PROCEEDINGS:

The proposal of issuing Ex-gratia payment for the year 2020-2021 to the Temporary Casual Labourers who were engaged directly in TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO for the year 2020-2021 has been examined in detail by the Chairman-cum-Managing Director/TANGEDCO.

2. Accordingly, it has been decided that, the Temporary Casual Labourers who had engaged directly in TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO on need basis on daily wages for not less than thirty working days in the financial year 2020-2021, are entitled to receive the payment of Ex-gratia.

3. The Ex-gratia amount payable shall be Rs.1403/- (Rupees One Thousand Four Hundred and Three only). This Ex-gratia payment will be made in a proportionate manner in respect of Temporary Casual labourers for the period they had worked in the financial year 2020-2021.

4. In pursuance to the above, it is hereby ordered that,

(i) The 1 Temporary Casual Labourers (**Annexure-A**) who was engaged directly by the TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO on need basis on daily wages @ Rs.380/- per day, in the year 2020-2021 and also continuously working till date shall be paid ex-gratia proportionately for the period they had worked in the year 2020-2021.

(ii) The 15 Temporary Casual Labourers (**Annexure-B**) who had engaged directly by the TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO on need basis on daily wages @ Rs.380/- per day, in the year 2020-2021 and subsequently absorbed as Field Assistant (Trainee) during/after March 2021 shall be paid Ex-gratia fully (or) proportionately as the case may be.

5. The Superintending Engineer are strictly informed that accountability will be fixed on the officers for non-compliance of these orders and in case the payment is made to any ineligible persons, responsibility will be fixed on the officers and disciplinary action will be initiated against the officers concerned. If any discrepancies are found regarding the eligibility/identity towards the payment of ex-gratia, the same must be got clarified from this office before payment made to the concerned persons.

6. The Superintending Engineers are directed to disburse the Ex-gratia to the persons mentioned in the Annexure A & B of these Proceedings immediately and also instructed to send the copy of the acquittance to this office.

Sub: MATERNITY LEAVE - Enhancement of Maternity Leave from 9 months (270 days) to 12 months (365 days) - Clarifications issued by the Government - Adoption in TANGEDCO - Clarification - Issued.

 - 3) From the Chief Secretary to Government, HRM (FR-III) Department Secretariat, Chennai-9, Letter (Ms) No.16049/FR.III/2021, Dated 17.09.2021.

Based on the orders issued by the Government in G.O. first cited, orders have been issued in the Proceedings second cited enhancing the Maternity Leave admissible to married women employees of TANGEDCO with less than two surviving children, from 9 months (270 days) to 12, months (365 days) with effect from 01.07.2021, with full pay, which may be spread over from the pre-confinement rest to post-confinement recuperation at the option of the married women employees of TANGEDCO. It was also ordered therein that the women employees of TANGEDCO who proceeded on Maternity Leave, prior to 1st July 2021, and continued to be on that leave on or after that date shall also be eligible for Maternity Leave for a period not exceeding 365 days in total.

2. In the letter third cited, the Government have issued certain clarifications with regard to the enhancement of Maternity Leave from 9 months (270 days) to 12 months (365 days) to the married women Government Servants. After thorough examination, it has been decided to adopt the same in TANGEDCO.

3. Accordingly, the following clarifications are issued:

- (i) As the enhancement of Maternity Leave takes effect from 01.07.2021 as per the Government Order first cited, and the date of issue of Proceedings is 13.09.2021, the cases of married women employees of TANGEDCO who were on Maternity Leave on 01.07.2021 or after that date, but joined duty on completion of 270 days before the issue of (Per) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No.183 (SB), Dated 13.09.2021 may be considered for sanction of Maternity Leave, for the balance period out of 365 days in total, as per the above said Proceedings from the date on which Maternity Leave was sanctioned to them initially, as and when representation is received from them, within this period. The in-between period from the date on which they joined duty and attended office may be treated as duty.
- (ii) Similarly, those who were on Maternity Leave on or after 01.07.2021 and subsequently continued their leave as Earned Leave/Unearned Leave on Medical Certificate/Extra ordinary Leave without pay and allowance etc., on completion of 270 days of Maternity Leave before the issue of above Proceedings may also be considered for sanction of Maternity Leave as per (Per) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No.183 (SB), Dated 13.09.2021 and in such cases the leave applied/sanctioned in continuation of Maternity Leave shall be modified as Maternity Leave.
- (iii) In all the above cases, the Leave Sanctioning Authority shall ensure that the Maternity Leave should not exceed 365 days in total, from the date on which Maternity Leave was sanctioned initially.
