) Consequent on the above conversion, it has been represented to allow movement to Selection Grade to the Regular Work Establishment employees taking into account of the service rendered in both the equivalent cadres in the same scale of pay.

4) The request has been examined in detail. After careful consideration, it is hereby clarified that the services rendered by the Regular Work Establishment Employees by conversion in Distribution Circles in the same Pay Band with same Grade Pay in the former cadre shall also be taken into account along with the service in the present cadre for the purpose of movement to Selection Grade provided such service is taken into account for fixation of seniority for promotion and this will be applied on case to case basis whenever such question arises for movement to Selection Grade.

In the Circular Memo under reference (1) to (2) cited instructions have been issued for stipulation of supply experience in the tender documents to be floated.

During the Board meeting under reference cited it has been discussed that wherever the nature of work which is not a regular work to be undertaken by any Electricity Utilities which may arise once in a while and also depends upon the specific requirement of any organization, the stipulation of period of 10 years as experience in BQR will be restrictive in nature.

The stipulation of minimum period of experience has been reviewed and carefully examine and the following has been decided.

The period of supply /works experience may be modified as Ten years instead of 5 years.

In case of special nature of supply/work, wherever the nature of work which is not a regular work to be undertaken by any Electricity Utilities which may arise once in a while and also depends upon the specific requirement, the period of experience requirement to be stipulated in BQR may be decided after getting the approval of BLTC so as to ensure the prospective bidders to participate in the tender.

Hence, all Tender Inviting Authorities are instructed that the period of supply experience may be stipulated as below:

“The tenderers should have supplied the required quantity of tendered materials/ execute the work or higher size or higher rating put together during the proceeding ten years as on the date of tender opening.”

In case of special nature of supply/work, wherever the nature of work which not a regular work to be undertaken by any power Utilities which may arise once in a while and also depends upon the specific requirement, the period of experience requirement to be stipulated in BQR may be decided after getting the approval of BLTC so as to ensure the prospective bidders of participate in the tender.

The Tender Inviting Authorities are requested to adhere the instructions as above and incorporate in the tender document for the tenders to be floated.

The instructions as above shall be applicable to all Tender Inviting Authorities of TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO.

Implementation of Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) in TANGEDCO – In principle approval for Implementation - Approval Accorded – Orders Issued.

PROCEEDINGS:

1. **MoP/GoI** has launched Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) for the Urban areas vide O.M.No.26/2014- APDRP, dt.03.12.2014. The Nodal agency for the scheme is M/s PFC, New Delhi. The scheme is to be implemented in all statutory towns(ST) as per Census 2011. Out of 721 Statutory Towns (STs) of Tamilnadu notified by the Nodal agency, 522 Nos STs have been identified since the balance 199 STs are already covered under R-APDRP scheme.

2. Project formulation :

a) 1st stage: Utility shall prepare a Need Assessment Document (NAD) in prescribed format containing all relevant information and cost estimates.

b) 2nd stage: Utilities will formulate bankable Detailed Project Reports(DPRs) based on detailed field survey and latest approved schedule of rates for various items of work. These DPRs, duly recommended by the Distribution Reforms Committee (DRC) at the State level, will have to be submitted by the utilities to the Nodal agency for appraisal.

3. Submission & Approval of DPRs: The circle/zone/Utility wise DPRs shall be prepared by the utility and recommended by Distribution Reforms Committee (DRC) at State level.

3.1 Separate consolidated DPR for ERP component shall be prepared by respective state.

3.2 National Optical Fiber Network (NOFN): Separate DPR shall be prepared for the NOFN component which envisages to connect all the 33 KV or 66 KV grid substations/ billing offices/Regional/Circle/Zonal offices of Discoms by extending optic fiber network being established under NOFN.

4. Mode of Implementation: It has been decided to execute the works under partial turnkey where in materials will be procured at Headquarters and Field officers and the erection works will be executed through K2 Agreement. The same shall be informed to the Nodal agency while submission of DPRs with approval from the Distribution Reforms Committee.

