PROCEEDINGS:

As per TNERC's DSM Regulations-2019, the TANTRANSCO proposed for constitution of State Power Committee (SPC), formation of Secretariat of SPC and State Transmission utility for implementation of DSM Mechanism for wind, solar, Co-Gen., Bio-Mass, Hydro and Thermal Generators, TANGEDCO owned and all Private Generators and Distribution Licensees. As per the provision in the Electricity Act 2003, the transmission system study and planning and system improvements have to be carried out by the State Transmission Utility (STU). Tamil Nadu State Power Committee with representations from SLDC, TANGEDCO, TANTRANSCO and Private Generators and a Secretariat of SPC is constituted to assist the SPC and to undertake the duties and responsibilities engaged in the Regulations.

2. At present, the activities of TANTRANSCO are being looked after by the Office of the Superintending Engineer/System Studies, Office of the Superintending Engineer/Planning under the control of TANGEDCO and the activities of STU (TANTRANSCO) are being looked after by the SLDC with Open Access Division and Grid Connectivity Division under the control of the Superintending Engineer/Commercial Operation.

3. To facilitate the formation of the Secretariat of SPC and State Transmission Utility (STU) and SLDC/Chennai, the Chief Engineer/Grid Operation has proposed for certain redeployment and re-designation of posts. The Chairman/TANTRANSCO has approved the proposal.

4. Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that the following posts last continued in the references first to fourth read above, shall be redeployed from the Offices of the Superintending Engineer/Planning, Superintending Engineer/ System Studies, Superintending Engineer/System Operation and Superintending Engineer/P&C for the formation of the Secretariat of SPC, State Transmission Utility (STU) and Chennai Sub-Load Despatch Centre/Chennai :-

TANGEDCO – Study of Work Allocation and Staff Pattern in five Thermal Power Stations – Awarding of Technical Consultancy Work to National Productivity Council – Orders – Issued.

PROCEEDINGS:

A Proposal to entrust the study on Work-Allocation and Staff Pattern on Scientific methods in the five Thermal Power Stations (Viz. North Chennai Thermal Power Station-I & II, Mettur Thermal Power Station-I & II, Tuticorin Thermal Power Station) to an external Consultant like National Productivity Council, Chennai was mooted.

2. The proposal of National Productivity Council has been placed before the Board of TANGEDCO for constitution of committee to award the contract for the consultancy on nomination basis as per the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act. The Board has approved the proposal for constitution of committee with the following members and directed to submit their recommendations:-

- i) The Principal Secretary to Government Energy Department
- ii) The Principal Secretary to Government Finance Department
- iii) The Chairman cum Managing Director/TANGEDCO
- iv) The Director/Generation/TANGEDCO
- v) The Professor from the Anna University.

The recommendation of the committee was placed before the Board of TANGEDCO and it has been examined in detail.

3. After careful examination, the TANGEDCO hereby ordered to award the Technical Consultancy Work to the National productivity Council for conducting a study of Work-Allocation and Staff Pattern and possible system improvement to increase the productivity in the five Thermal Power Stations of the TANGEDCO (viz. North Chennai Thermal Power Station-I & II, Mettur Thermal Power Station-I & II, Tuticorin Thermal Power Station). The National Productivity Council shall be directed to conduct the above study and submit a report within five months of the date of taking up the study.

4. The TANGEDCO also accords sanction for an amount of Rs.2,87,60,000/- towards expenditure in regard to Professional fee, Boarding and Travel Expenses payable to National Productivity Council. The mode of payment to the National Productivity Council will be as follows:-

- (a) The first instalment of (50% of Rs.2,87,60,000/-) Rs.1,43,80,000/- (Rupees One Crore Forty Three Lakhs and Eighty Thousand only) shall be paid on completion of field study.
- (b) The second instalment of (30% of Rs.2,87,60,000/-) Rs.86,28,000/- (Rupees Eight Six Lakhs and Twenty Eight Thousand only) shall be paid on submitting the draft report.
- (c) The third instalment of (20% of Rs.2,87,60,000/-) Rs.57,52,000/- (Rupees Fifty Seven Lakhs and Fifty Two thousand only) shall be paid on submission of final report.

5. The expenditure shall be debitable to "TANGEDCO – Account Code:76-000 "Administration and General Expenses" and Account Code:76-125 "Other Professional Charges".

6. The Chief Financial Controller/General/TANGEDCO will arrange for payment of the amount sanctioned in para 4 above.
