PROCEEDINGS:

The Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O.Ms.No.183, Finance [PGC] Department, Dated 03.08.2021, has ordered to maintain the rate of interest at **7.1%** (Seven point one percent) for the period from 01.07.2021 to 30.09.2021 on the accumulations at the credit of the subscribers to Contributory Pension Scheme.

2. It has been decided to adopt the orders of the Government to the employees in TNEB Limited, Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited and Tamil Nadu Transmission Corporation Limited (formerly Tamil Nadu Electricity Board).

3. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 79 (c) of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1948 (Central Act 54 of 1948), read with section 185 of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 2003 and G.O.Ms.No.100, Energy (B2) Department Dated 19.10.2010, it is hereby ordered that the rate of interest on the Employees Contribution and Employers Matching Contribution under the CPS shall be maintained at 7.1% (Seven point one percent) for the period from 01.07.2021 to 30.09.2021.

MATERNITY LEAVE – Enhancement of maternity Leave from 9 months (270 days) to 12 months (365 days) – Orders issued by the Government – Adoption in TANGEDCO - Orders – Issued.

PROCEEDINGS:

In the proceedings first read above, orders have been issued for enhancing the Maternity Leave admissible to the married women employees of TANGEDCO from 180

days to 270 days which may be lipospread over from the pre-confinement rest to post-confinement recuperation at the option of the women employees, by adopting the orders issued by the Government in G.O.(Ms) No.105 Personnel and Administrative Reforms (FR.III) Department, Dated 07.11.2016.

2. In the Proceedings second read above, necessary amendments to Regulation 24 of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Leave Regulations have been issued to this effect.

3. In the Government Order 3rd read above, the Government have issued orders enhancing the period of Maternity Leave admissible to married women Government Servants with less than two surviving children, from 9 months (270 days) to 12 Moths (365 days), with effect from 01.07.2021 with full pay, which may be spread over from the pre-confinement rest to post-confinement recuperation at the option of the married women Government Servant. It has also been ordered therein that the women Government Servants who proceeded on maternity Leave prior to 1st July, 2021 and continued to be on that leave on or after that date, are also eligible for Maternity Leave for a period not exceeding 365 days in total.

4. The extension of the said benefit to the married women employees of TANGEDCO has been examined in detail and it has been decided to adopt the said Government Order in toto in TANGEDCO.

Accordingly, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- i)** the Maternity Leave admissible to married women employees of TANGEDCO with less than two surviving children, which is 9 months (270 days) at present, be enhanced to 12 months (356 days) with effect from 01.07.2021, with full pay, which may be spread over from the pre-confinement rest to post-confinement recuperation at the option of the married women employees of TANGEDCO;
- ii)** the women employees of TANGEDCO who proceeded on Maternity Leave, prior to 1st July 2021 and continued to be on that leave on or after that date shall also be eligible for Maternity Leave for a period not exceeding 365 days in total.

5. Necessary amendments to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Leave Regulations will be issued separately.

PROCEEDINGS:

Prior to 2013, the Departmental Tests for the employees of TANGEDCO had been conducted by the TNPSC. In the Proceedings read above, orders have been issued that the Departmental Tests, be conducted in the months of May and November every year internally by TANGEDCO for the employees of TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO instead of TNPSC. Accordingly, the examinations are being conducted by TANGEDCO from November 2013 onwards. However, the examinations which were proposed to be held in May 2021, could not be conducted due to Covid-19. The proposal for conductance of Departmental Tests through **On-line Mode** to be conducted in November 2021 has been examined in detail and it has been decided to accept the same.

2. Accordingly, the following orders are issued for conductance of Departmental Tests through **On-line Mode** during November 2021:

(i) Eligibility Criteria for writing the Departmental Tests through Online Mode:

The employees/officials who are required to pass the Tests, as specified in regulations 94 and 96 of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Service Regulations alone, are eligible to apply for writing the Departmental Tests conducted by TANGEDCO.

(ii) On-line Mode Departmental Tests for November 2021 will be conducted in two sessions on 27.11.2021 (Saturday) and the Schedule for the said tests is as follows:-

(iv) Venue of Tests:

(a) On-line Mode Exam from residence: To avoid travelling during pandemic situation, the Departmental Tests for November 2021 will be conducted through On-line Mode. The candidates already applied for May 2021 exam and the new applicants for November 2021 exams, who possess the laptops, note pads, I-Pads, Tablets and Personal Computer and willing to write the Departmental Tests for November 2021 through **On-line Mode** from their residence, may submit their willingness in the examination portal before 31.10.2021. The candidates shall ensure that their electronic gadgets from which they are appearing for the exams shall be in good condition with video and audio facility and also to ensure for continuous/uninterrupted internet connection. The TANGEDCO will in no way be responsible for any of the system or internet defects which may arise during the examination.

(b) On-line Mode Exam from Designated Centres: The Departmental Tests for November – 2021 will also be conducted through **On-line Mode** in the following centres in co-ordination with the external agency Centre for Development of Advance Computing (C-DAC) & HRD Training centre in-charge (Senior Managers). The number of centres may increase/decrease depending upon the number of the candidates who submit their willingness to write their exams either in their residence or in the centres allotted for the exams:

(vi) Exam Fees:

The fees for the Departmental Tests to be held in November 2021 will be Rs.500/-. The candidates are instructed to pay the fees through online (net banking & Debit

Card/Credit Card) only along with the applicable GST (18%) and Bank service charges. The candidates who have already paid the said amount for appearing during May 2021 exam which was postponed due to Covid-19 pandemic may appear for November 2021 exam.