5. Implementation Period: In case of execution on partial turnkey/ departmental basis, project needs to be completed within 30 months (24 months for implementation and 6 months for placement of awards for supply and services i.e. erection) from date of communication of the approval of the Monitoring committee.

6. Dedicated team for implementation of projects: Utility shall have to create a dedicated team for implementation of projects at field and Utility/State levels including necessary manpower and requisite infrastructure like office, logistics etc. to ensure smooth implementation and monitoring and to redress grievance of public and public representatives of the project areas. The details of the dedicated team have to be mentioned in the DPR. An officer of the rank of Chief Engineer/ General Manager or above, will have to be designated as Nodal Officer from the dedicated team at utility/ state level.

7. The **financial support** under the scheme shall be as under: 60% - GoI's grant component, 30% - Loan/own fund and 10% own fund. Additional grant of 15% on timely completion and maintaining AT&C loss trajectory.

8. Appointment of PMA in TANGEDCO : One of the pre conditions for release of 6% of the project cost by MoP (10% of Central share) is to appoint a PMA. Regarding this, arrangements for appointing PMA commonly for IPDS and DDUGJY is initiated.

9. Tripartite agreement : A Tripartite agreement is to be executed between PFC as the Nodal Agency on behalf of Ministry of Power, the Government of Tamilnadu and TANGEDCO for undertaking and agreeing to their stipulated roles/responsibilities as per provisions of the scheme guidelines.

10. After careful consideration, the TANGEDCO have approved to implement the IPDS scheme in TANGEDCO as per the scheme guidelines and also passed the following resolutions :-

I. RESOLVED that TANGEDCO will implement the IPDS scheme in 522 Nos. Statutory towns (STs) as per Census 2011 (Annexure).

II. RESOLVED FURTHER that the CMD/TANGEDCO be authorised to accept and agree to said terms and conditions and execute the relevant agreements, loan documents/undertakings etc. in respect of sanction to be accorded by MoP/PFC for IPDS projects.

III. RESOLVED FURTHER that the CMD/TANGEDCO be authorized to accord administrative approval for the IPDS projects to be sanctioned by the MoP/GoI.

IV. RESOLVED FURTHER that the Chief Engineer/R-APDRP be authorized to accord technical sanction for the IPDS projects to be sanctioned by Mop/GoI.

V. RESOLVED FURTHER that the Director (Finance) be authorized to sign Agreements/Certificates such as Memorandum of Agreement (MoA), Hypothecation Deed Undertakings & other relevant papers as sought for by the PFC and execute relevant documents and other writings for and on behalf of the Board.

VI. RESOLVED FURTHER that the Director (Finance) be authorized to fully comply with the finance and accounts guidelines of the scheme.

PROCEEDINGS:

There are about 205 Nos. of feeders in the Tirunelveli and Udumalpet wind generating area, having mixed loads of WEGs and Distribution loads i.e. WEG loads are connected in the distribution feeders and distribution loads are connected in the wind farm feeders. Whenever the above feeders are subject to load shedding for backing down wind generation due to over loading of feeders and high frequency/grid safety, the consumers connected in the above feeders are affected which leads to unnecessary litigations and complaints by the consumers.

In order to avoid consumer complaints in the event of backing down the wind generation, the CMD/TANGEDCO in the note dated 25.09.2013 has approved that, the WEG loads and distribution loads are to be segregated separately from the above mixed load feeders, to make it as exclusive wind farm feeder and exclusive distribution feeder. As an interim measure, two phase switching arrangements are made in the feeders at Substation.

CMD/TANGEDCO has accorded administrative approval for carrying out the works of segregating the WEG loads from the distribution feeders, by the concerned SE/NCES/Tirunelveli and Udumalpet Circle.

REPORT TO ACCOMPANY THE ESTIMATE

This proposal envisages erection of 400KV Transmission lines for Startup Power as well as for Power Evacuation for the Udangudi Supercritical Thermal Power Project-2X660MW Tirunelveli Operation Circle in Tirunelveli Region at an estimated cost of Rs.30141 Lakhs Gross and Nett.

