vi) Remuneration for setting of question paper:-

The amount of remuneration as ordered in (Routine) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No.16 (TechI.Branch) dated 28.02.2014 will be followed for the Departmental Tests to be held in November, 2017, i.e. Rs.2,000/- for framing of question papers including typing, printing, postage and other charges and the payment will be credited to the individuals' bank account through NEFT transfer.

vii) Setting up of Question Paper for 'Departmental Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers:-

The Question Paper for the Departmental Accounts Test for Subordinate Officer for upcoming November, 2017 will be set by the Chief Internal Audit Officer.

Recruitment - Policy in the matter of considering persons undergone Apprentice Training in the TNEB/TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO while appointment through Direct Recruitment under section 22 (1) of the Apprentice Act, 1961 - Orders - Issued.

PROCEEDINGS:

The Hon'ble High Court has ordered on 16.08.2017 in Writ Appeal Nos. 267, 235 and 744 of 2017 filed by the apprenticeship candidates and directed that an explicit Policy be framed under section 22 (1) of the Apprentices Act, 1961 on or before 04.09.2017 and the same has to be filed before the Hon'ble High Court on or before 08.09.2017.

Section 22 (1) of the said Act obligates that "Every employer shall formulate its own policy for recruiting any apprentice who has completed the period of apprenticeship training in his establishment"

2) In this connection, the TANGEDCO, the Employer has already formulated a policy in consultation with the Learned Advocate General as follows:-

"The selection of all categories shall be made based on the merit of the marks and as per Communal Roaster. If other things being equal, preference should be given to the apprentices candidates who have completed Apprenticeship in Erstwhile TNEB, TANGEDCO/ TANTRANSCO".

(As per (Per) FB TANGEDCO Proceedings No.10, (Adm. Br.) dated 10.12.2015.

3) Further;

- (i) In terms of the orders of the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court/ Madras in W.A.No.1027 of 2013 dated 09.06.2014, the Government of Tamil Nadu has issued G.O. (Ms) No.44, Labour and Employment (T2) dated 11.03.2015 as per which the appointment in public service should be made by an open advertisement so as to enable all eligible persons to compete on merit.
- (ii) **Regulation 89 (d) (i) of the TNEB Service Regulations, interalia, Provides that selection shall be made by the appointing authority on the results of the written examination OR interview OR based on the performance in the qualifying examination prescribed for the respective post OR by awarding marks for the performance in the qualifying examination OR by combining any of the method as considered suitable.**
- (iii) In the previous years, except during the years 2001 and 2002, the selections were made based on the qualifying examination marks and viva-voce and as such the selections were made from among the candidates sponsored by the employment exchange and Apprentice Trainees as per the practice in vogue.
- (iv) While so, it was decided to recruit personnel to various posts through direct recruitment and it was also considered that such recruitment may be through competitive written exam and viva-voce.
- (v) At that time, a question arose as to whether the apprentices are required to undergo written test or otherwise. Hence, the opinion of the Learned Advocate General was sought for and the **Learned Advocate General in his opinion, dated 17.11.2015, after referring to Regulation 89 of the TNEB Service Regulations, Government Orders, etc., has opined that the apprentice candidates must also appear in the competitive examination as per G.O.Ms.No.44, dated 11.03.2015.**
- (iv) Thereafter, a committee was constituted in (Per) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No.64, (Adm.Branch) dated 30.03.2015 comprising Director (Distn.), Secretary and the CE/Personnel and the committee considered, among other things, the statutory provisions and the mode adopted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission for recruitment for Assistant

Engineer/Civil in Highways Department of the Government of Tamil Nadu including the provision for apprentice candidates in the TNPSC Notification, i.e., "Provided that other things being equal, preference shall be given to those who have undergone one year Apprenticeship Training under the Government of India Scheme or the State Government Apprenticeship Scheme." and recommended that the posts by direct recruitment may be filled up by advertisement and also from the candidates sponsored by the Employment Exchange; that the marks obtained in the competitive written examination to be worked out for 85% and for viva-voce interview -15%; and that the selection may be on merits of above marks and communal roaster and, other things being equal, preference should be given to the apprentice candidates who have completed apprenticeship in TNEB, TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO.

