Memorandum (Permanent) No. 59111/A17/A171/99-1, dated 21.7.2000.

Sub: Medical Reimbursement Claim Under Medical Attendance Rules - Scrutiny of Bills - Orders - Issued.

Ref: Memo. (Per.) No. 17242/N1/97-1, dated 7.7.1997.

In the Board's Memorandum cited, the following orders were issued:-

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- i) The Medical prescriptions in the printed prescribed form should be written in their own handwriting by Civil Surgeon/Authorised Medical Attendants or the Government Doctors and Chief Medical Officer and Medical Officers of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Dispensary along with their rubber stamp with date.
 - ii) Initially, every medical reimbursement claim preferred by the employees of the Board under the Medical Attendance Rules for the treatment taken as out-patient for Rs. 500/- and above should be forwarded by the respective sanctioning authorities of the Board in Chennai and sub-urban areas, to the Chief Medical Officer, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Head Quarters Dispensary, for scrutiny. Based on the recommendation of the Chief Medical Officer/Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Head Quarters Dispensary, the sanctioning authority should sanction the claim".

It has also been indicated therein that the above procedure would be extended, later on, to other areas.

2. A Superintending Engineer has reported that the MRI claims exceeding Rs. 500/- in certain cases have been admitted in his circle but however the ceiling is limited to one month's basic pay as on 1.1.95 + 125 % Dearness Allowance thereon for a year. At the time of conducting final inspection, the Inspecting Officer has indicated in his Inspection report that the clarificatory orders with regard to the extension of the above procedure to the other areas in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board should be obtained from the Board to regulate the M.R.I. claims.

3. After careful examination, it is hereby ordered that the existing procedure set out in para 1 above be continued in Chennai city and its sub-urban areas alone.

4. The instruction/Guidelines issued in B.P.Ms. No. 500 (SB) dated 2.11.1981 shall be followed in all other areas for scrutinising the M.R.I. claims.

5. The receipt of the Memorandum should be acknowledged.