- (vii) **Payment Status:**
The I.T. Wing and Accounts Wing are instructed to initiate a provision for viewing the real-time payment status of the paid candidates.
- (viii) **Test Pattern & Question Paper pattern:**
The tests will be conducted through On-line Mode, which will comprise of 100 objective type questions.
- (ix) **Setting up of Question Paper for Departmental Accounts Test:**
- (1) **English to Tamil Translation:**
The question paper setters should do Tamil translation for all the questions already set by them in English and hand over to GM/HRD.
- (2) **Change in the Syllabus:**
There is no change in the syllabus for November 2021 Departmental Tests.
- (x) **Remuneration for setting of question paper:**
An amount of Rs.10/- each for framing of objective type questions both in English and Tamil shall be paid to the setters, and the payment will be credited to the individuals bank account through NEFT transfer.
- (xi) **Evaluation:**
Centre arrangement exam conduction and evaluation shall be carried out by the Centre for Development of Advance Computing (C-DAC).
- (xii) **Application Rejection Clause:**
The rejection clause is followed as already in vogue. The applications will be summarily rejected for the following reasons:-
- (a) If the uploaded scanned photo and sign are not clearly visible.
- (b) If valid Departmental ID Card (Permanent/Temporary) is not uploaded and the Xerox copy of the ID Card is uploaded.
- (c) Mismatch of application details with Departmental Identity Card (viz. Name, Designation, Office, Photo, Signature, etc.,)
- (d) If the Signature of the Candidate and the Signature/Seal of the Competent Authority are missing in the Identity Card.
- (xiii) **Disqualification/Invalidation:**
- (i) Online monitoring of candidates will be done by the external agency M/s.C-DAC and any transgression (abuse/violation) is found on the part of any of the candidates during the online examination, his/her candidature will be disqualified and such candidate will not be allowed to appear for 3 consecutive exams, apart from initiation of disciplinary action against him/her thereafter.
- (ii) Malpractice, if any, found during examination or after examination, the marks scored by the candidates will not be considered and the respective candidate will be treated as disqualified and necessary Disciplinary Action will be initiated against him/her.
- (xiv) **Publication of Results in the Website:**
The status of "Pass", "Fail", "Absentees" and "Disqualification" shall be published in the Websites (TANGEDCO & Examination Web Portals) against the Application No., Name, Designation and Exam Centre. The list of passed candidates alone will be published in the Board's Proceedings.
- (xv) **Expenditure:**
The Chief Engineer/IC, R&D is empowered to sanction up to Rs.15.0 Lakhs per annum only, towards the expenditure for conducting the Departmental Tests once in six months. The expenditure is chargeable to TANGEDCO's Revenue Expenditure

- 1.0 It is informed that, necessary agriculture service connection target has been fixed and instructions issued for 2021-2022 in the reference cited above where in it has been instructed to effect agricultural service connections under Fast Track (Tatkal) SFS scheme, as and when willingness is received from the applicant, the same shall be considered and service connection effected as per the procedure applicable for Fast Track (Tatkal) SFS scheme.
- 2.0 In this regard, the following working instructions are issued in respect of effecting agricultural service connections under Fast Track (Tatkal) SFS scheme:
- Fast Track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme is an optional and purely on the willingness of the registered applicants. It does not affect the regular waiting seniority of the applicants.
 - All the agriculture applications registered under LT tariff IV for the load up to 15 HP may be considered for this scheme and collect the scheme cost as detailed below:

Load upto 5 HP	-	Rs.2.50 Lakhs
Above 5 to 7.5 HP	-	Rs.2.75 Lakhs
Above 7.5 to 10 HP	-	Rs.3.00 Lakhs
Above 10 HP to 15 HP	-	Rs.4.00 Lakhs
 - From 14.09.2021 onwards all the registered agriculture applicants (existing and new) who are willing to opt under the above scheme can make the one time payment.
 - Name transfer and SF change if any should be completed before acceptance under this scheme. Reduction of load is not permitted. After verifying the revenue documents as per Form-2 of TNERC Amendments to the TamilNadu Electricity Distribution code, NOC (if applicable), the willingness application and Demand Draft may be accepted.
 - Applications are to be processed only through online application tracking in LT billing system. Chief Engineer/IT has to provide necessary facility to collect charges and view facility to monitor the progress on daily basis as done in the previous TATKAL schemes.

- f) The preparation of estimate, execution of works, motor-pump set with capacitor readiness and effecting of power supply are to be carried out as per the procedure explained in the TNERC Distribution code in force.
- g) Separate Section priority should be maintained for this Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing Scheme 2021-2022 and to take up the work for the paid cases immediately and separately and categories the works on mere, minor, major category as per Section priority.
- h) All pending ready parties in other schemes are also to be completed simultaneously.
- i) The Regional Chief Engineers/Distribution shall implement and monitor the Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme 2021-2022 and send the progress report to Chief Engineer/Planning & RC every week.
- j) The scheme amount shall be collected under the Account Code No.55.109.
- k) The Scheme shall be in operation till further instruction from this office.