- (vii) In furtherance of the same, with the approval of the Board, (Per) FB TANGEDCO Proceedings No.10, (Adm. Branch) dated 10.12.2015 was issued to recruit personnel for various posts, wherein it was decided that the selection, inter-alia, will be based on marks in the written examination (85%) and viva-voce (15%).
- (viii) Accordingly, recruitment Notifications were issued to fill up various posts including the posts of Assistant Engineer, Technical Assistant and Field Assistant by direct recruitment.
- (ix) While so, writ petitions came to be filed in WP No.1048 of 2016 and etc. batch challenging the recruitment notifications, among other things, on the grounds that the apprentices are not required to undergo written examination, the notifications were not in accordance with section 22 (1) of the Apprentices Act, 1961, etc, by relying on the Government Orders and the decisions of the various Courts.
- (x) Those writ petitions were contested, among other things, on the following grounds:
 - a) The notifications were in accordance with the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in U.P. State Road Transport Corporation Vs U.P. Parivahan Nigam Shishukha dated 12 January, 1995 reported in (1995) 2 SCC 1 and clarified in U.P. Rajya Vidyut Parishad Apprentice Welfare Association and Anr.-vs-State of Uttar Pradesh and others in SLP (C) No.7406 of 2000 dated 08.05.2000 reported in 2000 LLR 869 (SC) = 2000 (3) SCR 1201.
 - b) Apprentice Act applies to every establishment covered under the Act, private as well as public departments including public sector undertakings/statutory Boards. In case of a private establishment, it can formulate a policy at its sweet will, which cannot be normally interfered with. Whereas, for entry into a public establishment, the recruitment policy should not be violative of any Constitutional rights including Article 16 of the Constitution of India. Hence, in this context, insofar as every public establishment is concerned, the expression "shall" in section 22 (1) has to be read as "may or can".
 - c) The policy TANGEDCO, as could be seen from Per (FB) TANGEDCO B.P. No.10, (Adm. Branch) dated 28.12.2015, is to recruit personnel

by giving the apprentices the right guaranteed in (1995) 2 SCC 1 as clarified in 2000 (3) SCR 1201 and not anything more and that the said decision was taken by the Board of TANGEDCO.

- d) The G.O.Ms.No.141, Labour and Employment (R2) Dept., dated 10.11.1998 was considered by the Full Board of the TNEB and a Policy decision was taken in (Per) BP (FB) No.20 (AB) Dated 06.07.1999 that the status quo viz., giving preference of Tamil Nadu Electricity Apprentices during recruitment if other things being equal over open market candidates be maintained.
- e) In Public Service Commission, Uttaranchal - vs- Jagdish Chandra Singh Bora & Anr. Etc. (PSUC Case) in C.A.No.3034 of 2007 dated 03.03.2014 reported in (2014) 8 SCC 644, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has rejected the claim to give preference to apprentices by giving bonus 10 marks for the selection through Public Service Commission; that it was held therein that when the Service Rules provides for written exam including to apprentices, it cannot be dispensed with; that it was clarified that the phrase "Other things being equal, a trained apprentice should be given preference over direct recruits." occurred in (1995) 2SCC 1 as "The only natural meaning of the aforesaid phrase 'other things being equal' is that all the candidates must have been subjected to the same selection process, i.e., same written test and interview."; that in UPSTRC's case was to give preference to the trained apprentices over direct recruits but no direction is given in the judgment as to how the preference is to be given and it was left entirely to the discretion of the Government to make the necessary provision in the statutory rules; that no vested right had accrued to the trained apprentices under the Rules; that there is no promise held out of the candidates of definite employment; that, otherwise, it would lead to a clear infraction of Article 14 of the Constitution of India; and that the settled position in law is that the executive orders/instructions can only supplement the rules framed under the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and that clarification would not have the effect of superseding, amending or altering the Rules.
- f) The policy of the TANGEDCO is that no percentage in appointment could be considered for apprentices other than the one guaranteed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the said decisions. If considered, it would be circumventing the constitutional rights of open candidates guaranteed under Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India.
- g) Sec.22 (1) has to be read with the Fundamental Rights guaranteed in the Constitution of India. Insofar as the contention that Railways have allegedly framed policy of reservation-20%, the same appears to be insofar as Class IV post of Kalasi, it was stated by the TANGEDCO that the right of apprentice is restricted to what was allowed in 1995 (2) SCC 1 and nothing more. Further, the recruitment in TANGEDCO includes AE-degree holder (Class II service), TA-Diploma Holder (Class III service) and Field Assistant- ITI Holder (Class IV service). As stated already, the consistent past and present policy of TANGEDCO is to ensure that the preference as laid down in (1995) 2 SCC 1 & 2000 (3) SCR 1201 alone to be extended to the apprentices and not to extend any more or violate the Constitutional rights of anybody.