NEED:

In the 37th Standing Committee Meeting on Power System Planning for Southern Region held on 22.09.2014 at New Delhi, the following Associated Transmission Scheme (ATS) for the Udangudi Supercritical Thermal Power Project -2X660MW has been approved based on the joint Load Flow study by CEA, with PGCIL and TANGEDCO.

ATS for power plants at Udangudi:

Connectivity for Udangudi power project Stage-I (2X660MW)

- i) 400KV DC Quad line to Udangudi Pooling Station.

From Udangudi Pooling station:

- i) 400KV DC Quad line to Kayathar 400KV SS.
- ii) 400KV DC line to the proposed Samugarengapuram 400/230-110 KV SS.
- iii) 400KV Quad DC line to the proposed Ottapidaram 400/230-110KV SS.

2.1 In this regard, during the meeting on provision of Startup power & Power evacuation schemes of the New Thermal Power Projects held on 20.08.2014, the project wing informed that the startup power will be required at 400KV level in the first quarter of 2017 for Udangudi project. As there is no nearby 400KV substation available to take startup power, it has been decided that the startup power can be availed from the proposed Udangudi – Kayathar 400KV DC line.

2.2 Hence, this proposal for the erection of 400KV DC Quad line from Udangudi Pooling Station to Kayathar 400KV substation for startup power requirement of Udangudi Supercritical Thermal Power Project -2X660MW has been evolved. The administrative approval for the other ATS of Udangudi project i.e., 400KV DC lines

from Udangudi Pooling station to the proposed Ottapidaram 400KV SS and to the proposed Samugarengapuram 400KV SS and establishment of Udangudi pooling station will be obtained separately.

3. BRIEF DETAILS OF WORKS INVOLVED:

1. Erection of 400 KV Quad DC line with OPGW cable from Udangudi Pooling Station to Kayathar 400KV Substation.
2. 2 numbers of 400KV Bay Extension at Kayathar 400/230-110KV SS.

4. LAND AVAILABILITY :

Land available for Bay extension at Kayathar 400/230-110KV substation.

5. ESTIMATED COST:

The cost of the estimate works out to Rs.30141 Lakhs (Gross and Nett) (Detailed estimate is annexed to the Board note). The estimate is based on the details furnished by the Transmission wing.

In the Erection estimate of 400 KV DC line on DC tower with Quad Moose conductor, the rates adopted for the foundation cost of four types of towers are based on the PWD Schedule of rates for the year 2014-2015 as per the soil condition and field requirement as stated by CE/Civil/Transmission and SE/GCC/Madurai. The rates for all other items are based on the TANTRANSCO Cost data for the year 2014-2015 and the quantities are based on the field requirement.

In the 400 KV Bay extension at Kayathar 400 KV SS estimate, the quantities arrived for the Civil items (Annexure-3) are based on the field condition and the rates adopted for the Civil items are as per PWD Schedule of rates for the year 2014-2015, local market rates & rates as per Highways Department data, as stated by CE/Civil Transmission and EE/TLC/Tirunelveli and the rates adopted for the electrical items are based on the TANTRANSCO Cost data for the year 2014-2015. The quantity of different type of cables, insulators and clamps adopted in the estimate is as per site requirements as furnished by EE/SSE/Tirunelveli.

Necessary provision is made in the estimate for Fibre Optic communication, SAS and Integration of 400 KV Relay panels with SAS. OPGW cable has been included as OFC ground wire with accessories in the erection cost of 400 KV DC line.

AMENDMENT

In the said Code, for regulation 8, the following shall be substituted, namely:-
8 Distribution System Interface with Generators:-

The generators may be permitted to evacuate the power by interfacing with the distribution system They shall comply with the norms specified by the Commission and the Authority for capacity connectivity, safety etc.

Provided that such generators, including those with captive loads within the premises, barring the generators injecting to the grid through net metering system, shall be connected to the substation through a separate feeder and no other distribution load shall be connected to this feeder”.