- h) The training imparted to Apprentices is out of social obligation as per the statutory mandate under the Apprentices Act, 1961 for the purpose of equipping them to employability and the expenditure incurred is a social obligation alone.
- i) The Apprentice Trainees cannot thrust upon anything, otherwise, it will be an affront to the powers of the TANGEDCO, the employer to choose the mode and manner of recruitment as per the statutory provisions.
- j) In the course of the said writ petitions, pursuant to the order of the Hon'ble Court in WMP No.4718 of 2016 in WP No.5411 of 2016, the matter relating to a policy decision on this matter was placed before the Committee constituted for Direct Recruitment and based on the recommendations of the Committee it was decided to adopt the policy already taken as per the orders issued in para 3 (iii) in (Per) (FB) TANGEDCO Proceedings No.10, (Adm. Branch) dated 10.12.2015 and that the policy in respect of Apprentices will be "If other things being equal, preference should be given to the apprentices candidates who have completed Apprenticeship in TNEB/TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO". and accordingly orders were issued in (Per) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No.93 (Adm.Branch) dated 27.08.2016.
- (xi) The Hon'ble High Court, by accepting the contentions of the TANGEDCO, was pleased to dismiss the writ petitions in WP Nos.5411 of 2016 and etc. batch by a common order, dated 25.01.2017.
- (xii) Thereagainst, Writ Appeal Nos. 267,235 and 744 of 2017 have been filed and the Hon'ble First Division Bench of the Hon'ble Court refused to grant any interim orders and thereby allowed the TANGEDCO to proceed with the recruitment process.
- (xiii) Pursuant to the same, the recruitment process for the Assistant Engineers continued, selection orders issued and the recruitment process completed.
- (xiv) The Writ Appeals came up for final hearing and on 16.08.2017 and the Division Bench has directed to the effect that an exclusive Policy be framed under section 22 (1) of the Apprentices Act, 1961 through the learned Additional Advocate General - VII, who has been entering appearance in the said cases, is pleased to advise that **a Policy be placed before the Board of TANGEDCO inasmuch as Section 22 (1) of the said Act obligates that "Every employer shall formulate its own policy for recruiting any apprentice who has completed the period of apprenticeship training in his establishment"**.

4) The above position including the legal position and the procedure hither to followed after obtaining the opinion of the Learned Advocate General in furtherance of the orders of the Board last issued in (Per) FB TANGEDCO Proceedings No.10, (Adm. Branch) dated 10.12.2015 relating to the issue on hand, it is considered appropriate that the Apprentice Trained in the TNEB/TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO will have to appear in the examination conducted by TNEB.

5) Hence, the matter has been placed before the Board of TANGEDCO and Board after careful consideration has decided that the Apprentice Trained in the TNEB/TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO will have to appear in the examination conducted by TNEB and also decided the following exclusive policy with regard

to apprentice is framed under the section 22 (1) of the Apprentice Act 1961 and direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras.

- (1) All apprentices who have undergone training in the Board have to go through the process of selection provided in the Regulations. Pursuant to G.O.Ms.No.44, dated 11.03.2015, the Board has decided to conduct written examination for all categories of candidates. Therefore, the apprentice candidates must also appear in the competitive written examination.**
- (2) Other things being equal, apprentice will be given preference in appointment as per the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in U.P. State Road Transport Corporation Vs U.P. Parivahan Nigam Shishukha (1995) 2 SCC 1 and clarified in U.P. Rajya Vidyut Parishad Apprentice Welfare Association and Anr. -vs- State of Uttar Pradesh and others 2000 LLR 869 (SC) = 2000 (3) SCR 1201, as has been followed hitherto followed.**
- (3) Age relaxation will be allowed to the extent of the actual period of apprentice training undergone in the TNEB/TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO.**

Kindly refer the Circulars (1) & (2) cited above, wherein it was clarified that

Income Tax Deducted at Source need not be deducted on Service Tax component. Since, Service Tax act is repealed and GST Act is rolled out from 01.07.2017, CBDT has issued Circular vide reference (4) stating that TDS need not be deducted on the component of 'Goods and Services Tax (GST) on services'. Accordingly, the following clarifications are issued.

Wherever in terms of the agreement/contract between the payer and the payee, the component of 'GST on services' comprised in the amount payable to a resident is indicated separately, tax shall be deducted at source under Chapter XVII-B of the Act on the amount paid/payable **without including such 'GST on services' component.** GST for these purposes shall include Integrated Goods and Service Tax (IGST), Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST), State Goods and Services Tax (SGST) and Union Territory Goods and Services Tax (UTGST).

The above circular relates to payment made to Resident under all sections covered under chapter XVII-B of the Income Tax Act 1961 such as 194C (1), 194C(2), 194D, 194G, 194H, 194I, 194IA, 194J, (1) (ba) etc.

Following points/conditions should be noted for excluding the 'Goods and Services Tax on services' component from TDS applicability;

1. The payment should be made to Resident. In case, payment is made to non residents, TDS is to be deducted including GST amount.

2. GST amount payable shall be indicated separately in terms of Agreement/Contract between payer and payee.

In case of **existing agreements or contracts entered prior to 01.07.2017** wherein Service Tax has been indicated separately, such reference shall be treated as 'GST on services' with respect to the period from 01.07.2017 onward till the expiry of such agreement or contract. Thus, the Bills received against such agreements with GST component will also be eligible to get exemption from TDS.

3. In case of more than one block in a premise, only one service shall be given for each block for common supply. If more than one common services are available in a block, the additional services should be merged to one service.

4. Any other supply effected in a multi tenements/residential complexes other than common supply as above but used for common purpose like gymnasium, community hall, amphi theatres, etc., inside the multi-tenement/residential complex shall not be considered as domestic/residential usage, and shall be classified under the appropriate tariff category, (i.e.) LT V for the entire multi tenements/residential complexes as one single service. The SEs and EEs shall to instruct AEEs/AEs for proper implementation of this provision.

2.5) The tariff to Prisons and Blood Banks shall be changed from LT Tariff V to LT Tariff II B (1) with effect from 11.08.2017.

3.0) The tariff schedule issued under TP No.1 of 2017 dt.11.08.2017 shall be read with the General Terms and Conditions of Supply Code and Distribution code specified by the Commission. Effecting change in tariff category for a consumer in accordance with this order shall be the responsibility of SEs/EDC. This proposal envisages erection of 765 KV DC line on DC tower with Hexa Zebra conductor for a route length of 271 Kms. from North Chennai 765kV GIS Pooling Station to Ariyalur 765 KV SS in Chennai Operation Circle/North, at an estimated cost of Rs. 158305.00 lakhs (Gross and Nett) by partially superseding the already sanctioned 765 KV DC line for length of 190 Kms, which has been included in the administrative approval accorded for the establishment of North Chennai 765/400 KV GIS Pooling Station vide (Per). FB TANTRANSCO Proceedings No.64, dated 25.07.2015.

NEED:

2.1 Administrative approval for the establishment of North Chennai 765/400 KV GIS Pooling Station at Ennore for evacuating power from various Thermal Power Projects in North Chennai & Ennore area has already been accorded vide (Per).FB. TANTRANSCO Proceedings No.64, dated 25.07.2015.

2.2 In the above administrative approval, provision has been made for the erection of 765 KV DC line on DC tower with Hexa Zebra conductor from North Chennai Pooling station to Ariyalur 765 KV SS for route length of 190kMs.

2.3 But while carrying out route survey for preparation of detailed estimate to obtain technical sanction and tendering, it has been found that the actual route length for erection of 765 KV DC line from North Chennai Pooling station to Ariyalur 765 KV SS is found to be 270.735 Kms. Further, North Chennai Pooling station area is found to be surrounded by buildings, factories and vacant approved plots. As such due to non availability of way leave, the line has to be erected along water ways and river banks necessitating pile foundation.

2.4 Since, the actual route length of sanctioned 765 KV DC line from North Chennai Pooling station to Ariyalur 765 KV SS as per route survey is found to be 270.735 Kms instead of 190 Kms, this proposal has been evolved to get approval for deviation in the quantity.

REPORT TO ACCOMPANY THE ESTIMATE

1.0. This proposal envisages the establishment of 400/230-110 kV AIS SS at Edayarpalayam with 3x315 MVA, 400/230 kV ICTs, 3x200 MVA, 400/110 kV ICTs, 2x125MVA bus reactors etc., in Coimbatore Operation Circle of Coimbatore Region at an estimated cost of Rs. 43,302 lakhs (Gross) and Rs. 42,443 lakhs (Nett) by superseding the approval already accorded vide (Per). FB TANTRANSCO Proceedings No. 16, dated: 13.01.2014. The estimate includes the DCW portion towards the erection of 4 Nos. 400 kV bays which works out to Rs. 2516.00 lakhs (Gross & Nett) to be borne by M/s. PGCIL.

2.0. Need:

2.1 In the Coimbatore region, the daily sustained peak load is about 1700 MW to 1800MW and the peak so far reached is 2062MW on 16.06.2017. Now the Coimbatore region is fed by Myvady, Arasur and Karamadai 400 kV substations. To meet the future load growth, Edayarpalayam 400kV SS has been approved in the 36th Standing Committee meeting on Power System Planning of Southern Region, while finalizing the HVDC transmission system from Chattisgarh to pugalur with the following 400kV connectivity.

- i. Edayarpalayam – Myvady 400kV DC quad line.
- ii. Pugalur HVDC station – Edayarpalayam 400kV DC quad line.

2.2 Administrative approval for the establishment of 400/230-110 kV GIS SS at Edayarpalayam has been accorded vide (Per). FB. TANTRANSCO Proceedings No.16, dt: 13.01.2014 at an estimated cost of Rs. 77,282.44 lakhs Gross and Rs. 76,416.18 lakhs Nett. As PGCIL has stated that there is no space available for establishment of 400 kV Bays at Myvady PGCIL 400kV SS, when Thappagundu – Anikadavu 400kv line was proposed to be made LILO at Myvady 400kV SS, following 400kV connectivity has been sanctioned in the above B.P, with pending CEA approval.

400kV connectivity:

- LILO of Udumalpet (Myvady) – Anaikadavu 400 kV SC line.
- 400 kV SC line from proposed Anaikadavu 400kV SS.

NEED FOR REVISED ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL:

2.3 Earlier, poromboke land to an extent of 20 acres at Pachapalayam Village of Coimbatore District has been identified for the establishment of 400/230-110 kV

SS at Edayarpalayam. Now additional poromboke land to an extent of 7.5 Acres at Pachapalayam village of Coimbatore District has been acquired and SE/GCC/Coimbatore has stated that the total land of 27.5 acres is sufficient for the establishment of 400/230-110 KV AIS SS at Edayarpalayam. Hence, it has been decided to establish AIS instead of GIS due to cost effectiveness.

2.4 The savings due to the establishment of AIS Sub Station instead of GIS SS is detailed below:

2.5 Further, in the 38th Standing Committee meeting held on 07.03.2015, PGCIL has stated that the Edayarpalayam 400/230-110kV substation would be taken up by PGCIL itself, as the delay in the establishment of Edayarpalayam 400/230-110kV SS would affect the dispersal of power from Pugalur HVDC and the power may be bottled up. In the same meeting, TANGEDCO has stated that the land for the establishment of Edayarpalayam 400/230-110 kV SS has been purchased and the tendering work is under progress and the establishment of Edayarpalayam 400/230-110kV substation will be under the scope of TANTRANSCO. After deliberation, the following was decided in the 38th Standing Committee meeting.

In the scope of TANTRANSCO :

Establishment of Edayarpalayam 400/230-110kV substation with 2x500 MVA, 400/230 kV ICTs, 3x200 MVA, 400/110kV ICTs and 400 kV, 2x125 MVar bus reactors.

In the scope of PGCIL as ISTS :

- i. Edayarpalayam – Myvady 400kV DC quad line.
- ii. Pugalur HVDC station – Edayarpalayam, 400kV DC quad line with 63 MVar switchable line reactor at Edayarpalayam end.

Further, CEA has suggested that TANTRANSCO will commission Edayarpalayam 400/230-110kV substation in the time frame matching with the requirement of Raigarh – Pugalur HVDC system.

2.6. TANTRANSCO has suggested to PGCIL, to review the necessity of the line reactor at Edayarpalayam 400/kV SS, in the Pugalur HVDC station – Edayarpalayam 400kV DC quad line, as the line length is less. Based on PGCIL's request, CEA has issued a corrigendum to the Minutes of the Joint meeting on power system planning in SR and WR, in which the line reactors at Edayarpalayam end in Pugalur HVDC to Edayarpalayam 400 kV DC line has been deleted from HVDC scheme.

2.7. It is proposed to sanction 3x315 MVA, 400/230 kV ICTs instead of 2x500 MVA, 400/230 kV ICTs as three numbers of ICTS will give more operational flexibility, even though 2x500 MVA, 400/230 kV ICTs are approved in the standing committee meeting. It is suggested that initially 2x315 MVA, 400/230 kV ICTs shall be taken up for erection and the 3rd ICT shall be taken up in future.

2.8. Hence due to the modification of GIS to AIS and the modification in the 400kV connectivity, revised administrative approval is accorded for the establishment of Edayarpalayam 400/230-110 kV AIS substation.

The revised 400kV, 230 kV and 110 kV connectivity are as follows:

I. 400kV connectivity

1. Under PGCIL's scope :

- 400kV DC quad line from PGCIL Myvadi 400kV SS.
- 400kV DC quad line from Pugalur HVDC station.

2. Under TANTRANSCO's scope :

- LILO of Myvady – Anaikadavu 400kV SC line.
- 400 kV DC line from sanctioned Coimbatore 765/400kV SS. (Cost of 400kV DC line and 400kV Bay extension at Edayarpalayam 400kV SS has already been included in the B.P. for the establishment of Coimbatore 765/400 kV SS)

II. 230kV connectivity (in TANTRANSCO scope):

- LILO of 230 kV Othkalmandapam – Palladam feeder at the proposed Edayarpalayam 400 kV SS for a distance of 10 Kms.
- LILO of 230 kV Othkalmandapam – Ponnapuram feeder at the proposed Edayarpalayam 400 kV SS for a distance of 25 kms, which is proposed to be bypassed at O.K.Mandapam 230 kV SS and linked to the Tudiyalur – O.K.Mandapam feeder thereby forming 230 kV Edayarpalayam – Tudiyalur feeder and 230 kV Edayarpalayam – Ponnapuram feeder.

III. 110kV connectivity (in TANTRANSCO scope):

- LILO of existing Edayarpalayam – L&T EHT – O.K.Mandapam 110kV feeder. (In between Edayarpalayam – L&T EHT Take off point).
- LILO of Podanur – Irugur 110kV feeder.
- Delinking of existing 110kV Edayarpalayam takeoff in the existing Peedampalli- Sultanpettai feeder and to be made LILO at the new Edayarpalayam SS and converting the SC line into DC line, from New Edayarpalayam thereby forming Edayarpalayam - Sultanpettai – Poolavadi feeder and Edayarpalayam – Karadibavi – Kethanur 110kV feeders.

➤ Delinking the existing 110kV Edayarpalayam takeoff in the existing Peedampalli – Sultanpettai feeder and to be made LILO at the new Edayarpalayam SS and converting the SC line into DC line, from New Edayarpalayam thereby forming Edayarpalayam – Sultanpettai – Poolavadi feeder and Edayarpalayam – Karadibavi – Kethanur 110kV feeders.

➤ Erection of 110kV SC line on DC tower with panther conductor from proposed 400/230-110KV Edayarpalayam SS to existing 110kV Edayarpalayam SS for a distance of 1 km.

➤ Dismantling of 110kV SC line with Panther conductor between existing Edayarpalayam 110 kV SS to tapping point in 110 kV Sultanpet – Kethanur line for a distance of 22.5 km.

➤ Dismantling of 110kV DC line with Panther conductor between existing Edayarpalayam 110 kV SS to loc.53 (Four Junction) in 110 kV Peedamballi line for a distance of 7 km.

5.0 ESTIMATED COST:

5.1 The cost of the revised estimate works out to Rs. 40,786 lakhs (Rupees Forty thousand seven hundred and eighty six lakhs only) (Gross) and Rs. 39,927 lakhs (Rupees Thirty nine thousand nine hundred and twenty seven lakhs only) (Nett) in the scope of TANTRANSCO. The DCW portion towards the erection of 4 Nos. 400 kV bays works out to Rs. 2,516 lakhs (Rupees Two thousand five hundred and sixteen lakhs only (Gross & Nett)) which is to be borne by M/s. PGCIL. The Total estimate amount including DCW portion works out to Rs. 43.302 lakhs (Rupees Forty three thousand three hundred and two lakhs) (Gross) and Rs. 42,443 lakhs (Rupees Forty two thousand four hundred and forty three lakhs) (Nett).

i. This estimate has been prepared based on the TANTRANSCO cost data for the year 2017-2018.

ii. Provision for cement mortar type kiosk building with its auxiliary items such as air conditioning units, Fire alarm etc., for the 400 kV, 230 kV and 110 kV bays has been made in the estimate.
